

THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO 8) ORDER 2014

Southampton City Council (hereinafter called "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 32, 33, 35, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Office of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:

CITATION

1 This Order shall come into operation on 6th June 2014 and may be cited as The City of Southampton (Off-Street Parking Places) (Amendment No 8) Order 2014.

INTERPRETATION

- 2 In this Order:
 - (i) "Principal Order" shall mean the City of Southampton (Off-Street Parking Places) Traffic Regulation Order 2009, as amended.
 - (ii) Except where otherwise stated, any reference to an Article or Schedule shall be construed as a reference to that Article or Schedule in this Order.
 - (iii) Any reference to an enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactments.

CHANGES TO INTERPRETATION

- 3 In Article 2(A) of the Principal Order the following expressions and meanings shall be replaced as follows:
 - (i) ""Charging Days" means those days other than Christmas Day and Easter Sunday which are specified in Schedules 9.01 to 9.16 for each parking place respectively."
 - (ii) ""Parking Place" means an area of land specified by name in Schedules 9.01 to 9.16 and provided by the Council pursuant to Section 32(1) of the Act for the purpose of vehicle parking and not closed (in part or in whole) by a Notice erected thereon by authority of the Council."

USE OF PARKING PLACES

- 4 The contents of paragraph (i) of Article 4 of the Principal Order shall be replaced with the following contents:
 - "Each parking place in Schedules 9.01 to 9.16 may be used in accordance herewith for the parking of all vehicles except:
 - (a) vehicles exceeding 3.5 tonnes gross vehicle weight and vehicles adapted to carry more than 8 passengers exclusive of the driver except as provided under paragraph (e) below;

- (b) vehicles drawing trailers in Grosvenor Square, Eastgate Street, Marlands, Salisbury Street and West Park Road multi-storey car parks;
- (c) vehicles, any part of which exceeds 2.05 metres in height in Grosvenor Square, Eastgate Street, Marlands, Salisbury Street multi-storey car parks or 1.88 metres in height in West Park Road car park; and
- (d) vehicles of any description in Bargate Street car park, unless they are parked for the purpose of using the Shopmobility Scheme and display in a prominent position, so that it is facing forwards and can be entirely and easily seen from in front of the vehicle, a valid permit in writing issued by the operators of the Shopmobility Scheme, authorising the vehicle to be parked and clearly indicating the period of validity of the permit.
- (e) in the Bus parking place in Mayflower car park, which may be only be used by buses and then for a maximum period of stay of 10 hours, within the same day, without charge."

THE POSITION OF VEHICLES

- The contents of paragraphs (i) of Article 5 of the Principal Order will be replaced with the following:
 - "Motor cycles and pedal cycles permitted in the parking places shown in Schedules 9.01 to 9.16 and specified in Article 4, shall be positioned in bays marked "motor cycles" on the parking place, except in certain car parks which require a special manner of parking, as specified in Schedules 9.01 to 9.16."
- The contents of paragraphs (ii) of Article 5 of the Principal Order will be replaced with the following:
 - "All other vehicles permitted to wait in the parking places, as shown Schedules 9.01 to 9.16 and specified in Article 4, shall be positioned in any other bays marked on the parking place, except in certain car parks which require a special manner of parking, as specified in Schedules 9.01 to 9.16."

MOVEMENT OF VEHICLES IN A PARKING PLACE IN EMERGENCIES

7 The contents of paragraph (ii) of Article 12 of the Principal Order shall be replaced with the following:

"Where a vehicle is left in a parking place in a position other than that specified in Article 5 and Schedules 9.01 to 9.16, a Police Constable in uniform or any other person duly authorised by the Council may move the vehicle or cause it to be moved to a position which complies with that specified in Article 5 and Schedules 9.01 to 9.16."

PAY AND DISPLAY PARKING TICKETS

- 8 The contents of Article 17 of the Principal Order, shall be replaced with the following:
 - "The driver of a vehicle left in accordance with the provisions of this Order during any charging period(s) or part(s) thereof in any parking place shown in Schedules 9.01, 9.02, 9.05, 9.06, 9.07, 9.08, 9.09, 9.10, 9.12, 9.13, 9.14, 9.15 and 9.16 shall purchase a valid parking ticket at the tariffs stated in Schedules 9.00A and 9.00B for the relevant charging periods for the length of stay, on the day of purchase and exhibit the parking ticket on the vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Article 18(ii), except where:
 - (i) Car Club vehicles are parked in designated Car Club bays; or
 - (ii) Buses in the bus parking place in Mayflower Park Car Park."

