

THE COUNTY OF CUMBRIA (VARIOUS ROADS, SOUTH LAKELAND AREA)
(CONSOLIDATION OF TRAFFIC REGULATIONS) (ORDER 2002)
(WINDERMERE) VARIATION ORDER 2007

The County Council of Cumbria in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (4), 19, 32, 35, 35A, 38, 45, 46, 47, 49, 51, 53 and 64 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Cumbria in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order shall come into operation on 1 March 2007 and may be cited as The County of Cumbria (Various Roads, South Lakeland Area) (Consolidation of Traffic Regulations) (Order 2002) (Windermere) Variation Order 2007
2. For the purposes of this Order the expression “the 2002 Order” shall mean The County of Cumbria (Various Roads, South Lakeland Area) (Consolidation of Traffic Regulations) Order 2002
3. The 2002 Order shall have effect as though:
 - (a) The following descriptions were added to Schedule 52 Part 4, Windermere and Bowness-on-Windermere - “No Waiting At Any Time”: -

Street	Side	Restricted Length
<u>WINDERMERE</u>		
Thwaites Lane	East	From its junction with the A591 (kerb line) in a generally southerly direction for a distance of 244m, the east side of the stone arch of the railway bridge.
Thwaites Lane	West	From its junction with the A591 (kerb line) in a generally southerly direction for a distance of 83m.
Thwaites Lane	West	From a point 146m south of its junction with the A591 (kerb line) southwards for a distance of 29m.
Thwaites Lane	West	From the east side of the stone arch of the railway bridge northwards for a distance of 32m.
Claife Avenue	Southwest and Northwest	From a point 47m northwest of the centre of its junction with Claife Close to a point 41m southwest of the said junction (measured along the kerb line)
Claife Avenue	Northeast and Southeast	From a point 18m northwest of the centre of its junction with Claife Close to a point 26m southwest of the said junction (measured along the kerb line)

Claipe Close	Both	From the centre of its junction with Claipe Avenue eastwards for a distance of 13m.
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- (b) The following entry relating in Schedule 52 Part 5 Miscellaneous “No Waiting At Any Time”:-

Casterton Parish	A683 at Devil’s Bridge	NWAAT	West	From a point 59m north of the centre of its junction with the U5397 (measured along the west channel line of A683) in a southwesterly direction along the kerb line (adjacent to the River Lune) for a distance of 13m.

Village	Street Name	Restriction	Side of Street	Restricted Length
Casterton Parish	A683 at Devil’s Bridge	NWAAT	West	From a point 59m north of the centre of its junction with the U5397 (measured along the west channel line of A683) in a southwesterly direction along the kerb line (adjacent to the River Lune) for a distance of 23m.

- (c) The following entry relating in Schedule 57 Part 1 Miscellaneous “No Waiting, 9 am – 6 pm Good Friday – 31 October”:-

Village	Street Name	Side of Street	Restricted Length
Coniston	Lake Road	Southeast and Southwest	From a point 7m south west of the centre of the bridge over Church Beck in a north easterly then south easterly direction to a point 306m south east of the centre of the bridge over Church Beck

was replaced with the following:-

Village	Street Name	Side of Street	Restricted Length
Coniston	Lake Road	Southeast and Southwest	From a point 7m south west of the centre of the bridge over Church Beck in a north easterly then south easterly direction to a point 352m south east of the centre of the bridge over Church Beck

- (d) The following entry in Schedule 111A “Parking Places for (1) Motor Cycles Only on Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays and (2) Any vehicle on all other days: -

Village	Street Name	Side of Street	Restricted Length
Casterton Parish	A683 at Devil's Bridge	West side of parking area	From a point 46m north of the centre of its junction with the U5397 (measured along the west channel line of the A683) southwestwards (measured along the kerb line adjacent to the River Lune) for a distance of 49m.

was replaced with the following: -

Village	Street Name	Side of Street	Restricted Length
Casterton Parish	A683 at Devil's Bridge	West side of parking area	From a point 37m north of the centre of its junction with the U5397 (measured along the west channel line of the A683) southwestwards (measured along the kerb line adjacent to the River Lune) for a distance of 39m.

4. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
