# CITY OF STOKE-ON-TRENT (TRAFFIC REGULATION) (HANLEY BUS RE-ROUTING - VARIOUS PROVISIONS) (NO. 37) ORDER, 2012

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOKE-ON-TRENT in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 32, 35, 45, 46 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act HEREBY MAKES THE FOLLOWING ORDER:-

In this Order:-

"Council" means the Council of the City of Stoke on Trent;

"vehicle" means a motor vehicle or pedal cycle;

"motor vehicle" means a mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on roads;

"pedal cycle" means a vehicle with fewer than four wheels which is not mechanically propelled unless it is an electrically assisted pedal cycle of such class as is to be treated as not being a motor vehicle for the purposes of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

"bus" means a motor vehicle which is constructed or adapted to carry more than eight seated passengers in addition to the driver;

"local bus" means a public service vehicle used for the provision of a local service not being an excursion or tour;

"local service" has the same meaning as in Section 2 of the Transport Act 1985;

"coach" means a vehicle constructed or adapted to carry more than 16 seated passengers in addition to the driver with a maximum gross weight of more than 7.5 tonnes and with a maximum speed exceeding 60 mph;

"disabled person's vehicle" means a vehicle displaying a valid disabled persons badge and disabled person's parking disc;

"motor cycle" means a mechanically propelled vehicle (not being an invalid carriage) with fewer than four wheels of which the unladen weight does not exceed 410 kilograms;

"solo motor cycle" means a motor cycle without a side car and having two wheels;

"police vehicle" means a vehicle being used for Police purposes or operating under the instructions of a Chief Officer of Police:

"taxi" means a vehicle licensed under Section 37 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 or section 6 of the Metropolitan Public Carriage Act 1869 or any similar or successor enactment:

"goods vehicle" means a motor vehicle constructed or adapted for use for the carriage of goods, or a trailer so constructed or adapted, and which is not a passenger vehicle;

"passenger vehicle" means a motor vehicle constructed or adapted primarily for the carriage of passengers and their effects and includes any motor vehicle which was originally designed primarily for the carriage of passengers except where such a vehicle has been permanently adapted for the carriage of goods;

"trailer" means a vehicle drawn by a motor vehicle which is not selfpropelled;

"goods" means goods of any kind whether animate or inanimate and includes postal packets of any description but does not include documents, cash or keys however packaged except where the weight or size of packages containing such objects means that they cannot be easily carried from the nearest parking place or car park;

"permanently adapted for the carriage of goods" means that all of the passenger seating in the vehicle to the rear of the driver has been removed and the area of the vehicle previously occupied by seating has been permanently adapted to enable goods to be carried.

"delivering" and "collecting" in relation to goods includes checking the goods for the purpose of their delivery or collection;

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as given in Regulation 3(1) of The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000 providing the expiry date on the badge has not passed;

"disabled person's parking disc" has the same meaning as given in Regulation 8(5) of The Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000;

"relevant position" in relation to a disabled persons badge, disabled persons parking disc, parking permit or parking ticket means:-

- (a) Attached to the front windscreen or placed on the dashboard or fascia of the vehicle so that the details on the front side of the badge, permit or ticket are clearly legible from outside of the vehicle; or
- (b) where the vehicle either does not have a front windscreen, dashboard or fascia, or, where it would be impracticable to exhibit the badge or ticket as provided in paragraph (a) above, exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the details on the front side of the badge, permit or ticket are clearly legible from outside of the vehicle.

"front side" in relation to the exhibition of badges, discs, tickets and permits means:

- (a) For a disabled persons badge, the side which shows the wheelchair-users symbol, the expiry date and the serial number of the badge;
- (b) For a disabled person parking disc, the side which shows the time when the vehicle was parked;

(c) For a parking ticket, the side which shows the details pertaining to that period of pay and display parking (the issuing machine number, the expiry time of the ticket and the amount paid);

(d) For a parking permit, the side which shows the issuing authority, the registration number of the vehicle the permit has been issued for and the period of validity of the permit.

"parking ticket" means a valid parking charge ticket purchased from a ticket machine or civil enforcement officer or other authorised officer.

