

THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON (BULK DISCOUNT) ORDER 2014

Southampton City Council (hereinafter called "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 32, 33, 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, ("the Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Office of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:

CITATION

1 This Order shall come into operation on 11th August 2014 and may be cited as The City of Southampton (Bulk Discount) Order 2014.

INTERPRETATION

- 2 In this Order:
 - (i) "Principal Order 1" shall mean the City of Southampton (Off-Street Parking Places) Traffic Regulation Order 2009, as amended.
 - (ii) "Principal Order 2" shall mean the City of Southampton (First Controlled Zone) Traffic Regulation Order 2012.
 - (iii) Except where otherwise stated, any reference to an Article or Schedule shall be construed as a reference to that Article or Schedule in this Order.
 - (iv) Any reference to an enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactments.

BULK DISCOUNT AND SEASON TICKET AMENDMENTS

- 3 Article 24 of Principle Order 1 shall be renamed "SEASON TICKETS".
- 4 The contents of Article 24 of Principle Order 1 shall be deleted and replaced with the following:
 - "(i) A Season Ticket shall be available for the parking places specified in schedule 9.00C, subject to any limits on issue and at the discretion of the Council. The Season Ticket may be used for up to two nominated vehicles by the holder, providing that the vehicles comply with the requirements of Article 4 of this order and are not motorcycles.
 - (ii) The driver of a vehicle left at any time in accordance with the provisions of this Order in a parking place as specified in paragraph (i) shall be exempt from purchasing a parking ticket if there is displayed in the manner prescribed for parking tickets in Article 18(ii) a valid Season Ticket purchased from the Council.
 - (iii) The price of a Season Ticket shall be as specified in schedule 9.00C.
 - (iv) An Overnight Season Ticket shall be available for the parking places specified in schedule 9.00C, subject to any limits on issue and at the discretion of the Council. The Overnight Season Ticket may be used for up to two nominated vehicles by the holder,

providing that the vehicles comply with the requirements of Article 4 of this order and are not motorcycles.

- (v) The driver of a vehicle left during overnight charging hours in accordance with the provisions of this Order, in a parking place as specified in Schedule 9.00C of this order, shall be exempt from purchasing a parking ticket if there is displayed in the manner prescribed for parking tickets in Article 18(ii) a valid Overnight Season Ticket purchased from the Council.
- (vi) If a driver using a valid Overnight Season Ticket leaves a vehicle in any of the parking places specified in Schedule 9.03 and 9.04 of this order and does not remove that vehicle from the parking place until part of the next daytime charging period has elapsed, the driver will need to pay for the additional stay before exiting the car park. In the other car parks shown in Schedule 9.00C where Overnight Season Tickets are valid for use, vehicles may only stay over into the next day time charging period with the purchase of the appropriate Pay & Display ticket for the intended period of stay, prior to the commencement of that day time charging period.
- (vii) Subject to the provisions of paragraph (vi) above, the price of an Overnight Season Ticket shall be £150 for 12 months.
- (viii) If a Season Ticket or Overnight Season Ticket is lost or destroyed, the permit holder may apply to the Council for the issue of a duplicate ticket and the Council, upon being satisfied as to such loss or destruction, shall issue a duplicate ticket so marked and upon such issue the first ticket shall become invalid.
- (ix) The charge for a duplicate Season Ticket or Overnight Season Ticket issued under the provisions of paragraph (viii) above shall be £13.00.
- (x) Any season ticket holder may surrender the ticket to the Council at any time and, upon the surrender of the ticket, the Council shall refund a due proportion of the price of the permit in respect of each complete unexpired calendar month for which the permit would have been valid."
- (xi) The driver of a vehicle left in accordance with the provisions of this Order, in the College Street Car Park shall be exempt from purchasing a parking ticket if there is displayed in the manner prescribed for parking tickets in Article 18(ii) a valid On-Street Season Ticket as defined in the City of Southampton (First Controlled Zone) Traffic Regulation Order 2012.
- 5 Article 24A of Principal Order 1 shall be renamed "BULK DISCOUNT AGREEMENTS AND RESERVED PARKING BAYS".
- The contents of Article 24A of Principal Order 1 shall be deleted and replaced with the following:
 - "(i) The Council may, at its complete discretion, enter into agreements to sell multiple Season Tickets at a discounted rate.
 - (ii) A Season Ticket purchased under a bulk discount agreement shall be available for the parking places specified in schedule 9.00C, subject to any limits on issue and at the discretion of the Council.
 - (iii) The price of a Season Ticket under a bulk discount agreement shall be as specified in schedule 9.00C.

