



**THE CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON (VARIOUS ROADS)
(PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING) (AMENDMENT 71) ORDER 2020**

Southampton City Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 63 and 64 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976, Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, hereby makes the following Order:

CITATION

- 1 This Order shall come into operation on 4th July 2022 and may be cited as The City of Southampton (Various Roads) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Amendment 71) Order 2020

INTERPRETATION

- 2 In this Order:
 - (i) "Principal Order" shall mean The City of Southampton (Various Road) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2011
 - (ii) Except where otherwise stated, any reference to an Article or Schedule shall be construed as a reference to that Article or Schedule in this Order.
 - (iii) Any reference to an enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactments.

AMENDMENT

- 3 The contents of schedule 1 shall be deleted from schedule 4.02 of the Principal Order
- 4 The contents of schedule 2 shall be added to schedule a new schedule 4.19 of the Principal Order
- 5 Hackney Carriage Stands Article shall be deleted and replaced with the following

"HACKNEY CARRIAGE STANDS

- (i) No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle, except for a Hackney Carriage while waiting at a duly authorised Hackney Carriage stand, to stop in any of the lengths of the road specified in Schedule 4.01.
- (ii) No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle, except for a Hackney Carriage while waiting at a duly authorised Hackney Carriage stand, to stop in any lengths of the road specified in Schedule 4.02 between the hours of 11:30pm and 5:30am

- (iii) Any person duly authorised by the Council may suspend the use of an authorised Hackney Carriage stand or of any part thereof whenever he considers such suspension reasonably necessary:
 - (a) for the purpose of facilitating movement of traffic or promoting its safety;
 - (b) for the purpose of any building operation, demolition or excavation in or adjacent to the parking place or the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the parking place or adjacent highway or part of the highway or the laying erection alteration removal or repair in or adjacent to the parking place of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus or traffic sign;
 - (c) for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place on any occasion of the removal of furniture from one office or dwelling house to another or the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository;
 - (d) on any occasion on which it is likely by reason of some special attraction that any street will be thronged or obstructed; or
 - (e) for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place at times of weddings or funerals, or on other special occasions.
- (iv) A Police Constable in uniform may suspend for not longer than 7 days the use of an authorised Hackney Carriage stand or any part thereof whenever he considers that such suspension is reasonably necessary for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety.
- (v) Any person suspending the use of an authorised Hackney Carriage stand or any part thereof in accordance with the provisions of this Article shall thereupon place or cause to be placed in or adjacent to that parking place or part thereof the use of which is suspended such traffic signs as he may consider appropriate in the circumstances.
- (vi) No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle, except for a Hackney Carriage while waiting at a duly authorised Hackney Carriage stand, to stop in any lengths of the road specified in Schedule 4.06 between the hours of 9:00pm and 6:00am.
- (vii) No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle, except for a Hackney Carriage while waiting at a duly authorised Hackney Carriage stand, to stop in any lengths of road specified in Schedule 4.07 between the hours of 11:00pm and 5:00am.
- (viii) No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle, except for a Hackney Carriage while waiting at a duly authorised Hackney Carriage stand, to stop in any lengths of road specified in Schedule 4.19 between the hours of 10:00pm and 5:00 am"

Road	Side	Description
St Mary's Road	West	From 40m north of the northern kerbline of Compton Walk northwards for 19 m
