

**THE BOROUGH OF SOUTHEND-ON SEA**

**(AMENDMENT NO. 2) ORDER 2006**

**Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**

The Southend-on-Sea Borough Council made an Order on 6 August 2007 in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 38 and Section 84 (and part IV of Schedule 9) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, the effect of which will amend the above-mentioned Order (as amended) by adding the items listed in the Schedule below. The Order will come into effect on 14 August 2007.

A copy of the sealed Order, a map showing the roads to which the Order relate and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected at the office of the Contact Centre on the ground floor of the Civic Centre (address below) during normal office hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained therein, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act of 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act, or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within six weeks from 6 August 2007 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
