CITY OF STOKE-ON-TRENT (THE STRAND, LONGTON) (TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION) (NO.02) ORDER, 2009

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Stoke-on-Trent (hereinafter referred to as "the City Council") is satisfied that loading and unloading restrictions should be introduced on The Strand, Longton.

NOW THEREFORE the City Council in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act, 1991 and of all other enabling powers **HEREBY MAKE** the following Order: -

- 1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any loading and unloading of vehicles between 07:30 am and 18:30 pm on the western side of The Strand, Longton from a point 25 metres south of its junction with Baths Passage to a point 10 metres north of its junction with Baths Passage
- 2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply to anything done upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Officer in uniform.
- 3. The Interpretation Act, 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 4. The effect of the Order, shall come into operation on 19th January 2009 and continue for 4 months weeks, or until the works it is proposed to carry out are completed, whichever is the earlier and may be cited as "City of Stoke on Trent (The Strand, Longton) (Temporary Traffic Regulation) (No.02) Order 2009"
