<u>City of Stoke-on-Trent (Traffic Regulation)(Twigg Street, Bucknall)</u> (No.16) Order, 2010

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOKE-ON-TRENT in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

- 1. Save as provided for in Article 4 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in the lengths of road specified in the First Schedule hereto;
- 2. Save as provided for in Article 4 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven in the lengths of road except in the permitted direction as specified in the Second Schedule hereto;
- 3. To revoke those parts of the City of Stoke on Trent (Traffic Regulation) (Consolidation Order) (No.13) Order 2008 as specified in the Schedule of Revocations below.
- 4. Nothing in this Order shall apply upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform.
- 5. The Interpretation Act, 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applied for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 6. This Order shall come into operation on the 24th day of September 2010 and may be cited as "City of Stoke-on-Trent (Traffic Regulation) (Twigg Street, Bucknall) (No.16) Order, 2010".
