

THE COUNTY OF CUMBRIA (VARIOUS ROADS, SOUTH LAKELAND AREA)
(CONSOLIDATION OF TRAFFIC REGULATIONS) (ORDER 2002)
VARIATION ORDER (GARTH HEADS, KENDAL) 2005

The County Council of Cumbria in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (4), 19, 32, 35, 35A, 38, 45, 46, 47, 49, 51, 53 and 64 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Cumbria in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on 28th February 2005 and may be cited as The County of Cumbria (Various Roads, South Lakeland Area) (Consolidation of Traffic Regulations) (Order 2002) Variation Order (Garth Heads, Kendal) 2005
2. For the purposes of this Order the expression "the 2002 Order" shall mean The County of Cumbria (Various Roads, South Lakeland Area) (Consolidation of Traffic Regulations) Order 2002
3. The 2002 Order shall have effect as though: -
 - (a) The following were added as Articles 124C and 124D: -
 - 124C. Save as provided in Article 124D of this Order, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in Schedule 89B to this Order.
 - 124D. Nothing in Article 124C to this Order shall apply to:-
 - (a) vehicles being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
 - (b) vehicles being used in connection with the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the length of road or side of road or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on or near the said length of road of any sewer or of any main pipe apparatus for the supply of gas water electricity or any telecommunications apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984; or
 - (c) vehicles being used in connection with the maintenance, repair or improvement of properties on or adjacent to that length of road; or
 - (d) pedal cycles.

(b) The following was added as Schedule 89B: -

SCHEDULE 89B – KENDAL

Prohibition of Vehicles

<u>Town/Village</u>	<u>Street Name</u>	<u>Restricted Length</u>
Kendal	U752 Garth Heads	From a point 41 metres south of the centre of the intersection of the centre line of Garth Heads with the southeastern boundary of Beast Banks, in a southerly direction to its junction with Captain French Lane.

4. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
