



**THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON
(NORTHAM) (RESIDENTS PARKING SCHEME) ORDER 2018**

Southampton City Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 33, 35, 45, 46, 49 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Office of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the 1984 Act hereby makes the following Order:

PART ONE – INTRODUCTION

CITATION

- 1.1** This order shall come into operation on the 21st September 2019 and may be cited as The City of Southampton (Northam) (Residents Parking Scheme) Order 2018.

INTERPRETATION

- 1.2** In this Order, except where otherwise stated, any reference to an Article or Schedule shall be construed as a reference to that article or schedule in this Order.
- 1.3** In this Order any reference to an Act, Statutory Instrument, Regulation or Order shall be construed as a reference to that Act, Statutory Instrument or Order as amended.
- 1.4** In this Order the following expressions shall have the respective meanings assigned to them:
- "Civil Enforcement Officer" means a person appointed in accordance with the provisions of Section 76 Traffic Management Act 2004.
- "Council" means Southampton City Council.
- "Disabled Persons Vehicle" means a vehicle displaying a valid disabled persons badge in accordance with The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000.
- "Displaying" in the case of a vehicle fitted with a transparent windscreen, means on the inside surface of the windscreen on the nearside so that it is facing upwards and can be entirely and easily seen from outside the vehicle; or in the case of a vehicle which is not fitted with a transparent windscreen, in a conspicuous position on the vehicle.
- "Goods Vehicle" means a motor vehicle constructed or adapted for use for the carriage of goods, or a trailer so constructed or adapted and which said motor vehicle is physically constructed or adapted so as to prohibit the carrying of passengers (other than front seat passengers) but (for the avoidance of doubt) does not include estate motor vehicles or hatchback vehicles which may be so adapted.
- "Invalid Carriage" has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
- "Light Goods Vehicle" means a Motor Vehicle, the maximum gross weight of which does not exceed 3.5 tonnes, which is constructed or adapted for use for the carriage of goods or burden of any description, and is not drawing a trailer.
- "Motor Cycle" has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
- "Motor Vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

"Owner", in relation to a vehicle, means the person by whom such vehicle is kept and used and in determining who the owner of a vehicle was at any time it shall be presumed that the owner was the person in whose name the vehicle was at that time registered under the Vehicle Excise and Registration Act 1994.

"Parking Permit Holder" means a person to whom a Parking Permit has been issued.

"Parking Permit" means a document issued by the Council under the provisions of this Order which exempts a vehicle from certain parking restrictions.

"Parking Place" means any parking area on-street as defined in article 2.1 and any parking area off-street as defined in article 2.2.

"Passenger Vehicle/s" means a Motor Vehicle (other than a Motor Cycle or Invalid Carriage) constructed solely for the carriage of passengers and their effects and adapted to carry not more than twelve passengers exclusive of the Driver, and not drawing a trailer.

"Permit" means a document issued by the Council under the provisions of this Order which exempts a vehicle from certain parking restrictions. The different types of Permits are specified in schedule 1.0.4.

"Permit Entitlement Register" means the database managed by the Council which specifies the type and number of Permits a property is eligible for a defined Zone.

"Residents Parking Zone" means an area in which parking is restricted primarily for the benefit of residents. Each zone is identified by either a number or letter(s).

"Restricted Hours" means

- the period 8am to 6pm, Monday to Saturday for the road lengths described in schedules 2.2.1 and 7.2.5 and
- the period 8am to 10pm, on all days, for the road lengths described in schedule 6.1.2 and the off-street parking places designated in schedule 9.0.1

"Vehicle" means a mechanically propelled vehicle, intended or adapted for use on roads.

"Waiver Certificate" means a certificate duly issued on behalf of the Council for the purposes of Article 5, permitting a specified vehicle to wait in specified circumstances on a length or lengths of roads where the waiting of that vehicle would otherwise be restricted or prohibited.

"Zone" means a Residents Parking Zone.

1.5 "Principle Order 1" shall mean The City of Southampton (Northam) (Residents Parking Scheme) Order 2018.

