


**City of Stoke-on-Trent (Traffic Regulation)**  
**(Dover Street, Northwood) (No.23) Order 2009**

**THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOKE-ON-TRENT** in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act **HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER :-**

1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven in the length of road specified in the Schedule hereto at any time.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to anything done upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Officer in uniform.
3. The Interpretation Act, 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
4. This Order shall come into operation on the 5th day of October 2009, and may be cited as "City of Stoke-on-Trent (Traffic Regulation) (Dover Street, Northwood) (No.23) Order 2009".