"ticket machine" means an apparatus or device designed to issue parking tickets indicating the payment of a charge and the date and time at which the charge was paid;

"owner" has the same meaning as in Section 142 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

"prescribed hours" means the hours during which an action or activity is permitted;

"restricted hours" means the hours during which an action or activity is prohibited or restricted;

"permit" means a permit issued at the discretion of the Council, which allows a vehicle on which the said permit is clearly displayed in the relevant position to wait in the locations for which the permit has been issued;

"permit holder" means a person who has obtained a permit from the Council;

"bus stand" means an area of carriageway comprising the road markings shown in diagram 1025.1, 1025.3 or 1025.4 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002 and on which is marked the words 'bus stand':

"bus stop" means an area of carriageway comprising the road markings shown in diagram 1025.1, 1025.3 or 1025.4 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002 and on which is marked the words 'bus stop':

"parking bay or parking space" means an area within a parking place delineated by surface markings within which a motor vehicle may be positioned and parked.

"disabled persons' parking place" means an area of carriageway designated as a parking place by virtue of Article 9 of this Order;

"pay and display parking place" means an area of carriageway designated as a parking place by virtue of Article 10 of this Order;

"limited waiting parking place" means an area of carriageway designated as a parking place by virtue of Articles 11 or 12 of this Order;

"solo motorcycle parking place" means an area of carriageway designated as a parking place by virtue of Article 13 of this Order;

"police vehicle parking place" means an area of carriageway designated as a parking place by virtue of Article 14 of this Order;

"dual use parking place for coaches and goods vehicles" means an area of carriageway designated as a parking place by virtue of Article 15 of this Order:

"loading only bay" means an area of carriageway designated as a parking place for the loading or unloading of goods by virtue of Articles 16, 17, 18, 19, 20 or 21 of this Order;

"street" and "road" have the same meaning for the purpose of this Order;

"cause" includes "permit" and "causing" includes "permitting".

## **GENERAL PROVISIONS**

- 1) Save as provided in Articles 31, 32 and 33 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to stop for any reason in any of the lengths of road specified in the First Schedule hereto.
- 2) Save as provided in Articles 31, 32 and 33 of this Order and subject to the provisions of Article 39 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle other than a bus to stop for any reason in any of the lengths of road specified in the Second Schedule hereto.
- 3) Save as provided in Articles 31, 32 and 33 of this Order and subject to the provisions of Article 39 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle other than a local bus to stop for any reason in any of the lengths of road specified in the Third Schedule hereto.
- 4) Save as provided in Articles 31, 32 and 33 of this Order and subject to the provisions of Article 40 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle other than a local bus to stop or wait for any reason in any of the lengths of road specified in the Fourth Schedule hereto.
- 5) Save as provided in Articles 31, 32 and 33 of this Order and subject to the provisions of Article 40 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle other than a local bus to stop or wait for any reason in any of the lengths of road specified in the Fifth Schedule hereto between the hours of 5am and midnight.
- 6) Save as provided in Articles 31, 32 and 33 of this Order and subject to the provisions of Article 40 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle other than a local bus to stop or wait for any reason in any of the lengths of road specified in the Sixth Schedule hereto between the hours of 8am and midnight.
- 7) Save as provided for in Articles 31, 32 and 33 of this Order and subject to the provisions of Article 41 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle other than a taxl to stop or wait for any reason in any of the lengths of road specified in the Seventh Schedule hereto.
- 8) Save as provided for in Articles 31, 32 and 33 of this Order and subject to the provisions of Article 41 of this Order no person shall cause or