1.6 "Principle Order 2" shall mean The City of Southampton (Northam, Bitterne Manor & Itchen) (Residents' Parking Scheme) Order 2008 (as amended)

PART TWO – PARKING PLACES

DESIGNATION OF PARKING PLACES

- 2.1** Each on-street area described in the schedules described in column 2 of schedules 6.1.2 and 7.2.5, having a width as indicated by the road markings, or in the case of signed only areas a width that extends across the whole of the side of the carriage way specified, is designated as a parking place.
- 2.2** Each off-street car park described in schedule 9.01, with extents as indicated by bay markings, is designated as a parking place.

USE OF PARKING PLACES

- 2.3** A vehicle left in a Parking Place must be parked wholly within the boundary of that parking place.
- 2.4** No vehicle left in a Parking Place shall be in a position which prevents access to any premises or which obstructs other road users.
- 2.5** The driver of a Motor Vehicle using a Parking Place must stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position and must not start the engine except to change the position of the vehicle or depart from the Parking Place.
- 2.6** Unless the prior written consent of the Council is obtained no vehicle left in a Parking Place shall be used in connection with the sale of any goods or services except where goods (including postal parcels) are being delivered to any premises in the immediate area.
- 2.7** The Council may also, at its discretion, further designate by signing or marking, off-street parking bays for use by a class of vehicle or class of user.

SUSPENSION OF PARKING PLACES

- 2.8** The Council or any person so authorised by the Council may suspend or revoke the use of any Parking Place or part of a Parking Place without prior notice.
- 2.9** No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait in a Parking Place which has been suspended.

PERMIT PARKING OR LIMITED WAITING

- 2.10** No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the Parking Places described in schedules 6.1.2 and 9.0.1 of this Order, during the Restricted Hours, for longer than the 1 hour unless that vehicle is displaying a valid Permit.
- 2.11** No person shall cause or permit any vehicle waiting in the Parking Places described in schedules 6.1.2 and 9.0.1 of this Order, during the Restricted Hours, to return to any Parking Place in the same street within the same day (or the same off-street Parking Place), unless that vehicle is displaying a valid Permit.
- 2.12** No Vehicle shall be left in a parking place signed or marked for a designated class of vehicle or class of user within the Off-Street Parking places defined in Schedule 9.01 of this Order, unless the vehicle is registered as that class of vehicle or class of user, and is displaying a valid Permit.

LIMITED WAITING

- 2.13** No Vehicle shall be left in a parking place described in schedule 7.2.5 of this Order, during the Restricted Hours, for longer than the 1 hour.
- 2.14** No vehicle left in a parking place described in schedule 7.2.5 of this Order, during the Restricted Hours, shall return to return to any Parking Place in the same street within the same day.

PART THREE – PERMITS

APPLICATION FOR AND ISSUE OF PERMITS

- 3.1** An application for a Parking Permit must be made in the manner specified by the Council.
- 3.2** The Council may require an applicant for a Parking Permit to produce such evidence as considered necessary to verify the information provided as part of the application for a Parking Permit.

- 3.3** A Parking Permit which is a Residents Parking Permit may only be issued:
- a) to the owner of the vehicle to which the Parking Permit will apply
 - b) in respect of a vehicle which is a Passenger Vehicle, Light Goods Vehicle or a Motorcycle.
- 3.4** An application for a Permit must be made in a manner specified by the Council.
- 3.5** The Council may require an applicant to produce such evidence as considered necessary to verify any information submitted.
- 3.6** A Permit may only be issued by the Council to an applicant who meets the eligibility criteria specified in column 5 of schedule 1.0.4.
- 3.7** The charge for issuing a permit shall be as specified in column 2 of schedule 1.0.4.
- 3.8** A duplicate of a permit may be issued by the Council if the original permit has been lost, stolen or becomes mutilated, defaced, faded, discoloured or otherwise illegible.
- 3.9** The charge for issuing a duplicate permit shall be as specified in column 3 of Schedule 1.0.4.
- 3.10** Notwithstanding the preceding articles, the issuing of Permits is at the complete discretion of the Council. Exceptional issues of Permits may be undertaken and limits on the number of Permits issued may be set as considered appropriate.

