

CITY OF STOKE-ON-TRENT (TRAFFIC REGULATION) (No. 56) ORDER 2003

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the City of Stoke-on-Trent propose to make an Order under Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984.

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit the waiting of any vehicle at any time in the lengths of road specified in the First Schedule below;

FIRST SCHEDULE NO WAITING AT ANY TIME

Leek New Road

(North-west Side)

- (i) from its junction with the new spine road linking Leek New Road and Bellerton Lane for a distance of 140 metres in a north easterly direction.
- (ii) from its junction with the new spine road linking Leek New Road and Bellerton Lane for a distance of 80 metres in a south westerly direction.

(South-east Side)

- (i) from its junction with Newford Crescent (South Western Entrance) for a distance of 160 metres in a south westerly direction
- (ii) from its junction with Newford Crescent (South Western Entrance) for a distance of 65 metres in a north easterly direction

Norton Colliery Site Spine Road (Both Sides)

from its junction with Leek New Road to its junction with Bellerton Lane
