**The District of South Somerset (Off-Street Parking Places) Order**  
**October 2019**

The District Council of South Somerset (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 35 and 35A and 124 (and Part IV of Schedule 9) of The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the 1984 Act") and The Traffic Management Act 2004 (hereinafter referred to as "the 2004 Act") and all other enabling powers with the consent of Somerset County Council, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 124(1) and Part III of Schedule 9 of the 1984 Act, hereby make the following Order:

**Part I - General**

**1. Commencement and Citation**

This order shall be cited as "the District of South Somerset (Off-Street Parking Places) Order October 2019" and shall come into operation on the 8th day of October 2019.

**2. Revocation**

The District of South Somerset (Off-Street Parking Places) Consolidated Order April 2016 and all subsequent amendments thereto are hereby revoked with effect from the 8th day of October 2019

**3. Definitions and Interpretation**

- 3.1 Any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or to a numbered Schedule is a reference to the Article or to the Schedule bearing that number in this Order, unless otherwise stated.
- 3.2 In this Order, except where the content otherwise requires, the following expressions shall have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:-

**"Approved Device"** means a Device used for statutory purposes in accordance with The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (Approved Devices) (England) Order 2007;

**"Charge Certificate"** means the statement that the Penalty Charge has been increased by fifty percent in accordance with Regulation 21 of the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007 which is issued to the Owner following the issue of a Penalty Charge Notice and a subsequent Notice to Owner following which the Penalty Charge has not been paid;

**"Charging Hours"** means any time period defined in Schedule 1 to this Order in respect of which a Charge is specified;

**"Civil Enforcement Officer"** means a person authorised by or on behalf of South Somerset District Council to supervise the Parking Places and enforce the restrictions imposed by this Order and has the same meaning as Section 76 of the "2004 Act";

**"the Council"** means South Somerset District Council;

**"Disabled Person's Badge"** means a Badge issued by any local authority in accordance with the provisions of The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 (as amended) or a Badge having effect under those regulations as if it was a Disabled Person's Badge;

**"Driver"** in relation to a Vehicle waiting in a Parking Place, means the person driving the Vehicle at the time it was left in the Parking Place and in relation to a Vehicle leaving a Parking Place means the person driving the Vehicle at the time ;

**"Electric Vehicle"** means a Vehicle which is fuelled by charged batteries on board for propulsion and which can be recharged from a plug in electric power source;

**"Electric Vehicle Parking Bay"** means an area of the Parking Space provided solely for recharging the battery of an Electric Vehicle by means of an electric vehicle charging point and defined as such by means of a sign, surface marking or other indication;

**"Expiry Time"** is the time indicated on the Pay and Display Ticket or as registered with the Phone and Pay service, and is the time by which the Vehicle must leave the Parking Place except where a Disabled Persons Badge is correctly displayed then an additional 60 minutes will be allowed on top of the time purchased;

**"Location Number"** means the unique number assigned to each Parking Place where the Phone and Pay System is operational;

**"MiPermit"** means the system put in place by the Council in conjunction with a third party which enables a Driver to pay for an electronic Season Ticket via the third parties payment system;

**"Motor Cycle"** contrary to Section 136 (4) of the 1984 Act means a solo Motor Cycle only and excludes any Motor Cycle which has a trailer or side-car, or which has more than two wheels;

**"Notice to Owner"** means the Notice served by the Council pursuant to Regulation 19 of the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007;

**"Parking Bay"** means an area of a Parking Place which is provided for the leaving of a Vehicle of a class specified and indicated by markings on the surface of the Parking Place or signed or otherwise indicated by signs in the Parking Place;

**"Parking Place"** means any area of land specified by name in the Schedules to this Order provided by the Council under Section 32(1) of the 1984 Act for the purpose of Vehicle parking and not closed (in part or in whole) by a barrier or Notice erected or displayed thereon by authority of the Council;

