# CITY OF STOKE-ON-TRENT (TRAFFIC REGULATION) (HANLEY BUS RE-ROUTING) (NO. 35) ORDER. 2012

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOKE-ON-TRENT in exercise of its powers under Sections 1. 2, 3, 4, 82, 83 and 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act HEREBY MAKES THE FOLLOWING ORDER:-

In this Order:-

"Council" means the Council of the City of Stoke on Trent;

"vehicle" means a motor vehicle or pedal cycle;

"motor vehicle" means a mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on roads;

"pedal cycle" means a unicycle, bicycle, tricycle, or cycle having four or more wheels, and which is not mechanically propelled unless it is an electrically assisted pedal cycle of such class as is to be treated as not being a motor vehicle for the purposes of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984:

"bus" means a motor vehicle which is constructed or adapted to carry more than eight seated passengers in addition to the driver:

"disabled persons vehicle" means a vehicle displaying a valid disabled person's badge and disabled person's parking disc;

"police vehicle" means a vehicle being used for Police purposes or operating under the instructions of a Chief Officer of Police:

"taxi" means a vehicle licensed under Section 37 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 or Section 6 of the Metropolitan Public Carriage Act 1869 or any similar or successor enactment:

"motor cycle" means a mechanically propelled vehicle (not being an invalid carriage) with fewer than four wheels of which the unladen weight does not exceed 410 kilograms:

"solo motor cycle" means a motor cycle without a side car and having no more than two wheels:

"goods vehicle" means a motor vehicle or trailer constructed or adapted for use for the carriage of goods including goods or burden of any description:

"heavy commercial vehicle" means a goods vehicle which has an operating weight exceeding 7.5 tonnes;

"goods" means goods or merchandise of any kind whether animate or inanimate and includes postal packets of any description but does not include documents, cash or keys however packaged except where the weight or size of packages containing such objects means that they cannot be easily carried from the nearest parking place or car park;

"delivering" and "collecting" in relation to goods includes checking the goods for the purpose of their delivery or collection;

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as given in Regulation 3(1) of The Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000 providing the expiry date on the badge has not passed:

"permit" means a permit issued at the discretion of the Council, which allows a vehicle on which the said permit is clearly displayed in the relevant position to enter the pedestrian zone for which the permit has been issued;

"permit holder" means a person who has obtained a permit from the Council:

"relevant position" in relation to a disabled persons badge or permit means:-

- (a) Attached to the front windscreen or placed on the dashboard or fascia of the vehicle so that the details on the front side of the badge or permit are clearly legible from outside of the vehicle; or
- (b) Where the vehicle either does not have a front windscreen, dashboard or fascia, or, where it would be impracticable to exhibit the badge or permit as provided in paragraph (a) above, exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the details on the front side of the badge or permit are clearly legible from outside of the vehicle.

"front side" in relation to the exhibition of badges and permits means:

- (a) For a disabled persons badge, the side which shows the wheelchairusers symbol, the expiry date and the serial number of the badge;
- (b) For a permit, the side which shows the issuing authority, the registration number of the vehicle the permit has been issued for and the period of validity of the permit.

"owner" has the same meaning as in Section 142 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

"bus lane" means any street, any part of a street or any traffic lane reserved for use only by buses, taxis and pedal cycles and identified by the appropriate signs and road markings;

"contraflow bus lane" means a traffic lane reserved for use only by buses, taxis and pedal cycles in a one-way street which allows such vehicles to travel in the opposite direction to the directed traffic flow for that street:

"pedestrian zone" means an area which has been laid out to improve amenity for pedestrians and to which the entry of vehicles is limited by purpose and/or time of day;

"street" and "road" have the same meaning for the purpose of this Order:

"cause" includes "permit" and "causing" includes "permitting".

#### GENERAL PROVISIONS

### 20 mph speed limit

Save as provided for in Articles 19 and 20 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in excess of 20 miles per hour in the lengths of road specified in the First Schedule hereto.

#### One-way street

Save as provided for in Articles 19 and 20 of this Order no person snall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven in any of the lengths of road specified in the Second Schedule hereto in a direction other than the permitted direction specified in the Schedule for the said length of road.

### One-way street except pedal cycles

3) Save as provided for in Articles 19 and 20 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle except a pedal cycle to be driven in any of the lengths of road specified in the Third Schedule hereto in a direction other than the permitted direction specified in the Schedule for the said length of road.

#### No left turn

4) Save as provided for in Articles 19 and 20 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to make a manoeuvre in the manner stated in the length of road specified in the Fourth Schedule hereto.