- permit any motor vehicle other than a taxi to stop or wait for any reason in any of the lengths of road specified in the Eighth Schedule hereto between the hours of 9pm and 5am.
- 9) Save as provided for in Articles 31, 32, 33, 34 and 35 of this Order and subject to the provisions of Articles 42 and 43 of this Order any of the lengths of roads specified in the Ninth Schedule of this Order may be used for parking at any time and the said lengths of road are hereby designated as disabled persons parking places.
- Save as provided for in Articles 31, 32, 33, 34 and 35 of this Order and subject to the provisions of Articles 44 to 62 of this Order any of the lengths of roads specified in the Tenth Schedule of this Order may be used for parking at any time and the said lengths of road are hereby designated as pay and display parking places.
- 11) Save as provided for in Articles 31, 32, 33, 34, 35 and 36 of this Order and subject to the provisions of Article 63 of this Order any of the lengths of roads specified in the Eleventh Schedule of this Order may be used for parking at any time and the said lengths of road are hereby designated as limited waiting parking places.
- 12) Save as provided for in Articles 31, 32, 33, 34, 35 and 36 of this Order and subject to the provisions of Article 64 of this Order any of the lengths of roads specified in the Twelfth Schedule of this Order may be used for parking between the hours of 9pm and 5am and the said lengths of road are hereby designated as limited waiting parking places.
- Save as provided for in Articles 31, 32 and 33 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle other than a solo motor cycle to wait at any time or to load or unload at any time in any of the lengths of road specified in the Thirteenth Schedule hereto at any time and the said lengths of road are hereby designated as solo motorcycle parking places.
- 14) Save as provided for in Articles 31, 32 and 33 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle other than a police vehicle to wait at any time or to load or unload at any time in any of the lengths of road specified in the Fourteenth Schedule hereto and the said lengths of road are hereby designated as police vehicle parking places.
- 15) Save as provided for in Articles 31, 32, 33, 34 and 35 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle other than a coach or a goods vehicle to wait or to load or unload goods at any time in any of the lengths of road specified in the Fifteenth Schedule hereto and the said lengths of road are hereby designated as dual use parking places for coaches and goods vehicles.
- Save as provided for in Articles 31, 32, 33, 34 and 35 of this Order and subject to the provisions of Articles 65 and 66 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in any of the lengths of road specified in the Sixteenth Schedule hereto for any purpose other than the loading or unloading of goods and the said lengths of road are hereby designated as loading only bays.

- 17) Save as provided for in Articles 31, 32, 33, 34 and 35 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle other than a goods vehicle or trailer to wait at any time in any of the lengths of road specified in the Seventeenth Schedule hereto for any purpose other than the loading or unloading of goods and the said lengths of road are hereby designated as loading only bays.
- 18) Save as provided for in Articles 31, 32, 33, 34 and 35 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle other than a goods vehicle or trailer to wait in any of the lengths of road specified in the Eighteenth Schedule hereto for any purpose other than the loading or unloading of goods between the hours of midnight and 5am and the said lengths of road are hereby designated as goods vehicle loading bays during those hours.
- 19) Save as provided for in Articles 31, 32, 33, 34 and 35 of this Order and subject to the provisions of Articles 65 and 66 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle other than a goods vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road specified in the Nineteenth Schedule hereto for any purpose other than the loading or unloading of goods and the said lengths of road are hereby designated as goods vehicle loading bays during those hours.
- 20) Save as provided for in Articles 31, 32, 33, 34 and 35 of this Order and subject to the provisions of Articles 65 and 66 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle other than a goods vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road specified in the Twentieth Schedule hereto for any purpose other than the loading or unloading of goods between the hours of midnight and 8am and the said lengths of road are hereby designated as goods vehicle loading bays during those hours.
- 21) Save as provided for in Articles 31, 32, 33, 34 and 35 of this Order and subject to the provisions of Articles 65 and 66 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle other than a goods vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road specified in the Twenty-First Schedule hereto for any purpose other than the loading or unloading of goods between the hours of 5am and 9pm and the said lengths of road are hereby designated as goods vehicle loading bays during those hours.
- 22) Save as provided for in Articles 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 37 and 38 of this Order and subject to the provisions of Articles 67 and 68 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road specified in the Twenty-Second Schedule hereto at any time.
- 23) Save as provided for in Articles 31, 32, 33, 34, 35 and 36 of this Order and subject to the provisions of Articles 67 and 68 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road specified in the Twenty-Third Schedule hereto between the hours of 5am and 9pm.
- 24) Save as provided for in Articles 31, 32, 33, 34, 35 and 36 of this Order and subject to the provisions of Articles 67 and 68 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of

