THE CITY OF SUNDERLAND (CITY CENTRE AREA) (WAITING AND LOADING AND PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2016

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNDERLAND ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 45 and 122 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act and with the persons and organisations specified in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 hereby makes the following Order:-

TITLE AND COMMENCEMENT

 This Order may be cited as The City of Sunderland (City Centre Area) (Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) Order 2016 and shall come into operation on the 31st May 2016

DEFINITIONS

2.(1) In this Order:-

"the Act" means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

"Bay" means a space within a Parking Place which is provided for the leaving of a vehicle and indicated by markings on the surface of the Parking Place;

"Carriageway" means a way constituting or comprised in a highway being a way (other than a cycle track) over which the public have a right of passage of vehicles but excludes any lay-by;

"Chargeable Hours" has the meaning assigned to it in paragraph 2 of Article 29

"Civil Enforcement Officer" means a person authorised by or on behalf of the Council to supervise and enforce any restrictions imposed by this Order;

"Credit Card" has the same meaning as in Section 35A of the Act;

"Debit Card" has the same meaning as in Section 35A of the Act;

"Disabled Person's Badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000;

"Dispensation Certificate" means a certificate issued by or on behalf of the Council under the provisions of this Order permitting a specified vehicle to wait in specified circumstances in a Parking Place, where the waiting by that

vehicle would otherwise be restricted or prohibited by the provisions of this Order;

"Driver" in relation to a vehicle waiting in a Parking Place, means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in the Parking Place;

"Expiry Time" means the time printed on the front of a ticket issued by a Ticket Machine being the time until which the charge specified in Article 31 has been paid

"Hackney Carriage" has the same meaning as in the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 and the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976;

"Hackney Carriage Rank" has the same meaning as in Section 63 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976;

"Hand Held Device" means a wireless hand held computer which is programmed to receive and record information transmitted by the Pay By Phone System and operated by a Civil Enforcement Officer to facilitate the enforcement of Parking Places;

"Loading Bay" means a parking place for the purpose of loading and unloading and picking up and setting down of passengers;

"Location Identification Number" means the location number assigned to each Parking Place where the "Pay by Phone" system is in operation:

"Mobile Telephone" means any wireless telegraphy apparatus as defined in The Wireless Telegraphy Act 2006 designed or adapted for the purposes of transmitting and receiving spoken or text messages so as to provide a network within the meaning of The Communications Act 2003 and is not physically connected to the land line;

"Motor Car" has the same meaning as in Section 136(2) of the Act;

"Motor Cycle" has the same meaning as in Section 136(4) of the Act;

"Parking Disc" has the same meaning as in Regulation 8(5) of the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000;

"Parking Place" means a place designated by this Order for the leaving of a vehicle;

"Passenger Vehicle" has the same meaning as in Regulation 4 of the Regulations

"Pay by Phone System" means the system operated and maintained by the Council's appointed Service Provider to accept and record payments of

parking charges (inclusive of any appropriate administrative charge), made by means of a Credit or Debit Card or any other approved method of secure authorised payment and transmitted by a Mobile Telephone or internet apparatus to obtain a period of parking in a Parking Place where the Pay by Phone System is operational and indicated by lawful signs;

"Regulated Road" means any of the roads, lengths of road or sides of road specified in the Schedules to this Order;

"the Regulations" means the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002;

"Relevant Position" means:-

- (a) in the case of a Disabled Person's Badge
 - (i) where a vehicle is fitted with a dashboard or fascia, the badge is exhibited on the dashboard or fascia, or
 - (ii) where a vehicle is not fitted with a dashboard or fascia, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle

so that the front of the badge displaying the serial number and expiry date is clearly legible from the outside of the vehicle; and

- (b) in the case of a Parking Disc -
 - where a vehicle is fitted with a dashboard or fascia the disc is exhibited on the dashboard or fascia; or
 - (ii) where the vehicle is not fitted with a dashboard or fascia the disc is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle

so that, when marked to show the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting began, that period is clearly legible from the outside of the vehicle; and

- (c) in the case of a ticket means:-
 - where a vehicle is fitted with a dashboard or fascia, the ticket is exhibited on the dashboard or fascia; or

(ii) where a vehicle is not fitted with a dashboard or fascia, the ticket is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle;

so that the Expiry Time on the ticket is clearly legible from the outside of the vehicle; and

- (d) in the case of Waiver Certificate or Dispensation Certificate -
 - where a vehicle is fitted with a dashboard or fascia, the waiver certificate or dispensation certificate is exhibited on the dashboard or fascia, or
 - (ii) where a vehicle is not fitted with a dashboard or fascia the Waiver Certificate or Dispensation Certificate is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle

so that the front of the Waiver Certificate or Dispensation Certificate showing the location, vehicle registration number and expiry date is clearly legible from the outside of the vehicle

"Service Provider" means the contractor or agent authorised by the Council to operate and accept the payment of parking charges by means of the "Pay by Phone" system

