

**CITY OF STOKE-ON-TRENT (TRAFFIC REGULATION) (VARIOUS PROVISIONS)
(No.35) ORDER 2007**

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOKE-ON-TRENT in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act **HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER :-**

1. To amend Article 25(b) (i) of Part 2 of the City of Stoke on Trent (Traffic Regulation Various Provisions) (Making in Part) (No.1) 2003 so that it reads :-

"In the case of a vehicle/motor vehicle fitted with a transparent windscreen by affixing the ticket to the inside surface of the windscreen or side front windows so that it is facing forwards and can be easily seen throughout the duration of the stay"

And the Order is hereby amended accordingly.

2. To amend Article 25(b) (i) of Part VI of the City of Stoke on Trent (Traffic Regulation) (No.5) Consolidation Order 2002 so it reads :-

"In the case of a vehicle/motor vehicle fitted with a transparent windscreen by affixing the ticket to the inside surface of the windscreen or side front windows so that it is facing forwards and can be easily seen throughout the duration of the stay"

And the Order is hereby amended accordingly.

3. To amend Article 5 (3) (i) of Part VIII of the City of Stoke on Trent (Traffic Regulation) (No.5) Consolidation Order 2002 so it reads :-

"In the case of a vehicle/motor vehicle fitted with a transparent windscreen by affixing the ticket to the inside surface of the windscreen or side front windows so that it is facing forwards and can be easily seen throughout the duration of the stay"

And the Order is hereby amended accordingly.

4. To amend Article 7(1) of Part II, Part B, Section 1 of the City of Stoke on Trent (Traffic Regulation Various Provisions) (Making in Part) (No.1) 2003 so it reads :-

"Where a notice has been attached to a vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Article 6(2) of this Part B of this Part II of this Order, no person not being the driver, owner or the keeper of the vehicle or a parking attendant shall remove the notice from the vehicle unless authorised to do so by either the driver, owner or keeper"

And the Order is hereby amended accordingly.


5. To amend Article 21(2) of Part IX, Part C, Section 3 of the City of Stoke on Trent (Traffic Regulation) (No.5) Consolidation Order 2002 so it reads :-

“Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order any vehicle being used in connection with a service provided under the National Health Service and displaying a valid permit may wait in any parking place (other than a place the use of which has been suspended under Article 19 of this Part A of this Part IX of this Order, during the regulated hours for as long as may be necessary whilst that service is being provided to a resident”

6. This Order shall come into operation on the 31st day of October 2007 and may be cited as “City of Stoke-on-Trent (Traffic Regulation) (Various Provisions) (No.35) Order 2007”
