

**CITY OF STOKE-ON-TRENT (TRAFFIC REGULATION)
(STATHAM STREET AREA – REVOCATIONS) (No.28) ORDER 2008**

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOKE-ON-TRENT in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act **HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER :-**

1. To remove all waiting and parking restrictions by the revocation of those parts of City of Stoke on Trent (Traffic Regulation) (No.13) Consolidation Order, 2008 as specified in the Schedule of Revocations below:-
2. The interpretation Act, 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. This Order shall come into operation on the 30th day of June 2008 and may be cited as “City of Stoke-on-Trent (Traffic Regulation) (Statham Street Area – Revocations) (No.28) Order 2008”.
