CITY OF STOKE-ON-TRENT (TRAFFIC REGULATION) (NO. 110) (AUDLEY STREET - ROAD CLOSURE) ORDER 2005

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOKE-ON-TRENT in exercise of its powers under Section 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. Save as provided in Articles 2 and 3 of this Order, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven in the length of road specified in the Schedule hereto at any time.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to anything done upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Officer in uniform.
- 3. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle to be driven in the length of road referred to in that Article for so long as it may be necessary to enable the vehicle to gain access to land adjacent to the road referred to for the purpose of general maintenance.
- 4. The Interpretation Act, 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 5. This Order shall come into operation on the 16th day of January 2006 and may be cited as "City of Stoke-on-Trent (Traffic Regulation) (No. 110) (Audley Street Road Closure) Order, 2006".
