THE BOROUGH OF STOCKTON-ON-TEES (WESTBURY SREET, THORNABY) (ONE-WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 1983

The Council of the Borough of Stockton-on-Tees (hereinafter referred to as Tibe Domnoil") pursuant to arrangements under Bection 101 of the Local Fovernment act 1972, with Dieveland Downty Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council ander Section 1(1) (2) and (3) and Section 84D(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 (which said Act of 1967 as so amended is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1967") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 84 C (1) of the Act of 1967 hereby make the following Order.

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on the Thirtieth day of May 1983 and may be cited as The Borough of Stockton-on-Tees (Westbury Street, Thornaby) (One-Way Traffic) Order 1983.
- 2. No person shall except upon the direction of a police constable in uniform or a traffic warden cause any vehicle to proceed along Westbury Street, Thornaby in a southerly direction from its junction with Mandale Road southwards to a point 25 metres north of its junction with Chelmsford Street.
- 3. Nothing in this Order shall apply to the driving of a mechanical street cleaning vehicle, refuse collecting vehicle, mechanical gritting vehicle or gulley emptying vehicle when being used in the service of the local authority, nor to an express carriage vehicle nor to a stage carriage vehicle.
- 4. The Borough of Stockton-on-Tees (Westbury Street, Thornaby) Experimental One-Way Traffic) Order 1981 is hereby revoked.