- road specified in the Twenty-Fourth Schedule hereto between the hours of 9pm and 5am.
- 25) Save as provided for in Articles 31, 32, 33, 34, 35 and 36 of this Order and subject to the provisions of Articles 67 and 68 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road specified in the Twenty-Fifth Schedule hereto on Mondays to Saturdays between the hours of 8am and 6pm.
- 26) Save as provided for in Articles 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 37 and 38 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to load or unload in any of the lengths of road specified in the Twenty-Sixth Schedule hereto.
- 27) Save as provided for in Articles 31, 32, 33, 34 and 35 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to load or unload in any of the lengths of road specified in the Twenty-Seventh Schedule hereto between the hours of 5am and 9pm.
- 28) Save as provided for in Articles 31, 32, 33, 34 and 35 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to load or unload in any of the lengths of road specified in the Twenty-Eighth Schedule hereto between the hours of 9am and 5pm.
- 29) Save as provided for in Articles 31, 32, 33, 34 and 35 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to load or unload in any of the lengths of road specified in the Twenty-Ninth Schedule hereto between the hours of 9pm and 5am.
- 30) Save as provided for in Articles 31, 32, 33, 34 and 35 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to load or unload in any of the lengths of road specified in the Thirtieth Schedule hereto between the hours of 10am and 5pm and between the hours of 9pm and 5am.

### **EXEMPTIONS**

- 31) Nothing in this Order shall apply to anything done under the direction or with the consent of a Police Officer in uniform.
- 32) Nothing in this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road referred to in this Order for as long as may be necessary to enable the vehicle to be used in pursuance of statutory powers and duties including the enforcement of this or any other Order, if it cannot be used for such purposes in any other road.
- 33) Nothing in this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road referred to in this Order for as long as may be necessary to enable the vehicle to be used, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road, in connection with:
  - (i) any building operation or demolition adjacent to the length of road;
  - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic from the length of road;
  - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the length of road;
  - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in the length of road of any sewer or any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water

or electricity, or of any telecommunication apparatus kept installed for the purposes of a telecommunication code system or with any service provided by means of any such apparatus as defined in the Telecommunication Act, 1984.

- 34) Nothing in Articles 9, 10, 11, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29 or 30 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle of (and bearing a livery used by) a universal service provider within the meaning ascribed by the Postal Services Act 2000 to wait in any of the lengths of road referred to in those Articles for as long as may be necessary to enable the vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets in the course of the provision of a universal postal service as defined in that Act, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road.
- 35) Nothing in Articles 9, 10, 11, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29 or 30 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road referred to in those Articles for as long as may be necessary to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road.
- 36) Nothing in Articles 11, 12, 22, 23, 24 or 25 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road referred to in those Articles for as long as may be necessary to enable goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from a vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road PROVIDED THAT loading and unloading is not prohibited in that length of road at the time the waiting takes place by virtue of Articles 26, 27, 28, 29 or 30 of this Order.
- 37) Nothing in Articles 22 and 26 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle to wait in Albion Street on the forecourt to Hanley Town Hall for the purposes of taking or collecting a wedding party to the Town Hall providing that:
  - (i) The person in charge of such a vehicle shall have in his or her possession a permit for parking on the forecourt to Hanley Town Hallissued by the Council;
  - (ii) The permit so issued is valid for the date and time when the vehicle is waiting:
  - (iii) The permit is displayed on the vehicle in the relevant position and the date and time for which the permit is valid are clearly visible.
- 38) Nothing in Articles 22 and 26 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a goods vehicle to wait in John Street for as long as may be necessary to enable goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle providing that:
  - (i) The goods are being delivered to or collected from The Reardon and Victoria Lounge Bar, 5 Adventure Place, Hanley, Stoke on Trent, ST1 3AF;
  - (ii) The vehicle waits only on the north side of John Street between a point 48 metres east of its junction with Bethesda Street and a point 60 metres east of its junction with Bethesda Street;
  - (iii) The vehicle waits only between the hours of 11am and 4pm, Monday to Friday inclusive;

(iv) The vehicle waits for a period not in excess of 1 hour.

### **USE OF BUS STOPS**

39) No bus waiting in any of the bus stops designated under Articles 2 or 3 of this Order may wait for any longer than is necessary to pick-up or set-down passengers.

## **USE OF BUS STANDS**

40) No local bus waiting in any of the bus stands designated under Articles 4, 5 or 6 of this Order may wait for more than 5 minutes.

### **USE OF TAXI RANKS**

41) No vehicle waiting in any of the taxi ranks designated under Articles 7 or 8 of this Order shall be left unattended by the authorised driver of the vehicle unless the driver is required to do so by a Police Officer in uniform or an authorised Council Officer.