#### No right turn

5) Save as provided for in Articles 19 and 20 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to make a manoeuvre in the manner stated in the length of road specified in the Fifth Schedule hereto.

### No 'U' turn

Save as provided for in Articles 19 and 20 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to make a manoeuvre in the manner stated in the length of road specified in the Sixth Schedule hereto.

#### No heavy commercial vehicles at any time

7) Save as provided for in Articles 19 and 20 of this Order no person shall cause or permit a heavy commercial vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in the Seventh Schedule hereto.

#### No vehicles from 9pm to 5am

Save as provided for in Articles 19 and 21 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in the Eighth Schedule hereto between the hours of 9pm and 5am.

# No motor vehicles at any time

Save as provided for in Articles 19 and 21 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in the Ninth Schedule hereto.

# No motor vehicles except buses and taxis (bus lane)

10) Save as provided for in Articles 19 and 22 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in the Tenth Schedule hereto other than a bus or taxi.

### No motor vehicles except buses and taxis (contraflow bus lane)

11) Save as provided for in Articles 19 and 22 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in the Eleventh Schedule hereto other than a bus or taxi in the direction specified in the Eleventh Schedule.

# No motor vehicles except buses, taxis and permit holders at any time and for loading or unloading from 5am to 10am and from 5pm to 9pm

12) Save as provided for in Articles 19, 23 and 24 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in the Twelfth Schedule hereto other than a bus or taxi at any time or any vehicle which is being used in connection with the delivery or collection of goods or merchandise to or from premises either in or adjoining the lengths of road specified in the Twelfth Schedule between the hours of 5am and 10am or between the hours of 5pm and 9pm.

# No motor vehicles except buses, taxis and permit holders from 5am to 9pm and for loading or unloading from 5am to 10am and from 5pm to 9pm

13) Save as provided for in Articles 19, 23 and 24 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in the Thirteenth Schedule hereto other than a bus or taxi between the hours of 5am and 9pm or any vehicle which is being used in connection with the delivery or collection of goods or merchandise to or from premises either in or adjoining the lengths of road specified in the Thirteenth Schedule between the hours of 5am and 10am or between the hours of 5pm and 9pm.

# No motor vehicles except buses, taxis, permit holders and for loading or unloading at any time

14) Save as provided for in Articles 19, 23 and 24 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in the Fourteenth Schedule hereto other than a bus or a taxi or a permit holder's vehicle or any vehicle which is being used in connection with the delivery or collection of goods or merchandise to or from premises either in or adjoining the lengths of road specified in the Fourteenth Schedule.

# No motor vehicles except buses and permit holders at any time and for loading or unloading from 5am to 10am and from 5pm to 9pm

15) Save as provided for in Articles 19, 23 and 24 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in the Fifteenth Schedule hereto other than a bus or a permit holder's vehicle at any time or any vehicle which is being used in connection with the delivery or collection of goods or merchandise to or from premises either in or adjoining the lengths of road specified in the Fifteenth Schedule between the hours of 5am and 10am or between the hours of 5pm and 9pm.

No motor vehicles except permit nolders, disabled persons vehicles and for loading or unloading at any time

Save as provided for in Articles 19, 23 and 24 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in the Sixteenth Schedule hereto at any time other than a permit holder's vehicle or a disabled person's vehicle or any vehicle which is being used in connection with the delivery or collection of goods or merchandise to or from premises either in or adjoining the lengths of road specified in the Sixteenth Schedule at any time.

No motor vehicles except permit holders and for loading or unloading at any time

17) Save as provided for in Articles 19, 23 and 24 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in the Seventeenth Schedule hereto other than a permit holder's vehicle at any time or any vehicle which is being used in connection with the delivery or collection of goods or merchandise to or from premises either in or adjoining the lengths of road specified in the Seventeenth Schedule at any time.

No motor vehicles except permit holders at any time and for loading or unloading from 5am to 10am and from 5pm to 9pm

Save as provided for in Articles 19, 23 and 24 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in the Eighteenth Schedule hereto other than a permit holder's vehicle at any time or any vehicle which is being used in connection with the delivery or collection of goods or merchandise to or from premises either in or adjoining the lengths of road specified in the Eighteenth Schedule between the hours of 5pm and 9pm.

### **EXEMPTIONS**

- 19) Nothing in this Order shall apply to anything done under the direction or with the consent of a Police Officer in uniform.
- 20) Nothing in Articles 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause a vehicle to travel in contravention of the requirements of the said Articles if the vehicle is being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency.
- 21) Nothing in Article 9 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause a vehicle to travel in the lengths of road specified in the Ninth Schedule hereto if the vehicle is authorised to do so by an Officer or the Council.

