## CITY OF STOKE-ON-TRENT (MOUNT PLEASANT, HANLEY) (TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION) (NO.20) ORDER, 2008

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Stoke-on-Trent (hereinafter referred to as "the City Council") is satisfied that the driving of vehicular traffic should be prohibited in Mount Pleasant, Hanley from a point 105 metres south-east of its junction with Clough Street to a point 45 metres north-west of its junction with Sun Street. The closure is required from 7th April 2008 to 5th May 2008, in order to permit the safe operation of laying telecom cables.

**NOW THEREFORE** the City Council in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act, 1991 and of all other enabling powers **HEREBY MAKE** the following Order: -

- 1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order no person shall use or cause or permit any vehicle to be driven in Mount Pleasant, Hanley from a point 105 south-east of its junction with Clough Street to a point 45 north-west of its junction with Sun Street..
- 2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply to anything done upon the direction or with the permission of an on duty Police Officer in uniform.
- 3. The Interpretation Act, 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 4. The effect of the Order, which shall come into operation on 7th April 2008 will remain in force until 5th May 2008 or until the works it is proposed to carry out are completed, whichever is the earlier, and may be cited as "City of Stoke on Trent (Mount Pleasant, Hanley) (Temporary Traffic Regulation) (No.20) Order 2008"
