

## THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON (VARIOUS ROADS) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING) (AMENDMENT 77) ORDER 2021

Southampton City Council (hereinafter called "the Council") in exercise of its powers under sections 1, 2, 32, 35, 45, 46 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:

## **CITATION**

This Order shall come into operation on 27<sup>th</sup> December 2021 and may be cited as The City of Southampton (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Amendment 77) Order 2021.

## INTERPRETATION

- 2 In this Order:
  - (i) "Principal Order" shall mean the City of Southampton (Various Roads) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2011, as amended.
  - (ii) Except where otherwise stated, any reference to an Article or Schedule shall be construed as a reference to that Article or Schedule in this Order.
  - (iii) Any reference to an enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactments.

## **AMENDMENTS**

- The definition of "Restricted Hours" in Article 2A of the Principal Order shall be deleted and replaced with the following:
  - ""Restricted Hours" means the period between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Monday to Friday inclusive on any such day not being Christmas Day, Good Friday or a Bank Holiday being a public holiday."
- The contents of Article 5(F) of the Principal Order shall be deleted and replaced with the following:
  - (i) Save as provided in paragraph (ii) below, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait during the restricted hours in any parking place specified in Schedule 8.10 for a period of more than six hours on any day or on more than one occasion during any day.
  - (ii) The provisions of paragraph (i) above shall not apply to:-
    - (a) any disabled person's vehicle;
    - (b) any vehicle displaying in the relevant position a valid permit issued under the provisions of Article 5(G);

- (iii) A Police Constable in uniform or any person duly authorised by the Council may suspend the use of a parking place specified in Schedule 8.10 or any part thereof when considered reasonably necessary:-
  - (a) for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety;
  - (b) for the purpose of building, industrial or demolition operations in or adjacent to the parking place or the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the parking place or the laying, erection alteration or repair in or adjacent to the parking place of any sewer, or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus or any traffic sign or ticket machine:
  - (c) for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place on any occasion of the loading of goods or other special occasions; or
  - (d) on any occasion on which it is likely by reason of some special attraction that any street in which the parking place is situated will be thronged or obstructed.

The Council may impose such charges as it considers appropriate for the purpose of recovering loss of income from parking places, which have been suspended under the provisions of this paragraph.

Any person suspending the use of a parking place or any part thereof in accordance with paragraph (iii) above shall thereupon place or cause to be placed in or adjacent to that parking place or the part thereof the use of which is suspended a traffic sign indicating that waiting by vehicles is prohibited."

- 5 The title of Schedule 8.10 to the Principal Order shall be amended to:
  - "Schedule 8.10: On-Street Parking Places with 6 Hour Limit (No Return within Same Day) 8am-6pm, Monday-Friday with an exemption for Permit Holders"
- 6 The title of Schedule 8.12 to the Principal Order shall be amended to:

"Schedule 8.12: Off-Street Parking Places with 6 Hour Limit (No Return within Same Day) 8am-6pm, Monday-Friday with an exemption for Permit Holders"
