

**THE COUNTY OF CUMBRIA (VARIOUS ROADS, SOUTH LAKELAND AREA)**  
**(CONSOLIDATION OF TRAFFIC REGULATIONS) (ORDER 2002)**  
**(VARIOUS ROADS, WINDERMERE AND BOWNESS-ON-WINDERMERE) (PART)**  
**VARIATION ORDER 2014**

The County Council of Cumbria in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (4), 19, 32, 35, 35A, 38, 45, 46, 47, 49, 51, 53 and 64 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Cumbria in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order shall come into operation on 6 May 2014 and may be cited as The County of Cumbria (Various Roads, South Lakeland Area) (Consolidation of Traffic Regulations) (Order 2002) (Various Roads, Windermere and Bowness-on-Windermere) (Part) Variation Order 2014
2. For the purposes of this Order the expression “the 2002 Order” shall mean The County of Cumbria (Various Roads, South Lakeland Area) (Consolidation of Traffic Regulations) Order 2002
3. The 2002 Order shall have effect as though:-
  - (a) The following entries were added to Schedule 21 Part 2, Windermere and Bowness – “Parking Places for Resident Permit Holders Only”: -

Windermere	Queen's Drive	NWAAT	Both	From its junction with Prince's Road south westerly for a distance of 15m.

- (e) The following entries in Schedule 52 Part 4, Windermere and Bowness-on-Windermere - "No Waiting At Any Time" were deleted in their entirety: -

Windermere	Birch Street	NWAAT	Both Sides	From its junction with Crescent Road (east side) in an easterly direction for its entire length.

- (f) The following entry in Schedule 79 Part 1, Windermere and Bowness-on-Windermere - "Disabled Parking Place 3 Hours Full Week, Waiting Limited to 3 Hours, Return Prohibited within 3 Hours" was deleted in its entirety: -

Bowness	Glebe Road	WL 3 HOURS, RPW 3 HOURS, DISABLED PP	South	From a point 31m west of the centre of its junction with the A592 westwards for a distance of 7m.

- (g) The following was added as Article 152A: -

152A. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle, other than a motor cycle, to wait, at any time, on any day, in the lengths of road or sides of road specified in Schedule 111A to this Order.

- (h) The following was added as Schedule 111A: -

**SCHEDULE 111A**  
**PART 1 – WINDERMERE AND BOWNESS-ON-WINDERMERE**  
**MOTOR CYCLES ONLY – FULL WEEK, AT ALL TIMES**

<u>Town/Village</u>	<u>Street Name</u>	<u>Restriction</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Restricted Length</u>
Bowness	Glebe Road	MOTOR CYCLES ONLY AT ALL TIMES	South	From a point 39m west of its northern junction with the A592 (north end) in a westerly direction for a distance of 12m.

4. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
