

**CITY OF STOKE-ON-TRENT (TRAFFIC REGULATION) (NO. 6) (MEIR ROAD)  
ORDER 2003**

**THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOKE-ON-TRENT** in exercise of its powers under Section 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act **HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:-**

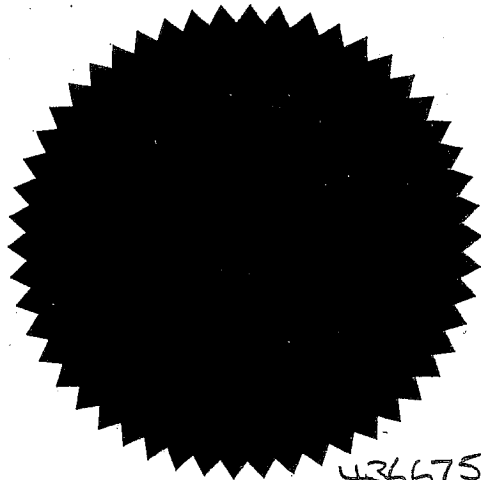
1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order no person shall cause or permit the stopping of any vehicle at any time on the school entrance markings in the length of Meir Road from a point 53 metres east of the public footpath adjacent to Alexandra County Middle School for a distance of 27 metres in an easterly direction.
2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to anything done upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform.
3. The Interpretation Act, 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
4. This Order shall come into operation on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of March 2003 and may be cited as "City of Stoke-on-Trent (Traffic Regulation) (No. 6) (Meir Road) Order 2003".
