CITY OF STOKE-ON-TRENT (TRAFFIC REGULATION) (SUNNYSIDE AVENUE) (20mph SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2011

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOKE-ON-TRENT in exercise of its powers under sections 81, 82, 83 and 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the act hereby makes the following Order.

- 1. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed in excess of 20mph in any of the lengths of road specified in the Schedule hereto.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to anything done upon the direction or with the permission of a police Constable in uniform or a Traffic Warden.
- 3. The Interpretation Act, 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 4. This Order shall come into operation on the 4th day of April 2011 and may be cited as "City of Stoke-on-Trent (Traffic Regulation)(Sunnyside Avenue) (20 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order, 2011".
