


City of Stoke-on-Trent (Traffic Regulation)(Twigg Street, Bucknall)
(No.16) Order, 2010

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOKE-ON-TRENT in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act **HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER :-**

1. Save as provided for in Article 4 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in the lengths of road specified in the First Schedule hereto;
2. Save as provided for in Article 4 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven in the lengths of road except in the permitted direction as specified in the Second Schedule hereto;
3. To revoke those parts of the City of Stoke on Trent (Traffic Regulation) (Consolidation Order) (No.13) Order 2008 as specified in the Schedule of Revocations below.
4. Nothing in this Order shall apply upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform.
5. The Interpretation Act, 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applied for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
6. This Order shall come into operation on the 24th day of September 2010 and may be cited as "City of Stoke-on-Trent (Traffic Regulation) (Twigg Street, Bucknall) (No.16) Order, 2010".