- 22) Nothing in Articles 10 and 11 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause a vehicle to be in a bus lane in the lengths of road specified in the Tentr. and Eleventh Schedules hereto for as long as may be necessary:
  - (a) To enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle if and in so far as the activity is not prohibited by the provisions of any other Order;
  - (b) To enable a vehicle in the service of or employed by a universal service provider and in actual use as such to unload and deliver postal packets addressed to premises adjacent to the bus lane, or to collect and load postal packets from postal boxes or premises adjacent to the bus lane;
  - (c) To enable the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
  - (d) To enable the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any road or any street furniture, including bus stop infrastructure;
  - (e) To enable a vehicle in the service of the local authority for the purpose of collecting refuse;
  - (f) To enable the vehicle if it cannot be used for such purposes in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation, or demolition;
  - (g) To enable a vehicle to get to or from any road adjacent to the bus lane or any vehicular access to premises adjacent to the bus lane;
  - (h) To enable a vehicle in connection with the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near to a bus lane of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in paragraph 1(1) of Schedule 2 of the Telecommunications Act 1984 if the vehicle cannot be used for that purpose without being in the bus lane and in so far as the activity is not prohibited by the provisions of any other Order:
  - (i) To enable a vehicle to avoid an accident or to enable a vehicle to comply with any requirement resulting from works, road works or an emergency in any part of the road adjoining the bus lane;
  - (j) To enable the vehicle to be used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency.
- 23) Nothing in Articles 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 and 18 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road referred to in the Twelfth. Thirteenth, Fourteenth, Fifteenth, Sixteenth, Seventeenth and Eighteenth Schedules hereto for as long as may be necessary.-
  - (a) To enable any police, fire brigade or ambulance emergency vehicle to pass through those lengths of road for the purpose of attending any emergency;
  - (b) To enable a specialist security vehicle contracted to a bank or other secure premises either in or adjoining those lengths of road to access that bank or premises for the purpose of loading or unloading valuables;
  - (c) To enable the vehicle in an emergency to pass through those lengths of road in order to carry any equipment needed for the purpose of maintaining any paved surfaces, traffic signs or buildings within those lengths of road providing that the vehicle cannot conveniently be used for that purpose in any other length of road

- (d) To enable the vehicle to pass through those lengths of road in order to carry any equipment needed for the purpose of laying, erecting, altering or repairing in those lengths of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in paragraph 1(1) of Schedule 2 of the Telecommunications Act 1984 if the vehicle cannot conveniently be used for that purpose in any other length of road;
- (e) To enable the vehicle to pass through those lengths of road in order to carry any equipment needed for the purpose of delivering, erecting, dismantling or removing any stand or stall authorised for use for the sale of goods or services or the provision of public information, or for taking or collecting goods or materials from such a stand or stall, within those lengths of road, providing that the vehicle cannot conveniently be used for that purpose in any other length of road and that the stand or stall has been licensed by the Council, or a body authorised to issue such a licence by the Council, for use in those lengths of road.
- 24) Nothing in Articles 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 and 18 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road referred to in the Twelfth, Thirteenth, Fourteenth, Fifteenth, Sixteenth, Seventeenth and Eighteenth Schedules hereto between the hours of 5am and 10am or between the hours of 5pm and 9pm for as long as may be necessary:-
  - (a) To enable the vehicle to pass through those lengths of road in order to carry any equipment needed for the purpose of maintaining or cleaning any planted areas, paved surfaces, traffic signs or buildings, or for collecting any waste materials within those lengths of road providing that the vehicle cannot conveniently be used for that purpose in any other length of road;
  - (b) To enable a vehicle in the service of or employed by a universal service provider, and in actual use as such, to pass through those lengths of road in order to unload and deliver postal packets addressed to premises adjacent to the lengths of road, or to collect and load postal packets from postal boxes or premises adjacent to the lengths of road, if the vehicle cannot conveniently be used for that purpose in any other length of road:
  - (c) To enable the vehicle to pass through those lengths of road in order to deliver newspapers or magazines to premises adjacent to the lengths of road if the vehicle cannot conveniently be used for that purpose in any other length of road.

#### INTERPRETATION

25) The interpretation Act, 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

#### **REVOCATIONS**

26) Those parts of the Traffic Regulation Orders specified in the Nineteenth Schedule of this Order are hereby revoked.

#### OPERATIONAL DATE and CITATION

27) This Order shall come into operation on the 26th March 2013 and may be cited as "City of Stoke-on-Trent (Traffic Regulation) (Hanley Bus Re-Routing) (No.35) Order 2012".
