

THE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL OF STOCKPORT
(BRIGHTON ROAD & DIDSBURY ROAD, HEATON MOOR) (TEMPORARY
PROHIBITION OF WAITING) & (TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF LIMITED
WAITING) ORDER 2017

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Metropolitan Borough Council of Stockport proposes to make an Order not less than 7 days from the date of this Notice under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, the effect of which will be to introduce Temporary Prohibition of Waiting at Brighton Road, both sides from its junction with Didsbury Road for its entire length in a southerly then southwesterly direction and a Temporary Suspension of Limited Waiting (Mon-Sat 8am-6pm 30 mins No return 1 hour) on Didsbury Road, south side, from the projected westerly kerbline of Brighton Road for a distance of 47 metres in a westerly direction whilst traffic signs to that effect are in place on or near the said roads.

This Order is necessary to accommodate works associated with utilities diversions, road improvements and junction widening at the Brighton Road junction with Didsbury Road.

It is anticipated that the maximum duration of the works will be 18 months.

This Order is to come into operation on the 1 January 2018 and will have effect for eighteen months, provided that if all necessary works are completed within a shorter period this Order shall cease to have effect at the end of that shorter period.
