

THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT 1) ORDER 2019

Southampton City Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 32, 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Office of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the 1984 Act hereby makes the following Order:

CITATION


1 This Order shall come into operation on the 9th November 2020 and may be cited as The City of Southampton (Off-Street Parking Places) (Amendment 1) Order 2019.

INTERPRETATION

- 2 In this Order:
 - (i) "Principal Order" means The City of Southampton (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2019.
 - (ii) Except where otherwise stated, any reference to an article or schedule shall be construed as a reference to that article or schedule in this order.
 - (iii) Any reference to an enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactments.

AMENDMENTS

- The contents of Article 2.16 of the Principal Order shall be deleted and replaced with the following:
 - "No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be left in those Parking Places specified as "Pay & Display" in column 5 of schedule 1, during the hours specified in column 3 of schedule 1, unless:
 - (a) the appropriate charge for the length of stay, as specified in schedule 2 in accordance with the relevant parking tariff specified in column 4 of schedule 1, has been paid; or
 - (b) a valid Parking Permit is displayed in the case of a vehicle fitted with a transparent windscreen, so that it is facing upwards and can be entirely and easily seen from outside the vehicle; or in the case of a vehicle which is not fitted with a transparent windscreen, in a conspicuous position on the vehicle, or
 - (c) The vehicle is a Disabled Persons Vehicle left in one of the following car parks: Amoy Street, Bevois Valley Road, Bond Street, Civic Centre Forecourt, College Street, Compton Walk, Crosshouse Hard, Gloucester Square, Handford Place, James Street, Mayflower Park, Northam Road, Ordnance Road, Six Dials, Southampton Street, The Quays North, The Quays South, Toys R Us North, Toys R Us South, Trinity Road, West Park (MSCP) and Wilton Avenue."



- 4 The contents of schedule 1 to the Principal Order shall be deleted and replaced with the contents of Schedule 1.
- 5 The contents of schedule 2 to the Principal Order shall be deleted and replaced with the contents of Schedule 2.
- The contents of schedule 4 to the Principal Order shall be deleted and replaced with the contents of Schedule 3.
