- 1. To add the parking place specified in the First Schedule hereto to the One Hundredth and Eighteenth Schedule of the City of Stoke on Trent (Traffic Regulation) (No.5) Consolidation Order 2002 ("the Consolidated Order") thereby making the said parking place subject to the provisions of the Consolidated Order and the Consolidated Order is hereby amended accordingly.
- 2. To introduce the scale of charges payable during the charging periods as set out in First Schedule of this Order hereto
- 3. The Interpretation Act, 1978 shall to the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament
- 4. This Order shall come into operation on the 5th day of June 2006 and may be cited as "City of Stoke-on-Trent (Traffic Regulation) (Chancery Lane) (No.22) Order 2006"