### **USE OF DISABLED PARKING PLACES**

- 42) No vehicle waiting in any of the parking places designated under Article 9 of this Order shall:
  - a) Wait for more than 3 hours.
  - b) Return within 1 hour of moving away from the parking place.
- 43) A person parking in any disabled parking place designated under Article 9 of this Order shall:-
  - Display a valid disabled person's badge in the relevant position on the vehicle, in accordance with the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations, 2000; and
  - b) Display a disabled person's parking disc issued by a local authority in a relevant position on the vehicle and the person in charge of the said vehicle marks on the said parking disc the time at which the period of waiting has begun.

#### USE OF PAY AND DISPLAY PARKING PLACES

#### **DISPLAY OF TICKETS AND PERMITS**

44) No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be parked in a pay and display parking place designated under Article 10 of this Order unless there is displayed on that vehicle in the relevant position a pay and display ticket or permit valid for that time and for that parking place.

## TIME RESTRICTIONS ON THE USE OF PARKING PLACES

- 45) No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be parked in a pay and display parking place designated under Article 10 of this Order:-
  - (a) for longer than 3 hours on Mondays to Saturdays between 7am and 6pm; or
  - (b) beyond the time of expiry of the period for which the charge has been paid.

46) No vehicle parking in any pay and display parking place designated under Article 10 of this Order shall return to the same parking place within 1 hour of moving away from the parking place.

#### CHARGES

47) No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be parked in a pay and display parking place designated under Article 10 of this Order without arranging for the appropriate charge to be paid in accordance with the scale of current charges as set out in the Thirty-First Schedule hereto or as specified at or close to each pay and display ticket machine located adjacent to or near to that parking place.

#### MEANS OF PAYMENT

48) The charge referred to in Article 47 of this Order shall be payable in the manner as specified by notice at or close to the parking place.

### PROVISION OF PAY AND DISPLAY TICKET MACHINES

- 49) The Council will:-
  - install in such positions at or in the vicinity of a payment parking place as it may think fit such pay and display ticket machines as are required by this Order for the purposes of that parking place;
  - (b) carry out such other work as is authorised by this Order or is reasonably required for the purposes of the satisfactory operation of a parking place.

#### PURCHASE OF TICKET

50) The person in charge of a vehicle, upon parking the vehicle in a pay and display parking place designated under Article 10 of this Order shall immediately purchase a pay and display ticket from a pay and display ticket machine situated at or close to that parking place at the level of charge and for the period required in accordance with the scale of charges as specified at the pay and display ticket machine.

#### DISPLAY OF TICKET

- 51) Where on payment of the charge a pay and display ticket has been obtained, the person in charge of the vehicle shall:-
  - (a) display the pay and display ticket issued in the relevant position on the vehicle in respect of which it was issued, and
  - (b) ensure that the pay and display ticket is continuously displayed during the entire period that the vehicle is parked in the parking place.

### VALIDITY OF TICKET

- 52) A pay and display ticket is:
  - (a) valid only until the expiry of the period for which a payment has been made; and

(b) not transferable from one vehicle to another.

### EXPIRY OF PARKING PERIOD

- 53) The expiry of the period for which payment has been made shall be when the time shown on the clock of the issuing pay and display ticket machine is later than the time exhibited on the pay and display ticket displayed on the vehicle.
- 54) For the avoidance of doubt, the maximum specified period of parking applicable to a parking place shall take precedence over the times shown on a pay and display ticket in determining whether or not a contravention has taken place.

#### NON-DISPLAY OF TICKET

55) If, at any time while a vehicle is parked in a parking place designated under Article 10 of this Order, no pay and display ticket is displayed on that vehicle in the relevant position, it shall be judged that the charge has not been paid.

### TICKET MACHINE OUT OF ORDER

56) If the nearest pay and display ticket machine is out of order at the time when a vehicle is parked during the permitted hours in a parking place designated under Article 10 of this Order, then a pay and display ticket shall be obtained from another pay and display ticket machine relative to that parking place.

#### REMOVAL OF TICKETS

57) Where a ticket has been attached to a vehicle in accordance with the provisions of this Order no person, not being the driver of the vehicle, shall remove the ticket from the vehicle unless authorised to do so by the driver.

## SPECIFIC EXEMPTIONS IN PAY AND DISPLAY PARKING PLACES

### Ticket Machines Out of Order

58) If, at the time when a vehicle is parked in a pay and display parking place designated under Article 10 of this Order, all the ticket machines relative to that parking place are out of order, the driver of that vehicle shall be exempt from payment of the charge and display of ticket provided that the maximum period of parking specified for that parking place at the pay and display ticket machine still applies.

