<u>CITY OF STOKE-ON-TRENT (TRAFFIC REGULATION) (VARIOUS PROVISIONS)</u> (NO.42) ORDER, 2009 (Making in Part; Leek New Road 30 mph Speed Limit)

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOKE-ON-TRENT in exercise of its powers under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:-

In this Order:-

- 1. Subject as mentioned in Article 2 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour in the lengths of road specified in the First Schedule hereto.
- 2. The provisions of Article 1 shall not apply to any vehicle:
 - a) being used for Police, Fire Brigade and ambulance purposes; or
 - b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer in uniform.
- 3. The Interpretation Act, 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applied for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 4. This Order shall come into operation on the 18th day of January 2010 and may be citied as "City of Stoke-on-Trent (Traffic Regulation) (Various Provisions) (No.42) Order 2009 (Making in Part; Leek New Road 30 mph Speed Limit).