- 9 The contents of Article 18 of the Principal Order, shall be replaced with the following:
 - "A parking ticket used in a parking place shown in Schedules 9.01, 9.02, 9.05, 9.06, 9.07, 9.08, 9.09, 9.10, 9.12, 9.13, 9.14, 9.15 and 9.16 shall only be a valid parking ticket if:
 - (i) it has been purchased from a ticket machine situated in the parking place where the vehicle is left or in another parking place that has the same car park code;
 - (ii) it is exhibited on the vehicle:
 - (a) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a transparent windscreen, by exhibiting the ticket behind the windscreen at the near side of the vehicle so that the front of the ticket is clearly and entirely visible from outside the vehicle; or
 - (b) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a transparent windscreen, by exhibiting the ticket in a conspicuous position at the front or near side of the vehicle so that the front of the ticket is clearly and entirely visible from outside the vehicle; AND
 - (iii) it has been so purchased and displayed in accordance with the following provisions:
 - (a) in the parking places specified in 9.01, 9.02, 9.05, 9.06, 9.07, 9.08, 9.09, 9.10, 9.12, 9.13 9.14, 9.15 and 9.16, one ticket per vehicle shall be valid either from the time of purchase or if purchased when parking charges are not applicable from the beginning of the next following daytime charging period to the expiry time specified on the ticket so however that no such ticket shall be valid after the vehicle has exceeded within any daytime charging period the maximum period of waiting (if any) specified in Article 10;
 - (b) in the parking place specified in Schedule 9.06, one ticket per vehicle shall be valid at any time on the day of purchase for the period of 2 hours commencing either at the time and date specified on that ticket or, if purchased outside daytime charging hours, at the commencement of the next following period of daytime charging hours."

PEDAL CYCLES AND MOTOR CYCLES

10 The contents of Article 21 of the Principal Order shall be replaced with the following:

"The driver of a motor cycle or a pedal cycle which is left in accordance with the provisions of this Order in a parking place in the position specified for such vehicles as specified in Article 5 and Schedules 9.01 to 9.10, 9.12 to 9.16, shall be exempt from purchasing a parking ticket."

DISABLED PERSONS' AND ESSENTIAL VISITORS' VEHICLES

- 11 The contents paragraph (i) of Article 22 of the Principal Order shall be replaced with the following:
 - (a) "The driver of a vehicle left in accordance with the provisions of this Order in a parking place, shown in Schedules 9.01, 9.02, 9.05, 9.06, 9.07, 9.08, 9.09, 9.10, 9.12, 9.13, 9.14, 9.15 and 9.16 shall be exempt from purchasing a parking ticket if the vehicle is a vehicle which displays a Disabled Person's Badge in the manner prescribed by Regulation 12 of the Disabled Person's (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000; and
 - (b) The driver of a vehicle left in accordance with the provisions of this Order in a parking place, shown in Schedules 9.01, 9.02, 9.05, 9.06, 9.07, 9.08, 9.09, 9.10, 9.12, 9.13, 9.14, 9.15 and 9.16 shall be exempt from purchasing a parking ticket a vehicle which displays a valid Essential Visitors' Parking Permit issued and used in accordance with the provisions of the City of Southampton (First Controlled Zone) Traffic Regulation Order 2012, as amended."

ABSENCE OF TICKET MACHINE

12 The contents of Article 23 of the Principal Order shall be replaced with the following:

"If at the time when a vehicle is left in a parking place shown in Schedules 9.01, 9.02, 9.05, 9.06, 9.07, 9.08, 9.09, 9.10, 9.12, 9.13 9.14, 9.15 and 9.16 there is no ticket machine at the parking place, or all the ticket machines at that parking place carry notices placed upon them by a person duly authorised by the Council indicating that they are out of order, the driver of that vehicle shall be exempt from purchasing a parking ticket."

CONTRAVENTIONS

13 The contents of Article 28 of the Principal Order shall be replaced with the following:

"If a vehicle is left in a parking place referred to in Schedules 9.01 to 9.16 without complying with the requirements of this Order, a contravention shall have occurred and a penalty charge shall be payable."



1) "Decrementing Cards" are pre-payment cards for use in Bedford Place, Eastgate Street, Grosvenor Square and Marlands MSCP's. A 20% discount is applied except at Marlands MSCP.
2) B & PH = Bank & Public Holidays (excluding Christmas Day and Easter Sunday).
3) For the Civic Centre forecourt, Monday to Friday there is lower charge of 10p for up to 30 minutes stay, for cash payments only.
4) For the Mayflower Park car park charges apply from half an hour after sunset on every day of the week, for each 2 hour stay, with the exception of the bus parking bay where buses may park without charge for a maximum stay of 10 hours in the same

day. For West Park Road Car Park, the day time charging period ends at 10pm.

5) The maximum stay period apply, the day time charging period and will extend to the commencement of the next day time charging period, when the maximum stay period extends after 6pm. Vehicles parking during the Day Time charging period and will extend to the commencement of the next day time charging period.

Overnight charging period (except Mayflower Park) will be subject to discrete tariffs for both periods. The Limitation on Return only applies during the next day time charging period, will require a further ticket purchase may only apply to the Day Time and Overnight charging periods on the day of purchase. To stay over into the next day time charging period, will require a further ticket purchase between Midnight and 8am