**"Pay and Display Ticket"** means a Ticket issued by a Ticket Machine located in the Parking Place in which the Vehicle has been left or a Ticket issued by a person nominated by the Council on payment of a charge and valid for a parking period as detailed in the Schedules of this Order;

**"Penalty Charge"** means the Charge set by the Council pursuant to the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007;

**"Penalty Charge Notice"** means a Charge in respect of parking contraventions which is defined by The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007;

**"Phone and Pay"** means the system put in place by the Council in conjunction with a third party which enables a Driver to pay the required parking charge via the third parties payment system. Payment by this manner may incur an administrative fee to the Driver by the third party;

**"Registered Keeper"** means the person in whose name the Vehicle is registered under the Vehicle Excise and Regulation Act 1984;

**"Public Service Vehicle"** has the same meaning as in the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981;

**"Relevant Position"** means:

(a) In the case of a Disabled Person's Badge:-

- (i) In the case of a Vehicle fitted with a dashboard or facia panel, the Badge is exhibited thereon so that Part 1 (the front of the Badge) and also the Parking Clock, can be seen and read from outside the Vehicle; or
- (ii) In the case of a Vehicle not fitted with a dashboard or facia the Badge, pass or ticket is exhibited in a conspicuous and readable position on the Vehicle;

(b) In respect of a Vehicle displaying a Pay and Display Ticket or Parking Permit, where applicable :-

- (i) The Ticket or Permit is exhibited face up on the inside surface of the windscreen or in a clearly visible position so that it is facing forwards and can be easily seen and read from the front or side of the Vehicle; or;
- (ii) In the case of a Vehicle that is not fitted with a transparent windscreen, the Ticket or Permit is exhibited face up on the front of the Vehicle facing forwards and clearly visible;

**"Season Ticket"** means a Ticket purchased from the Council by means of the MiPermit service;

**"Taxi"** means a "Hackney Carriage" and has the same meaning as in the Town Policy Clauses Act 1847;

**"Ticket Machine"** means an apparatus of a type and design approved by the Secretary of State for Transport for the purpose of this Order, being apparatus designed to indicate the time by a clock and to issue Parking Tickets which show that a payment has been made of an amount or for a period specified thereon and which specify the date and, either the time of such payment, or the time at which the Vehicle must leaving the Parking Place;

**"Trailer"** means a Vehicle drawn by a Motor Vehicle and includes a caravan or boat trailer;

**"Vehicle"** means a Motor Vehicle or Heavy Commercial Vehicle and has the meaning assigned to it by Section 136 and 138 of the 1984 Act and should be read to include Electric Vehicles;

3.3 Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment;

3.4 The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order.

## **Part II - Designation and Use of Parking Places**

### **4. Designation**

Each Parking Place may be used, subject to the provisions of this Order, as a place to leave Vehicles, in such positions, on such days, during such hours, for such period and on payment of such charges as are specified in relation thereto in the Schedules 1 and 2.

## **5. Class and position of vehicle**

Where in the Schedules the Parking Place is described as available for Vehicles of a specified class or Vehicles to be left in a specified location, no person shall permit a Vehicle to wait in that Parking Place,

- (i) unless it is of the specified class;
- (ii) unless it is wholly within a marked Parking Bay;
- (iii) in a position marked for use by an Electric Vehicle unless it is an Electric Vehicle which is charging using the apparatus installed;
- (iv) without a valid Vehicle excise licence, insurance and MOT certificate;
- (v) in a position other than that specified.

## **6. Maximum period of stay**

Where in the Schedules a Parking Place is described as available on specified days, during specified hours or for a maximum period of stay, no person shall permit a vehicle to wait in that Parking Place on any day, during such hours or for any period other or longer than those specified, except for where the Vehicle has displayed in the Relevant Position a Disabled Persons Badge in which case, an additional 60 minutes will be allowed on top of the time purchased.

