VARIATION ORDER 2010

The Stroud District Council in the County of Gloucester in exercise of its powers under Section 35(1) and Schedule 9 Part IV of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf and with the consent of the Gloucestershire County Council pursuant to Section 39(3) of the Act of 1984 and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Schedule 9 Part III paragraph 20(1) of the Act of 1984 hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. (1) The Order may be cited as the Stroud District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order Variation Order 2010.
 - (2) This Order shall come into operation on 27th September 2010.
- 2. The Order shall have effect as follows:
 - (1) By deleting from Schedule 2 Dursley short-stay, May Lane Car Park column 2 the words "3 hours between 08:00am 06:00pm" and substituting the words "23 hours".
 - (2) By deleting from Schedule 2 Dursley short-stay Castle Street Car Park column 2 the words "2 hours between 08:00am 06:00pm" and substituting the words "3 hours between 08:00am 06:00pm".
 - (3) By introducing a limited number of Business Parking Permits for use in the Castle Street (Pool) Car Park, Dursley.
 - (4) By deleting from Schedule 5 Berkeley long-stay Marybrook Street Car Park column 2 the words "23 hours" and substituting the words "3 hours".
 - (5) By deleting from Multi Storey London Road Car Park levels 1 and 1A, 5 and 5A and 2 to 4A Schedule 1 column 4 and Table 1 (Times and charges) column 2 the words "All hours" and substituting the words "opening between 07:00am 6:30pm".
 - (6) By deleting from Schedule 1 Multi Storey London Road Car Park levels 1 and 1A the words "23 hours" and substituting the words "3 hours".
