<u>City of Stoke-on-Trent (Traffic Regulation) (Hanley Night-Time Closure)</u> (No.17) Order, 2005

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOKE-ON-TRENT in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:-

- 1. Other than provided for in Article 2 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven or ridden between the hours of 11.30pm and 4.00am Monday to Sunday inclusive, in the lengths of road and in the direction specified in the schedule below.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform.
- 3. The Interpretation Act, 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament
- **4.** This Order shall come into operation on the 20th day of March 2006 and may be cited as "City of Stoke-on-Trent (Traffic Regulation) (Hanley Night-Time Closure) (No.17) Order, 2005".
