## NOTICE OF PENALTY CHARGES STAFFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA AND SPECIAL ENFORCEMENT AREA IN THE DISTRICT OF CANNOCK CHASE

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Staffordshire County Council in accordance with its powers under Sections 72 and 77 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 ("the 2004 Act") and in consultation with the Secretary of State for Transport have set the following penalty charges in relation to the above newly designated parking areas. These relate to the Civil Enforcement of On-Street parking contraventions in the District of Cannock Chase provided for by The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Staffordshire) (Districts of Cannock Chase, Lichfield, South Staffordshire and Tamworth) Designation Order 2009.

The relevant charges are:-

- a penalty charge of £70 on the issue of a Penalty Charge Notice (PCN) for Higher level contraventions and £50 on the issue of a Penalty Charge Notice (PCN) for lower level contraventions in accordance with The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (Guidelines on Levels of Charges)(England) Order 2007 but discounted by 50% if payment is received within 14 days of the issue of the PCN or within 21 days for PCNs issued by post;
- (ii) on the issue of a "Charge Certificate" in accordance with the provisions of The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (Guidelines on Levels of Charges)(England) Order 2007 the penalty charge shall be increased by 50%.

The above charges are to take effect on the 23rd March 2009.
