

City of Stoke-on-Trent (Traffic Regulation) (Hanley Road Closures)
(No.24) Order 2008

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOKE-ON-TRENT in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act **HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER :-**

1. To prohibit the driving of any vehicle at any time in the lengths of road specified in the First Schedule hereto.
2. The interpretation Act, 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. This Order shall come into operation on the 30th day of June 2008 and may be cited as “City of Stoke on Trent (Traffic Regulation) (Hanley Road Closures) (No.24) Order 2008.

FIRST SCHEDULE
ALL VEHICLES PROHIBITED

Broad Street (Service Road Linking St James Street And Broad Street)

From its junction with Broad Street for a distance of 3metres in south-westerly direction.

Slippery Lane

- (i) From its junction with Clough Street for a distance of 10 metres in south easterly direction.
- (ii) From its junction with Robson Street for a distance of 2 metres in north westerly direction.

Statham Street

From its junction with Morley Street for a distance of 2 metres in south westerly direction.