## **7. Period of no return**

Where in the Schedules a Parking Place is described as having a period within which a Vehicle may not return, no person shall permit a Vehicle to wait in that Parking Place on any day, during such hours within which the Vehicle is excluded from waiting in the Parking Place.

## **8. Disabled Person's Parking Bays**

No person shall cause or permit a Vehicle to park in a Parking Bay marked for Disabled Persons unless the Vehicle displays a Disabled Person's Badge in the Relevant Position and immediately before or immediately after the act of parking the Vehicle has been or is about to be used by the person(s) in respect of whom the Disabled Person's Badge has been issued.

## **9. Motor Cycle Parking Bays**

No person shall cause or permit a Vehicle to park in a Parking Bay marked for Motor Cycles unless the Vehicle is a Motor Cycle.

## **10. Power to close, suspend or grant licences of Parking Places**

10.1 Nothing in this Order shall prevent the Council by notice, sign or barrier displayed in the Parking Place:

- (a) from closing the Parking Place or any part thereof for any period; and/or
- (b) from setting aside the Parking Place or any part or parts thereof on all days or on certain days or during certain parts of days for use only by particular Vehicles or organisations.

10.2 Nothing in this Order shall prevent the Council from granting permission for short term use of the Parking Place free of charge or otherwise grant short term licences in accordance with the Council's Scheme of Delegations to Officers forming part of the Council's Constitution.

10.3. Any person suspending the use of a Parking Place or any part thereof in accordance with the provisions of this Article shall thereupon place or cause to be placed in or adjacent to that Parking Place or that part thereof a notice or traffic sign indicating that the use of that Parking Place or that part thereof is suspended and that waiting by Vehicles is prohibited.

10.4. No person shall cause or permit a Vehicle to be left in a Parking Place or any part thereof during such periods that the use of that Parking Place or that part thereof is suspended or during such period as there is in or adjacent thereto a notice or traffic sign placed by or on behalf of the Council in pursuance of the preceding Article.



## **11. Use of Vehicle whilst in Parking Places**

11.1 Without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing provisions of this Order, the provisions of this Article shall apply to the Parking Places even where the Parking Place is occupied by a Vehicle of a type that is permitted to wait in that Parking Place

11.2 No person shall without the prior written permission of a duly authorised Officer of the Council use any part of a Parking Place or any Vehicle or Vehicles (whether belonging to that person or not) left in a Parking Place:

- (a) for sleeping or camping purposes
- (b) for the purpose of carrying out or permitting to be carried out any servicing, repairing or washing of any Vehicle or part thereof other than is reasonably necessary to enable that Vehicle to depart from the Parking Place
- (c) for preparing or cooking food or washing crockery, cutlery, clothing or any other articles or things whatsoever;
- (d) in connection with the sale, or advertising for sale of a Vehicle or of any other article or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skills or services;
- (e) for the purpose of advertising or promoting any cause, event or other matter whatsoever or for the distribution of leaflets or other material; or
- (f) for the erection of any tent, booth, stand, building or other structure

## **12. Obstruction**

The Driver of any Vehicle shall not, unless authorised by the Council:

- (a) use a Parking Place so as to prevent other persons from obtaining access thereto or therefrom or otherwise cause an obstruction in the Parking Place or Parking Bay;
- (b) park over or beyond the Parking Bay markings or otherwise use a Parking Bay so as to prevent other Vehicles from using adjoining Parking Bays;
- (c) park where hatching, cross hatching or yellow lines have been marked on the surface or in the running lanes of the Parking Place.

## **Part III – Charges for Parking**

### **13. Payment**

The Driver of a Vehicle using a Parking Place shall upon leaving the Vehicle in the Parking Place pay the appropriate charge (if any) in accordance with the scale of charges specified in the Schedules,

### **14. Pay and Display Parking Places**

The Driver of a Vehicle using a Pay and Display Parking Place shall upon leaving the Vehicle in the Parking Place either:

- (a) on payment of a charge, purchase a Pay and Display Ticket from the Ticket Machine at the level of charge and for the period required in accordance with the scale of charges specified in the Schedules.
- (b) utilise a Phone and Pay service advertised at the Parking Place following instructions displayed at the level of charge and for the period required in accordance with the scale of charges specified in the Schedules.
- (c) utilise the MiPermit service advertised at the Parking Place for purchase of a Season Ticket at the level of charge and for the period required in accordance with the scale of charges specified in the Schedules.

