

**City of Stoke-on-Trent (Traffic Regulation) (Various Provisions - Bentilee Area)**  
**(Making in Part) (No.35) Order 2005**

**THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOKE-ON-TRENT** in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act **HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER :-**

1. Save as provided for in Articles 3 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle except pedal cycles to be driven in the lengths of road specified in the First Schedule hereto.
2. The Interpretation Act, 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. Nothing in this Order shall apply to anything done upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Officer in uniform.
4. This Order shall come into operation on the 20th day of March 2006 and may be cited as “City of Stoke-on-Trent (Traffic Regulation) (Various Provisions – Bentilee Area) (Making in Part) (No.35) Order 2005
