

THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON (SUBURBAN OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT 4) ORDER 2017

Southampton City Council (hereinafter called "the Council") in exercise of its powers under sections 32, 33, 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:

CITATION

1 This Order shall come into operation on 24th July 2017 and may be cited as The City of Southampton (Suburban Off-Street Parking Places) (Amendment 4) Order 2017.


INTERPRETATION

- 2 In this Order:
 - (i) "Principal Order" means The City of Southampton (Suburban Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2011, as amended.
 - (ii) Except where otherwise stated, any reference to an Article or Schedule shall be construed as a reference to that Article or Schedule in this Order.
 - (iii) Any reference to an enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactments.