### **15. Means of payment**

The charge referred to in preceding Article shall be payable by;

- a) the insertion of an appropriate coins; or
- b) other approved method of payment together making up the amount of the charge into the Ticket Machine situated in that Parking Place or
- c) by Phone and Pay or by MiPermit.

If at the time when a Vehicle is parked during the Charging Hours in a Parking Place and the nearest Ticket Machine in that Parking Place is out of order, then a ticket shall be obtained from another Ticket Machine within the same Parking Place (where provided) or via the Mobile Phone Payment system.

## **16. Display of ticket**

Unless Phone and Pay or a Season Ticket has been purchased where no physical ticket is issued, the Driver of the Vehicle shall:

- (a) ensure that a valid Pay and Display Ticket has been obtained to cover the entire period that the Vehicle is to be parked in the Parking Place, and
- (b) display, at all times the Vehicle is parked the Pay and Display ticket face up in the Relevant Position on the Vehicle in respect of which it was purchased

## **17. Exemption to requirement to display of Pay and Display Ticket**

Where arrangement to pay the Daily Charge have been made through a Mobile Phone or MiPermit payment and no Pay and Display Ticket is produced by following the process the Driver of a Vehicle shall be exempt from the requirement to display such a ticket.

## **18. Oversized Vehicles**

18.1 The Driver of a Vehicle drawing a Trailer must ensure that both the Vehicle and the Trailer are parked within the marked bays. If the Vehicle cannot be parked wholly within one marked bay by virtue of the Vehicle and Trailer being of such a length or width not fitting the marked Parking Bay then a valid Pay and Display Ticket must be purchased and displayed in the Relevant Position for each Parking Bay occupied. For the purposes of this Order, whether or not the Vehicle and Trailer are disconnected, the Vehicle and the Trailer shall be deemed to be separate Vehicles and the Driver of the leading Vehicle shall be deemed to be the Driver of both of the Vehicles

18.2 Where a Vehicle of the permitted class but which is oversized (for instance large van or long wide Vehicle) is parked in a Parking Place, a Pay and Display Ticket must be purchased for each Parking Bay occupied in full or in part.

## **19. Validity of Pay and Display tickets**

19.1 A pay and Display Ticket becomes invalid if placed or displayed on or in a Vehicle other than the Vehicle for which it was originally purchased.

- 19.2 A Pay and Display Ticket is valid only in the Parking Place in which it was issued. This is defined by the reference code of the parking Ticket Machine located in that Parking Place printed on the Pay and Display Ticket

## **20. Expiry of parking period**

The expiry of the period for which the charge specified for that Parking Place in the Schedules has been paid shall be indicated when there is exhibited on the Vehicle a Pay and Display Ticket and the time shown on the clock of the issuing Ticket Machine is later than the time at which the period for which a charge has been paid expired.

## **21. No ticket displayed**

- 21.1 Unless Phone and Pay or MiPermit service is used, if at any time while a Vehicle is left in a Parking Place no Pay and Display Ticket is displayed on that Vehicle in the Relevant Position and in accordance with the provisions of this Order, it shall be deemed that the charge has not been paid
- 21.2 If at the time when a Vehicle is left during the Charging Hours in a Parking Place on the nearest Ticket Machine in that Parking Place there is a notice placed by any person duly authorised by the Council, indicating that the Ticket Machine is out of order, then a Pay and Display Ticket shall be obtained from another machine within the same car park (where provided) or by utilising the Phone and Pay service.
- 21.3 Where no valid Pay and Display Ticket can be obtained and Phone and Pay is not available, a Vehicle may be left in a Parking Place but may not be left for longer than the maximum waiting period in that Parking Place as specified in the Schedules.

