

THE COUNTY OF CUMBRIA (VARIOUS ROADS, SOUTH LAKELAND AREA)
(CONSOLIDATION OF TRAFFIC REGULATIONS) (ORDER 2002)
(GRIZEBECK) VARIATION ORDER 2009

The County Council of Cumbria in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (4), 19, 32, 35, 35A, 38, 45, 46, 47, 49, 51, 53 and 64 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Cumbria in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order shall come into operation on 25 May 2009 and may be cited as The County of Cumbria (Various Roads, South Lakeland Area) (Consolidation of Traffic Regulations) (Order 2002) (Grizebeck) Variation Order 2009
2. For the purposes of this Order the expression “the 2002 Order” shall mean The County of Cumbria (Various Roads, South Lakeland Area) (Consolidation of Traffic Regulations) Order 2002
3. The 2002 Order shall have effect as though:-
 - (a) The following description was added to Schedule 52 Part 5, Miscellaneous - “No Waiting At Any Time”: -

VILLAGE	STREET NAME	RESTRICTION	SIDE OF STREET	RESTRICTED LENGTH
Grizebeck	A595 slip road between the southern and western arms of the A595 at its junction with the A5092	NWAAT	Both sides	Full length

- (b) The following entry in Schedule 109 “One Way Traffic” was deleted in its entirety: -

VILLAGE	STREET NAME	RESTRICTION	SIDE OF STREET	RESTRICTED LENGTH
Grizebeck	Slip Road (A595)	One Way Traffic	Both sides	That length of slip road joining the A595 trunk road to the principal road on the west side of the junction of the A595/A5092 trunk road and the A595 principal road at Grizebeck to a point 15 metres south eastwards from its junction with the A595 trunk road other than in a southeast to northwest direction.

4. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