FORM OF PARKING PERMITS

- 3.11** A Parking Permit shall be in writing and shall include the following particulars:
- (a) Where the Parking Permit is a Residents Parking Permit the registration mark of the vehicle to which the Parking Permit applies
 - (b) The expiry date of the Parking Permit
 - (c) An indication that the Parking Permit was issued by the Council

VALIDITY OF PERMITS

- 3.12** A Permit shall not be valid when used in contravention of the conditions of use specified in column 6 of Schedule 1.0.4, or in contravention of any other terms or conditions of use set out by the Council.
- 3.13** A Parking Permit shall only be valid within the Residents Parking Zone(s) in respect of which it was issued
- 3.14** A Permit shall permanently cease to be valid in the following circumstances:
- a) After the expiry date specified on it.
 - b) The Permit holder ceases to meet the eligibility criteria.
 - c) The Permit holder ceases to be the owner of the vehicle for which the Permit was issued.
 - d) The vehicle for which the Permit was issued has been adapted, modified or used in such a manner that it is not a vehicle of the class eligible for the Permit.
 - e) The withdrawal of the Permit by the Council.
 - f) The surrender of the Permit to the Council.
 - g) The issue of a duplicate Permit by the Council.
 - h) The payment for the Permit fails to clear.
 - i) The Council believes the Permit is being used in a dishonest or fraudulent manner, or intentionally used in contravention of the conditions of use set out by the Council, or the Permit holder has abused or intimidated Council staff.

WITHDRAWAL AND SURRENDER OF PERMITS

- 3.15** A Permit holder may surrender the Permit to the Council at any time.
- 3.16** A Permit holder shall surrender the Permit to the Council when it permanently ceases to be valid.
- 3.17** The Council may serve notice to withdraw a Permit; on receipt of this notice the Permit holder shall surrender the Permit within 48 hours.
- 3.18** The notice specified in article 3.17 shall be served to the Permit holder at the address given on their application or at any other address believed to be the Permit holder's residence or place of business.
- 3.19** When a Permit is surrendered or withdrawn a pro rata refund for each whole unexpired calendar month for which the permit would have been valid shall be paid to the permit holder; unless the Council believes the permit has been used in a dishonest or fraudulent manner, or intentionally used in contravention of its conditions of use set out by the Council, or the Permit holder has abused or intimidated Council staff.

MISHANDLING OF PARKING DOCUMENTS

- 3.20** The Parking Services Manager or any employee of the Council working on his behalf, and all Civil Enforcement Officers are authorised to act in accordance with Section 116 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

PART FOUR – WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS

PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING

- 4.1** No Vehicle shall wait in the lengths of road specified in schedule 2.0.1 of this Order to which a no waiting at any time restriction applies.
- 4.2** No Vehicle shall wait in the lengths of road specified in schedule 2.2.1 of this Order to which a no waiting during restricted hours restriction applies during the Restricted Hours.

PART FIVE – EXEMPTIONS

GENERAL EXEMPTIONS

- 5.1** Nothing in this Order shall prohibit any vehicle from stopping or waiting for as long as reasonably necessary in the following circumstances:
 - (a) The vehicle is directed to stop or wait by or with the permission of a police officer or Civil Enforcement Officer in uniform
 - (b) The vehicle is being used for emergency services purposes
 - (c) To prevent a road traffic collision
 - (d) The vehicle cannot be moved due to an unavoidable breakdown
 - (e) the vehicle, not being a Passenger Vehicle, is stopped or waiting only for so long as may be reasonably necessary to enable it to be used for the purpose of any building operation, demolition or excavation or the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any said lengths of road or the laying erection, alteration, removal or repair of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or any telegraphic line or traffic sign in any said lengths of road

- (f) the vehicle, not being a Passenger Vehicle, is in actual use in connection with the removal of furniture from one office or dwelling house to another or the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository, provided that notice is given twenty-four hours in advance to the Council and their consent is obtained and any conditions imposed are complied with
- (g) The vehicle is being used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets

PROHIBITION OF WAITING EXEMPTIONS

5.2 Nothing in articles 4.1 or 4.2 shall apply to a vehicle waiting for as long as necessary in the following circumstances:

