



THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON (FIRST CONTROLLED ZONE) (AMENDMENT 23) ORDER 2017

Southampton City Council (hereinafter called "the Council") in exercise of its powers under sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:

CITATION

- 1 This Order shall come into operation on 8th May 2017 and may be cited as The City of Southampton (First Controlled Zone) (Amendment 23) Order 2017.

INTERPRETATION

- 2 In this Order:
 - (i) "Principal Order" means the City of Southampton (First Controlled Zone) Traffic Regulation Order 2012, as amended.
 - (ii) Except where otherwise stated, any reference to an Article or Schedule shall be construed as a reference to that Article or Schedule in this Order.
 - (iii) Any reference to an enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactments.

AMENDMENTS

- 3 The following shall be inserted into Article 2(A) of the Principle Order:

"Electric Vehicle" means a vehicle with a CO² emission figure of 0 g/km"
- 4 Article 28A (vii) of the Principal Order shall be deleted and replaced with the following:

"(vii) the vehicle displays a valid Season Ticket in accordance with the provisions of Article 28A"
- 5 Article 28A of the Principal Order shall be deleted and replaced with the following:

"28A SEASON TICKETS

 - (i) An application for a Season Ticket must be made in a manner specified by the Council.
 - (ii) The Council may require an applicant to produce such evidence as considered necessary to verify any information submitted.
 - (iii) A Season Ticket may be issued by the Council to an applicant who meets the eligibility criteria specified in column 7 of Schedule 1.03. Notwithstanding this, the issuing of Season Tickets is at the complete discretion of the Council. Exceptional issues of Season Tickets may be undertaken and limits on the number of Season Tickets issued may be set as considered appropriate.

- (iv) The charge for issuing a Season Ticket shall be as specified in Column 2 of Schedule 1.03. The charge for issuing a Season Ticket for use in respect of an Electric Vehicle shall be as specified in brackets in Column 2 of Schedule 1.03 where applicable.
- (v) A duplicate of a Season Ticket may be issued by the Council if the original has been lost, stolen or becomes mutilated, defaced, faded, discoloured or otherwise illegible. The charge for issuing a duplicate Season Ticket shall be £13.
- (vi) A Season Ticket shall only be valid for use in the Parking Places specified in Column 4 of Schedule 1.03, during the charging periods specified in Column 5 of Schedule 1.03.
- (vii) A Season Ticket shall not be valid when used in contravention of the conditions of use specified in column 6 of Schedule 1.03, or in contravention of any other terms or conditions of use set out by the Council.
- (viii) A Season Ticket shall permanently cease to be valid in the following circumstances:
 - (a) After the expiry date specified on it
 - (b) The Season Ticket holder ceases to meet the eligibility criteria
 - (c) The Season Ticket holder ceases to be the owner of the vehicle in respect of which the Season Ticket was issued
 - (d) The vehicle for which the Season Ticket was issued has been adapted, modified or used in such a manner that it is not a vehicle of the class eligible for the Season Ticket
 - (e) The withdrawal of the Season Ticket by the Council
 - (f) The surrender of the Season Ticket to the Council
 - (g) The issue of a duplicate Season Ticket by the Council
 - (h) The payment for the Season Ticket fails to clear
 - (i) The Council believes the Season Ticket is being used in a dishonest or fraudulent manner, or intentionally used in contravention of the conditions of use set out by the Council, or the Season Ticket holder has abused or intimidated Council staff
- (ix) A Season Ticket may be surrendered to the Council at any time and, upon the surrender of the Season Ticket, the Council shall refund a due proportion of the price of the ticket in respect of each complete unexpired calendar month for which the ticket would have been valid
- (x) The Council may serve notice to withdraw a Season Ticket; on receipt of this notice the Permit holder shall surrender the Permit within 48 hours"

6 Article 42 (ii) (a) of the Principal Order shall be deleted and replaced with the following:

"(a) The charge for the issue of a City Centre residents' permit having a validity of 1 year shall be £1000.00 (£100 for a City Centre Resident's Permit issued in respect of an Electric Vehicle), unless the applicant resides in a property rented from the Council or a registered Housing Association where the charge shall be £500.00 (£50 for a City Centre Resident's Permit issued in respect of an Electric Vehicle)"

7 The contents of schedule 1 shall be inserted into the Principal Order as a new Schedule 1.03.
