



THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON (VIOLET ROAD) (BUS GATE) ORDER 2022

Southampton City Council (hereinafter called "the Council") in exercise of its powers under sections 1, 2 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:

CITATION

- 1 This Order shall come into operation on ^{12th HH-}7th November 2022 and may be cited as The City of Southampton (Violet Road) (Bus Gate) Order 2022.

INTERPRETATION

- 2 In this Order:

- (i) "Principal Order" shall mean the City of Southampton (Bus Lanes, Bus-Only Street and Bus Gates) Order 2021, as amended.
- (ii) Except where otherwise stated, any reference to an Article or Schedule shall be construed as a reference to that Article or Schedule in this Order.
- (iii) Any reference to an enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactments.

AMENDMENTS


- 3 The contents of Schedule A to the Principal Order shall be deleted and replaced with the contents of Schedule 1.
- 4 The contents of Schedule 2 shall be inserted into Schedule 3 to the Principal Order.

Schedule 1 – Authorised Vehicles (Replacement of Schedule A to the Principal Order)

The following vehicles or classes of vehicles are Authorised Vehicles for the purposes of this order:

- (a) Hackney carriages licenced by Southampton City Council under the Town Police Clauses Act 1847
- (b) Private hire vehicles licenced by Southampton City Council under the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976
- (c) Monday to Friday between the hours of 7am – 9:30am and 4pm – 6:30pm only, hackney carriages and private hire vehicles licenced by a local authority other than Southampton City Council provided the vehicle was first registered on or after 1st September 2015 for diesel vehicles (reflecting the introduction of Euro 6b emission standards) or, on or after 1st January 2006 for petrol vehicles (reflecting the introduction of Euro 4 emission standards)
- (d) Subject to application and written approval by the Council, a vehicle adapted to carry disabled passengers being used for home to school contracts, where the costs of replacing an existing vehicle with a compliant one is substantive
- (e) For the Violet Road bus gate only, subject to application and written approval by the Council, a vehicle owned or leased by a resident of 124 Violet Road, 122 Violet Road, 120 Violet Road or 73 Violet Road provided the vehicle is only accessing or exiting the property and does so via the shortest restricted route (i.e. vehicles accessing 73 Violet Road should enter and leave from the eastern end of the restriction, and vehicles accessing the other properties should enter and leave from the western end of the restriction)
