

THE COUNTY OF CUMBRIA (VARIOUS SCHOOLS IN THE SOUTH LAKELAND DISTRICT)
(NO STOPPING ON SCHOOL ENTRANCE MARKINGS) ORDER 2003

The County Council of Cumbria in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1) to (3), 2(1) and (2) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Cumbria in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on 5th January 2004 and may be cited as The County of Cumbria (Various Schools in the South Lakeland District) (No Stopping on School Entrance Markings) Order 2003

PART I

GENERAL

2. (1) In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:-

"delivering" and or "collecting" in relation to any goods includes checking the goods for the purpose of their delivery or collection;

"junction" means, unless otherwise indicated in this Order, the intersection of the general alignment of the highway boundaries of two roads;

"post office" and any reference to "post office vehicle" or "postal packets" shall be construed in the context of the Postal Services Act 2000 and the Consequential Amendments Order 2001 (No. 2001/648);

"the 1991 Act" means the Road Traffic Act 1991;

"The 2002 Regulations" means the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002.

- (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactment.
- (3) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

PART II

NO STOPPING ON SCHOOL ENTRANCE MARKINGS

3. Save as provided in Article 4, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or stop on any school entrance markings which generally comply with diagram number 1027.1 and indicated by an associated sign to diagram 642.2A as prescribed in the 2002 Regulations on the road at or near any school in the District of South Lakeland specified in the Schedule to this Order.
4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall apply if the vehicle is:-
 - (a) waiting owing the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his control or to such waiting being necessary in order to avoid accidents;
 - (b) being used for the following reasons where they cannot be reasonably expected to park safely or within reasonable distance of the school outwith the school entrance markings:-
 - for maintenance of the highway or for maintenance/installation of utility apparatus;
 - for the purpose of carrying out postal collections and deliveries;
 - for delivering and collecting goods at the school;
 - for maintenance and building work at the school;
 - officially recognised transport engaged in the transport of children in school transport vehicles whilst being used to set down and pick up, ie. school taxis, school buses, coaches on school trips (not including parent's vehicles);
 - for setting down or picking up disabled passengers;
 - (c) being used in connection with weddings or funerals.
 - (d) a vehicle used for police, fire brigade, ambulance or mountain rescue purposes, or a vehicle (other than a passenger vehicle) in the service of a local authority or water authority which is being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (e) in the service of or employed by the post office and is waiting while postal packets addressed to premises adjacent to the length of road or side of road in which the vehicle is waiting are being unloaded from the vehicle, or, having been unloaded therefrom, or are being delivered or while postal packets are being collected from premises or posting boxes adjacent to the length of road or side of road in which the vehicle is waiting, or, is in use in connection with the servicing of posting boxes adjacent to the length of road or side of road in which the vehicle is waiting;
 - (f) being used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the length of road or side of road or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near the said length of road or side of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984.

5. The school entrance markings shall be deemed to comply with diagram 1027.1 if the markings on the ground contain at least one set of the words "SCHOOL-KEEP-CLEAR" and on either side of these words at least one zig-zag pattern (of approximately 5.4m in length) has been placed.