- (iv) Any Season Ticket purchased under a bulk discount agreement shall only be valid while that agreement continues in force and the ticket is being used in accordance with the terms thereof.
- (v) The Council may, at its complete discretion, enter into agreements to reserve a number of parking bays, in the parking places specified in schedule 9.00C, solely for use by holders of Season Tickets purchased under a bulk discount agreement.
- (vi) A parking bay under paragraph (v) shall be reserved for one of two periods:
 - (a) Day Monday to Saturday between 08:00 and 18:00 and Sunday or Bank/Public holidays between 12:00 and 18:00.
 - (b) 24/7 At all times.
- (vii) The price of a Season Ticket with a reserved bay under a Bulk discount agreement shall be as specified in schedule 9.00C.
- (viii) No person other than the holder of a valid Season Ticket with a reserved bay acting in accordance with the terms of an agreement as specified in paragraph (v) shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or remain in a parking bay during any period when it is reserved.
- (ix) No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or remain in a reserved parking bay in contravention of such signs or markings used to identify reserved parking bays and the vehicle or group of vehicles permitted to use the bays.
- 7 Schedule 9.00C to Principal Order 1 shall be deleted and replaced with Schedule 1.
- 8 The contents of Article 28A to Principal Order 2 shall be deleted and replaced with the following:
 - "(i) An On-Street Season Ticket is a season ticket, issued under the provisions of this article, which allows the valid holder to park in the following parking bays without charge: any on-street bay in College Street, Terminus Terrace, Richmond Street, Duke Street, Threefields Lane, Bernard Street, Marsh Lane, South Front and Henstead Road. The holder may also park in the College Street Car Park without charge.
 - (ii) An On-Street Season Ticket may only be purchased under the terms of a bulk discount agreement, whereby The Council may, at its complete discretion, enter into an agreement to sell multiple Season Tickets at a discounted rate.
 - (iii) The Cost of an On-Street Season Ticket shall be based on the number purchased:
 - (a) 25 to 35 tickets £1140 per ticket
 - (b) 36 to 49 tickets £1080 per ticket
 - (c) 50+ tickets £1020 per ticket
 - (iv) An Evening and Weekend Season Ticket is a season ticket allowing the valid holder, issued under the provisions of this article, to park in parking places specified in Schedules 8.02, 8.03, 8.04, and 8.05 without charge during any Evening Charging Hours and during the Daytime Charging hours on Saturday, Sunday and Bank/Public holidays, at a cost of £400 per year.
 - (v) Any resident, occupying a property with agreed entitlement by the Council, who:

- (a) is the owner of a vehicle of the following class, that is to say a passenger vehicle or, a goods vehicle, not exceeding 3 tonnes in weight or 5m in length or a motorcycle.
- (b) with the permission of the owner uses a vehicle of the said class on a regular basis during the course of his employment, and

may apply to the Council for the issue of an Evening Season Ticket or Evening and Weekend Season Ticket for the leaving of that vehicle, and any such application shall be made on a form issued by and obtainable from the Council and shall include the particulars and information required by such form to be supplied.

- (vi) The Council may at any time require an applicant or holder of an Evening Season Ticket or Evening and Weekend Season Ticket to produce to an officer of the Council such evidence in respect of an application for a season ticket made to them as they may reasonably require to verify any particulars or information given to them or in respect of any season ticket issued by them as they may reasonably require to verify that the season ticket is valid.
- (vii) On receipt of an application duly made under the foregoing provisions of this Article the Council, upon being satisfied that the applicant is eligible to apply for a season ticket under the terms of paragraph (v) above, shall subject to the payment of the stipulated charge issue to the applicant one Evening Season Ticket or Evening and Weekend Season Ticket for the leaving, in accordance with the provisions of this Article of the vehicle to which such season ticket relates by the owners of such vehicle or by any person using such vehicle with the consent of the owner other than a person to whom such vehicle has been let for hire or reward:

PROVIDED THAT the Council shall not issue an Evening Season Ticket or Evening and Weekend Season Ticket to any postal address which would be valid for any period during which two of these season tickets issued to that postal address would be valid.

