



**THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON  
(VARIOUS ROADS) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING) (AMENDMENT 66)  
(PART 1) ORDER 2019**

Southampton City Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Office of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to that Act hereby makes the following Order:

**CITATION**

- 1 This Order shall come into operation on 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2020 and may be cited as The City of Southampton (Various roads) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Amendment 66) (Part 1) Order 2019.

**INTERPRETATION**

- 2 In this Order:
- (i) "Principal Order" means the City of Southampton (Various Roads) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2011.
  - (ii) Except where otherwise stated, any reference to an Article or Schedule shall be construed as a reference to that Article or Schedule in this Order.
  - (iii) Any reference to an enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactments.

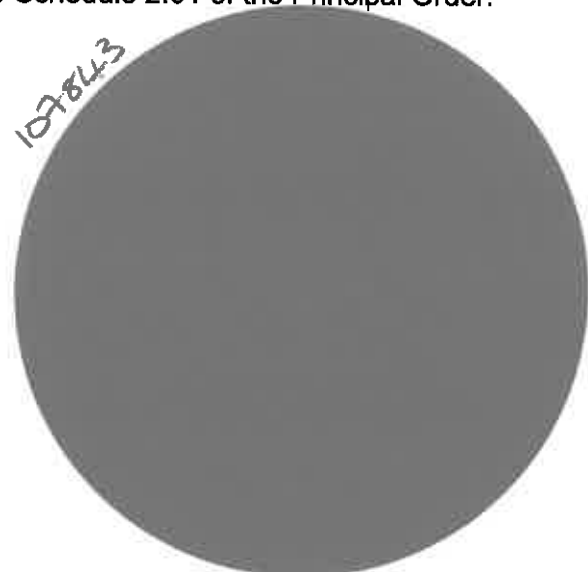
**AMENDMENTS**

**SCHEDULE 1 – No Waiting at Any Time (Addition to schedule 2.01 of the Principal Order)**

<b>Road</b>	<b>Side</b>	<b>Description</b>
Mercator Close	All	For its entire length
Mercator Close (Spur)	North-east	For its entire length
Mercator Close (Spur)	South-eastern closed end	For its entire length
Mercator Close (Spur)	South-west	From its junction with Mercator Close southwards for 8m
Mercator Close (Spur)	South-west	From 50m south of its junction with Mercator Close southwards to its closed end