## **22. Season Tickets**

- 22.1 Season Tickets are available at the appropriate fee for a Vehicle of a specific class and for the Parking Places as specified in the Schedule and paid by means of the MiPermit service.

22.2 The Driver shall abide by the terms stipulated by the Council for the use of the Season Ticket.

**23. Staff/Member Visitor Pass**

(a) the Council may issue a Staff/Member/Visitor Pass, as it considers reasonably appropriate and may limit availability to any specified category of person and shall be subject to such terms and conditions, as it deems fit in respect of the Parking Places;

(b) a Staff/Member/Visitor Pass shall only be valid when it is being used in full accordance with the terms, conditions and limitations applying to it at the time of issue.

**24. Exemption to Require Display Ticket**

No charge shall be payable in respect of:

A Motor Cycle which is left in a Parking Bay specified for such Vehicles (if any)

**Part IV – Contravention and Penalty Charge**

**25. Contravention**

If a Vehicle is left in a Parking Place referred to in the Schedule without complying with the requirements of this Order, a contravention shall have occurred and a Penalty Charge shall be payable. A Penalty Charge Notice showing the information required by the 2004 Act may then be issued by a Civil Enforcement Officer in accordance with the requirements of the 2004 Act.

## **26. Notice of Penalty Charge**

26.1 In the case of a Vehicle in respect of which the Penalty Charge may have been incurred, it shall be the duty of a Civil Enforcement Officer to attach to the Vehicle in a conspicuous position or hand to the Driver a Penalty Charge Notice which shall include such particulars as are required by the 2004 Act and the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007.

26.2 In the case in respect of which the Penalty Charge may have been incurred, a Penalty Charge Notice may be issued by post by the Council if the Driver of the Vehicle drives away before the Civil Enforcement Officer has issued a Penalty Charge Notice or the Civil Enforcement Officer has been prevented from issuing a Penalty Charge Notice. Such a Penalty Charge Notice shall include such particulars as are required by the 2004 Act and the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007

## **27. Restrictions on removal of Penalty Charge Notice**

A Penalty Charge Notice fixed to a Vehicle in accordance with the preceding Article shall not be removed or interfered with except by or under the authority of:

- (a) the Owner, or person in charge of the Vehicle;
- (b) the Council for the place in which the Vehicle in question was found.

## **28. Payment of Penalty Charge**

28.1 The Owner of a Vehicle in respect of which the Penalty Charge has been incurred shall pay the Penalty Charge to the Council by cheque or postal order which shall be delivered or sent by post so as to reach the Council not later than the last day of the period of 28 days beginning with the date on which the Penalty Charge Notice was served or by credit card or debit card by telephone (01935 462462) or electronically via the Council's website.

Please quote your Penalty Charge Number and Vehicle Registration in all communications concerning a Penalty Charge Notice.

- 28.2 If the Penalty Charge is paid not later the last day of the period of 14 days beginning with the date on which the Penalty Charge Notice was served, the amount of the Penalty Charge will be reduced by fifty percent in accordance with the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contravention (Guidelines on Levels of Charges (England) Order 2007.
- 28.3 If the Owner fails to pay the Penalty Charge by the last day of the period of 28 days beginning with the date on which the Penalty Charge Notice was served, a Notice to Owner may be served; and if the charge is then not paid within a further 28 days it may be increased by 50% upon the issue of a Charge Certificate.
- 28.4 Payment shall be received not later than the end of the 28<sup>th</sup> day following the day on which such Penalty Charge was served or the 14<sup>th</sup> day following the day on which the Penalty Charge was served if the reduced charge is paid. **PROVIDED THAT** if the said 28<sup>th</sup> or 14<sup>th</sup> day falls upon a day on which the Council's Offices or other nominated place are closed, the period within which payment of the said Penalty Charge shall be made to the Council shall be extended until the end of the next full day on which the Council's Offices or other nominated place are open.

