


**CITY OF STOKE-ON-TRENT
(BRIGHT STREET ONE-WAY)
(TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER (NO. 81) 2004**

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOKE-ON-TRENT in exercise of its powers under Section 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(1) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven in the length of road specified other than in the permitted direction stated in the Schedule hereto;
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply to anything done upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Officer in uniform.
3. The Interpretation Act, 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
4. This Order shall come into operation on the 30th day of March 2006 and may be cited as "City of Stoke-on-Trent Bright Street One-Way (Traffic Regulation) (No. 81) Order, 2004".