- (viii) The driver of a vehicle left in accordance with the provisions of this Order in a parking place as specified in paragraph (i), (iii) and (iv) shall be exempt from purchasing a parking ticket if there is valid season ticket purchased from the Council for applicable charging periods defined in paragraph (i), (iii) and (iv) clearly displayed.
- (ix) If an On-Street Season Ticket, Evening Season Ticket or Evening and Weekend Season Ticket is lost or destroyed, the permit holder may apply to the Council for the issue of a duplicate ticket and the Council, upon being satisfied as to such loss or destruction, shall issue a duplicate ticket so marked and upon such issue the first ticket shall become invalid.
- (x) The charge for a duplicate season ticket issued under the provisions of paragraph (ix) above shall be £13.00."
- (xi) Any On-Street Season Ticket, Evening Season Ticket or Evening and Weekend Season Ticket holder may surrender the ticket to the Council at any time and, upon the surrender of the ticket, the Council shall refund a due proportion of the price of the ticket in respect of each complete unexpired calendar month for which the ticket would have been valid.
- (xii) The Council may, by notice in writing, withdraw a Evening Season Ticket or Evening and Weekend Season Ticket if it appears to the Council that any one of the events set out in paragraph (xiii) of this Article has occurred and the Evening Season Ticket or Evening and Weekend Season Ticket holder shall surrender the permit to the Council within 48 hours of the receipt of the aforementioned Notice.

- (xiii) The events referred to in the foregoing provisions of this Article are:
 - (a) the holder of an Evening Season Ticket or Evening and Weekend Season Ticket ceases to occupy a property, with entitlement, as defined by the Council.
 - (b) the Evening Season Ticket or Evening and Weekend Season Ticket holder ceasing to be the owner of the vehicle in respect of which the permit was issued.
 - (c) the withdrawal of such permit by the Council.
 - (d) the vehicle in respect of which such permit was issued being adapted or used in such a manner that it is not a vehicle of the class specified in this Article.
 - (e) the issue of a duplicate permit by the Council under the provisions of this Order; and
 - (f) the Evening Season Ticket or Evening and Weekend Season Ticket ceasing to be valid pursuant to the provisions of paragraph (xiv) of this Article.
 - (g) in the view of the Council the Evening Season Ticket or Evening and Weekend Season Ticket has been used in contravention of the instructions and conditions of use, or payment for Evening Season Ticket or Evening and Weekend Season Ticket has not cleared.
- (xiv) Without prejudice to the foregoing provisions of this Article an Evening Season Ticket or Evening and Weekend Season Ticket shall cease to be valid at the expiration of the period specified thereon or on the occurrence of anyone of the events set out in paragraph (xiii) (a), (b), (c), (d), (e), (f) or (g) of this Article, whichever is the earlier."


- The meaning of "Daytime Charging Hours" in Article 2(A) of Principal Order 1 shall be deleted and replaced with the following:
 - ""Daytime Charging Hours" means the period between 12 noon and 18.00 hours, on those charging days which are Sundays, Bank or Public Holidays, and the period between 08.00 hours and 18.00 hours on all other charging days, except:
 - (a) in Mayflower Park car park, where it means the period from sunrise to sunset on all charging day.
 - (b) in West Park Road car park, where it means the period between 08.00 hours and 22.00 hours on all charging days.
 - (c) in the Toys R Us North and South Car Parks, where it means the period between 8.00 hours and 18.00 on all charging days".
- 10 The content of Schedule 9.00A to Principal Order 1 shall be deleted and replaced with the content of Schedule 2.

1) "Decrementing Cards" are pre-payment cards for use in Bedford Place, Eastgate Street, Grosvenor Square and Marlands MSCP's. A 20% discount is applied except at Marlands MSCP.

B & PH = Bank & Public Holidays (excluding Christmas Day and Easter Sunday).

3) For the Civic Centre forecourt, Monday to Friday there is lower charge of 10p for up to 30 minutes stay, for cash payments only.

4) For the Mayflower Park car park charges apply from half an hour before sunrise to half an hour after sunset on every day of the week, for each 2 hour stay, with the exception of the bus parking bay where buses may park without charge for a maximum stay of 10 hours in the same day. For West Park Road Car Park, the day time charging period ends at 10pm, For Toys R Us North and South Car Parks the day time charging period is 8am to 6pm Monday to Sunday including Bank and Public holidays...

5) The maximum stay period applies to the Day time charging period and will extend to the commencement of the next day time charging period, when the maximum stay period extends after 6pm. Vehicles parking during the Day Time charging period (except Mayflower Park) will be subject to discrete tariffs for both periods. The Limitation on Return only applies during the Day Time charging period.

6) For all Pay & Display Car Parks a ticket purchase may only apply to the Day Time and Overnight charging periods on the day of purchase. To stay over into the next day time charging period, will require a further ticket purchase between Midnight and 8am