### Disabled Person's Badge

59) If, at the time when a vehicle is parked in a pay and display parking place designated under Article 10 of this Order, the driver of that vehicle displays in the relevant position a valid disabled person's badge and disabled person's parking disc, the driver shall be exempt from payment of the parking charge, display of ticket and any time limit provided that the vehicle is being used in accordance with the conditions applying to the said badge.

### CONTRAVENTION AT A PAY AND DISPLAY PARKING PLACE

- 60) If a vehicle (other than an exempted vehicle) is left in a pay and display parking place designated under Article 10 of this Order during the permitted hours and is deemed to be in contravention of any other provision of this Order, a penalty charge shall be payable.
- 61) In the case of a vehicle in respect of which a penalty charge notice is payable, a Penalty Charge Notice indicating the information required by the Traffic Management Act 2004, may be served a Civil Enforcement Officer in uniform in accordance with the said Act.

#### POWER TO SUSPEND A PARKING PLACE

- 62) Any person duly authorised by the Council may suspend the use of a parking place or any part thereof whenever they consider such a suspension reasonably necessary:-
  - (a) for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety;
  - (b) for the purpose of any building operation, demolition or excavation in or adjacent to the parking place or the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the parking place or the laying, erection, alteration, removal or repair in or adjacent to the parking place of any sewer of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line, traffic sign or ticket issuing machine;
  - (c) for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place on any occasion of the removal of furniture from one office or dwellinghouse to another of the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository;
  - (d) on any occasion on which it is likely by reason of some special attraction that any street will be through or obstructed; or
  - (e) for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place at times of weddings or funerals or on other special occasions

### USE OF LIMITED WAITING PARKING PLACES

- 63) No vehicle waiting in any of the parking places designated under Article 11 of this Order shall:
  - a) Wait for more than 15 minutes:
  - b) Return within 1 hour of moving away from the parking place.
- 64) No vehicle waiting in any of the parking places designated under Article 12 of this Order shall:
  - a) Wait for more than 10 minutes:
  - b) Return within 30 minutes of moving away from the parking place.

### **USE OF LOADING BAYS**

- 65) During permitted loading times, no vehicle loading or unloading goods in any loading bay designated under Articles 16, 19, 20 and 21 of this Order shall:
  - a) Wait for any longer than is necessary to deliver goods to or to collect goods from premises in the immediate vicinity of the vehicle;
  - b) Without prejudice to Article 66(a), wait for more than 1 hour:
  - c) Return within 1 hour of moving away from the loading bay.
- 66) The activity associated with loading or unloading from any vehicle using a loading bay designated under Articles 16, 19, 20 and 21 of this Order shall be continuous such that:
  - a) The driver of the vehicle must actively undertake loading or unloading for the whole of the time that the vehicle is waiting:
  - b) The driver of the vehicle must not leave the vehicle unattended for any more than 5 minutes at a time.

### LOADING AND UNLOADING GOODS OUTSIDE LOADING BAYS

- 67) During permitted loading times, no vehicle loading or unloading goods in any of the lengths of road designated under Articles 22, 23, 24 and 25 of this Order in order shall:-
  - Wait for any longer than is necessary to deliver goods to or to collect goods from premises in the immediate vicinity of the vehicle;
  - b) Without prejudice to Article 67(a), wait for more than 30 minutes;
  - Return within 1 hour of moving away from the length of road.
- 68) The activity associated with loading or unloading goods in any of the lengths of road designated under Articles 22, 23, 24 and 25 of this Order shall be continuous such that:
  - The driver of the vehicle must actively undertake loading or unloading for the whole of the time that the vehicle is waiting;
  - b) The driver of the vehicle must not leave the vehicle unattended for any more than 5 minutes at a time.

#### INTERPRETATION

69) The Interpretation Act, 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

#### **REVOCATIONS**

70) Those parts of the Traffic Regulation Orders specified in the Thirty-Second Schedule of this Order are hereby revoked.

### **OPERATIONAL DATE and CITATION**

71) This Order shall come into operation on the 26 March 2013 and may be cited as "City Of Stoke-On-Trent (Traffic Regulation) (Hanley Bus Re-Routing - Various Provisions) (No. 37) Order, 2012".