- (a) The vehicle is waiting for the purposes of loading or unloading that vehicle, provided the loading/unloading is continuous and being undertaken in a timely manner, the goods being loaded/unloaded cannot reasonably be carried other than by means of a vehicle, the vehicle is waiting adjacent to where the goods are being loaded/unloaded from/to and the length of time the vehicle is waiting for is reasonable
- (b) To allow the picking up or setting down of passengers
- (c) The vehicle is a cleaning or refuse vehicle collecting rubbish in the immediate vicinity;
- (d) The vehicle is waiting for the purpose of removing an obstruction to traffic
- (e) The vehicle is a liveried utility company vehicle being used in connection with works of that utility in the immediate vicinity
- (f) The vehicle is a Disabled Persons Vehicle, provided the vehicle does not wait for longer than three hours and at least one hour has elapsed following a previous period of waiting by the vehicle in the same road or part of a road
- (g) The vehicle is displaying a valid Waiver Certificate

LIMITED WAITING EXEMPTIONS

5.3 Nothing in articles 2.13 or 2.14 shall apply to a vehicle waiting for as long as necessary in the following circumstances:

- (a) The vehicle is a Disabled Persons Vehicle
- (b) The vehicle is a cleaning or refuse vehicle collecting rubbish in the immediate vicinity
- (c) The vehicle is a liveried utility company vehicle being used in connection with works of that utility in the immediate vicinity
- (d) The vehicle is a wedding car or hearse and is being used in connection with a wedding or funeral cortege in the immediate vicinity
- (e) The vehicle is displaying a valid Waiver Certificate

PERMIT PARKING OR LIMITED WAITING EXEMPTIONS

5.4 Nothing in articles 2.10, or 2.11 shall apply to a vehicle waiting for as long as necessary in the following circumstances:

- (a) The vehicle is a Disabled Persons Vehicle
- (b) The vehicle is a cleaning or refuse vehicle collecting rubbish in the immediate vicinity
- (c) The vehicle is a liveried utility company vehicle being used in connection with works of that utility in the immediate vicinity
- (d) The vehicle is a wedding car or hearse and is being used in connection with a wedding or funeral cortege in the immediate vicinity

- (e) The vehicle is displaying a valid Waiver Certificate

5.5 Nothing in articles 2.12 shall apply to a vehicle waiting for as long as necessary in the following circumstances:

- (a) The vehicle is a cleaning or refuse vehicle collecting rubbish in the immediate vicinity and no alternative parking bay is available
- (b) The vehicle is a liveried utility company vehicle being used in connection with works of that utility in the immediate vicinity and no alternative parking bay is available

EXEMPTIONS FOR DISABLED PERSONS VEHICLES

5.5 The exemptions specified in article 5 shall not apply to a Disabled Person's Vehicle which has been left or is waiting in a position which endangers, inconveniences or obstructs pedestrians or other road users, or which has been left or is waiting in a manner contrary to the blue badge rights and responsibilities guidance issued by the Department for Transport or other authority.

PART SIX – CONTRAVENTION, AMENDMENTS, ADDITIONS & REVOCATIONS

CONTRAVENTION

6.1 Any vehicle failing to comply with the provisions of this Order shall be in contravention and a penalty charge shall be payable.

AMENDMENTS / ADDITIONS

- a) The contents below shall be inserted as a new Article 12A in Principle Order 2

"12A VALIDITY OF PERMITS

A Parking Permit shall only be valid within the Residents Parking Zone(s) in respect of which it was issued."

- b) The contents of Schedule 1A shall be deleted from Schedule 2.01 of Principle Order 2
- c) The contents of Schedule 1B shall be deleted from Schedule 2.07 of Principle Order 2
- d) The contents of Schedule 1C shall be deleted from Schedule 5.09 of Principle Order 2
- e) The contents of Schedule 1D shall be deleted from Schedule 6.02 of Principle Order 2
- f) Schedule 2.0.1 shall be a new schedule within Principle Order 1
- g) Schedule 2.2.1 shall be a new schedule within Principle Order 1
- h) Schedule 6.1.2 shall be a new schedule within Principle Order 1
- i) Schedule 7.2.5 shall be a new schedule within Principle Order 1
- j) Schedule 9.0.1 shall be a new schedule within Principle Order 1