## **29. Indications as Evidence**

The particulars given in the Penalty Charge Notice attached to a Vehicle in accordance with this Article shall be treated as evidence in any proceedings relating to failure to pay such Penalty Charge.

## **Part V – Other Provisions**

### **30. Liability**

Vehicles and their content are parked at the owners own risk and no liability is accepted for loss or damage to Vehicles or other property, or persons on or in the vicinity of the Parking Place however caused, left in any of the Council's Parking Places to which this Order applies.

### **31. Stop engine and apply brakes**

The Driver of a Vehicle using a Parking Place shall stop the engine as soon as the Vehicle is in the Parking Bay and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the Vehicle in or to depart from the Parking Place.

### **32. Repair of Vehicles in parking Places**

No person shall, while a Vehicle is in a Parking Place, permit the carrying out of any work of maintenance or repair thereto except such as may be necessary to enable the Vehicle to be moved from the Parking Place.

### **33. Entry and exit**

Where signs are erected or surface markings are laid for the purpose of indicating the entrances to or exits from the Parking Place; or indicating that a Vehicle proceed in a specified direction, no person should drive or cause to be driven any Vehicle:

- (a) so that it enters the Parking Place otherwise than by an entrance, or leaves the Parking Place otherwise than by an exit;
- (b) in a direction other than that specified, as the case may be



#### **34. Damage to or defilement of a Parking Place**

34.1 Without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing provisions of this Order, the provisions of this Article shall apply to the Parking Places even where the Parking Place is occupied by a Vehicle of a type that is permitted to wait in that Parking Place.

34.2 In a Parking Place no person shall:

- (a) light or cause or permit to be lit any fire;
- (b) soil or defile, remove, displace or damage any wall or fence in or enclosing the Parking Place or any building, barrier, post, notice, sign, railing, Ticket Machine, or any other erection therein
- (c) damage or destroy or cause to be damaged or destroyed any part of the fabric or structure of the Parking Place; or
- (d) throw down, drop or otherwise deposit in any Parking Place any item or article of rubbish or waste material so as to contribute to or tend to lead to the defilement of that Parking Place by litter

#### **35. Prohibited use of Parking Place / anti-social behaviour**

35.1 No person shall do anything to interfere with the use and enjoyment of any Parking Place by other users of the Parking Place and in particular no person shall obstruct or misuse any Parking Place furniture and amenities

35.2 No person shall in a Parking Place wantonly shout or otherwise make any loud noise to the disturbance or annoyance of users of the Parking Place or residents of premises in the neighbourhood

35.3 No person shall in a Parking Place use any threatening, abusive or insulting language, gesture or conduct so as to put any person in fear of their safety or wellbeing or so as to occasion or is likely to occasion a breach of the peace.

35.4 No person in a Parking Place shall sound any horn or other similar instrument or use or permit the same to be used on a Vehicle at any time except to make another Driver or person aware of their presence where an accident is imminent.

- 35.5 No person shall, except with the permission of any person duly authorised by the Council, drive any Vehicle in a Parking Place other than for the purpose of leaving that Vehicle in a Parking Bay in accordance with the provisions of this Order or for the purpose of departing from the Parking Place.
- 35.6 No person shall in a Parking Place commit any parking contravention attracting a higher level Penalty Charge as set out in the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (Guidelines on levels of Charges) (England) Order 2007 or any parking contravention attracting a lower level Penalty Charge as from time to time specified by the Department for Transport on their website.

## **Part VI – Relocation Removal and Disposal of Vehicles**

### **36. Relocation of a Vehicle**

Where any Vehicle is standing in a Parking Place in contravention of the provisions of this Order, or is left in such a manner so as to cause danger or obstruction a Civil Enforcement Officer or a person authorised by the Council may alter or cause to be altered the position of the Vehicle.

