


**CITY OF STOKE-ON-TRENT (TRAFFIC REGULATION)
(SAMPSON STREET AREA, HANLEY) (No.88) ORDER 2006**

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOKE-ON-TRENT in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act **HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER :-**

1. To remove all waiting restrictions in Sampson Street (Between the junctions of York Street/Century Street), Bexley Street and Loftus Street, by the revocation of the provisions relating to the afore-mentioned streets in the Sixty First Schedule of the "City of Stoke-on-Trent (Traffic Regulation) (No.5) Consolidation Order 2002..
2. The interpretation Act, 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. This Order shall come into operation on the 1st day of December 2006 and may be cited as "City of Stoke-on-Trent (Traffic Regulation) (Sampson Street Area, Hanley) (No.88) Order 2006".
