<u>CITY OF STOKE-ON-TRENT (SOUTH WOLFE STREET, STOKE)</u> (ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION) (NO.28) EXPERIMENTAL ORDER, 2009

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOKE-ON-TRENT in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 3, 9 and 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

- 1 Save as provided for in Article 2 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any Vehicle to be driven in South Wolfe Street, Stoke between the hours of 6am and 5pm on every Wednesday between the dates of 8th April 2009 and 8th April 2010 inclusive.
- 2 Nothing in this Order shall apply to anything done upon the direction of or with the permission of an on duty police officer.
- To revoke the those parts of the City of Stoke on Trent (Traffic Regulation) (No.32) Bus Lanes Consolidation Order 2003 in so far as it relates to that section of Church Street between the junctions of South Wolfe Street and Campbell Place for vehicles travelling in a North Westerly direction only on the dates referred to in this Order.
- 4 The Interpretation Act, 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applied for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- This Order shall come into operation on the 8th day of April 2009 and will be operational on Wednesdays until 8th April 2010 and may be cited as "City Of Stoke-on-Trent (South Wolfe Street, Stoke) (Road Traffic Regulation) (No.28) Experimental Order, 2009".