### **37. Removal of a Vehicle**

Where a Civil Enforcement Officer or a person authorised by the Council is of the opinion that any of the provisions contained in this Order have been contravened or not complied with in respect of a Vehicle left in a Parking Place he/she may, using such measures as are appropriate, remove or cause to be removed the Vehicle from the Parking Place.

### **38. Disposal of vehicles abandoned in Parking Places**

- 38.1 The Council may sell or otherwise dispose of a Vehicle which has been, or could at any time be, removed from a Parking Place pursuant to this Order, if the Vehicle appears to have been abandoned, provided that this power of disposal shall not be exercisable unless the Council has taken such of the following steps as are applicable to the Vehicle in question, and there has elapsed a period of six weeks beginning with the taking of the first of those steps.

- 38.2 Where the Vehicle carries a registration mark the Council shall ascertain from the appropriate body the name and address of the person who is the Owner of the Vehicle unless the Council is satisfied that the true Owner of the Vehicle has identified himself/herself to it.
- 38.3 The Council shall, where it is by virtue of the preceding Articles, aware of the name and address of a person who it appears may be the Owner of the Vehicle, send a notice to that person at that address stating that it is the intention of the Council to sell or otherwise dispose of the Vehicle ("the Notice") on or after a specified date (which shall not be less than two weeks from the date of the Notice and in any event not earlier than six weeks from the date of the first step taken by the Council under this Part of this Order) unless it is in the meantime removed by or on behalf of that person from such place as is specified by the Council in the said Notice or from such place as may be subsequently notified in writing by the Council to that person.
- 38.4 If any person to whom a Notice is sent in accordance with this Article informs The Council of the name and address of some other person who he/she alleges may be the Owner of the Vehicle, a Notice stating the particulars mentioned in this Article shall be sent to that other person and to any further person who the Council may in consequence of the sending of the Notice to the said other person be led to believe may be the Owner of the Vehicle.
- 38.5 Where a Vehicle does not carry a registration mark the first step to be taken by the Council shall be to apply in writing to the Chief Officer of Police in whose area the Parking Place is situated enquiring whom that Officer considers is the Owner of the Vehicle and the address of that person.
- 38.6 The Council shall then make such further enquiries as to ownership as it thinks fit.
- 38.7 Upon the sale of a Vehicle by the Council, the Council shall apply the proceeds of sale in or towards the satisfaction of any costs incurred by it in connection with the disposal thereof and of any charge or payment to which it is entitled.
- 38.8 In the event that any such costs incurred by the Council in connection with the disposal of the Vehicle are not satisfied by virtue of this Article, the Council may

recoup those costs from the person who was the Owner of the vehicle immediately before it was removed from the Parking Place, provided that that the person was sent by the Council a Notice under this Article.

- 38.9 Any sums received by the Council on a sale of a Vehicle shall, after deducting any sum applied thereabouts by virtue of this Article, be payable within a period of one year from receipt hereof to any person to whom, but for such sale, the Vehicle would have belonged and insofar as any such sums are not claimed within the said period they shall be paid into the General Fund of the Council.

### **39. Emergencies**

A Civil Enforcement Officer, a person authorised by the Council or a Police Constable in uniform may, using such measures as are appropriate, move or cause to be moved in the case of an emergency to any place he/she thinks fit, any Vehicle left in a Parking Place.

## Part VII – General Data Protection Regulation 2018

### 40. Your Privacy

Under The Traffic Management Act 2004 our Civil Enforcement Officers patrol our Parking Places (and utilise hand held camera devices) to enforce the terms of this Order. Where these have not been complied with, your personal data may be collected, processed, shared and retained in order to carry out the performance of a public task and fulfil our legal obligations in the following ways:

- (a) To request details of the registered keeper of the Vehicle from the DVLA in order to pursue a Penalty Charge Notice.
- (b) Shared with third parties for appeals and enforcement.
- (c) Shared with the Police or security organisations to prevent or detect crime.
