

**CITY OF STOKE-ON-TRENT (HUMBERT STREET)
(TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER, (No.84) 2004**


WHEREAS the Council of the City of Stoke-on-Trent (hereinafter referred to as "the City Council") is satisfied that vehicular traffic should be prohibited in that length of highway (formerly Humbert Street) situated between Etruria Old Road and Cavour Street, south-west of Lanehead Road, in order to permit the safe operation of landscaping works except for any vehicle being used in connection with the works or for the police, ambulance or fire brigade purpose.

NOW THEREFORE the City Council in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act, 1991 and of all other enabling powers HEREBY MAKE the following Order: -

1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven in that length of highway (formerly Humbert Street) situated between Etruria Old Road and Cavour Street, south-west of Lanehead Road.
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply to anything done upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Officer in uniform.
3. The Interpretation Act, 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
4. The effect of the Order, which shall remain in force for a period of 12 months, or until the works it is proposed to carry out are completed, whichever is the earlier, shall come into operation on the 8th day of November 2004 and may be cited as "City of Stoke-on-Trent (Humbert Street)(Temporary Traffic Regulation) Order (No.84) 2004"