"Ticket Machine" means an apparatus or device approved by the Secretary of State being apparatus designed to issue parking tickets indicating the payment was made or the time of expiry

"Traffic Sign" means a sign of any size, colour and type prescribed or authorised under, or having effect as though prescribed or authorised under Section 64 of the Act:

"the 2002 Regulations" means the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002

"Universal Service Provider" and "Provision of a Universal Postal Service" have the same meanings as in the Postal Services Act 2000;

"Waiver Certificate" means a certificate issued by or on behalf of the Council permitting a specified vehicle to wait in specified circumstances on a length or lengths of road where the waiting of that vehicle would otherwise be restricted or prohibited by the provisions of this Order

"Zone A Permit" means a parking permit issued by the Council to residents who reside in the following streets: Northcote Avenue, Salisbury Street,

Winifred Terrace, Laura Street, Churchill Street, Barleycom Place or Meaburn Street

- 2.(2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment, regulation or other similar instrument shall be construed as a reference to the enactment, regulation or other similar instrument as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment, regulation or other similar instrument.
- 2.(3) The Schedules form part of this Order and will have the same force and effect as if expressly set out in the body of this Order and any reference to this Order will include the Schedules
- 2.(4) The headings to the Articles of this Order will not affect its construction
- 2.(5) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 2 .(6) In this Order the masculine includes the feminine and vice versa and the singular includes the plural where the context so admits

PROHIBITION OF WAITING

3. No Waiting at any time

Save as provided in Articles 5, 6, 7 and 8 of this Order, no person shall, except under the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform, cause or permit a vehicle to wait at any time in a regulated road specified in Section 1.01 of Schedule 1.

No Waiting Monday to Saturday 8am-6pm

Save as provided in Articles 5, 6, 7 and 8 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform cause or permit a vehicle to wait between the hours of 8am to 6pm Monday to Saturday (inclusive) in a regulated road specified in Section 1.41 of Schedule 1

5. Exemptions

Nothing in Articles 3 and 4 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the regulated roads referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable:-

(a) the picking up and setting down of passengers

- (b) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in another road, to be used in connection with any of the following purposes, namely:-
 - (i) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (ii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of a road;
 - (iii) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on land adjacent to the said regulated roads of any sewer or of any main, pipe, apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of telecommunications apparatus;
- (c) the vehicle not being a passenger vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in another road, to be used in the service of a local authority or its contractors in pursuance of that authority's statutory powers or duties;
- (d) the vehicle, being a vehicle of a Universal Service Provider, to be used in the provision of the Universal Postal Service;
- (e) the loading onto or unloading from the vehicle of goods at any time PROVIDED THAT this paragraph shall not apply to as to exempt any person from prohibition contained in Articles 9, 10, 11 and 12 of this Order unless the vehicle is a vehicle of Universal Service Provider engaged in the provision of a Universal Postal Service;
- (f) an official vehicle being used for a wedding or funeral, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in another road, to wait at or near to any premises situated on or adjacent to the regulated road for as long as waiting by that vehicle is reasonably necessary in connection with a wedding or funeral;
- (g) the vehicle to be used in an emergency for police fire and rescue or ambulance purposes if the observance of the prohibition on waiting would be likely to hinder the use of that vehicle for the purpose for which it is being used on that occasion;
- Nothing in Articles 3 and 4 shall prevent any person from causing or
 permitting a vehicle to wait in any of the regulated roads referred to therein if it
 is displaying in the Relevant Position a valid Waiver Certificate or

Dispensation Certificate issued by the Council and the vehicle is waiting in accordance with the terms and conditions of the said certificate.

- Nothing in Articles 3 and 4 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit the following vehicles to wait in any of the regulated roads referred to therein:-
 - a Hackney Carriage waiting at a duly authorised Hackney Carriage Rank during the period of operation of the Hackney Carriage Rank;
 - (ii) a vehicle waiting in a Parking Place duly authorised by this Order or any other Order made under the Act provided that the vehicle is parked in accordance with the provisions of the Order which so authorised the Parking Place
- Nothing in Articles 3 and 4 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or 8. permit a vehicle which displays in the Relevant Position continuously throughout the period of waiting a valid Disabled Person's Badge and a Parking Disc marked to show the quarter hour period during which the period of exempted waiting began, to wait in a regulated road specified in Sections 1.01 and 1.41 of Schedule 1 for a period not exceeding three hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same road on the same day) PROVIDED THAT the vehicle immediately before or after the act of waiting has been or is about to be driven or used by the person to whom the badge has been issued or as the case may be, used for the carrying of a disabled person as a passenger; and PROVIDED THAT nothing in this paragraph shall apply so as to exempt a vehicle from any prohibition contained in the said Articles during any period when a prohibition of loading or unloading applies to the Regulated Road concerned or any part thereof

PROHIBITION OF LOADING AND UNLOADING

No loading/unloading at any time

Save as provided in Articles 13 and 14 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait for the purpose of loading to or unloading from a vehicle, in a regulated road specified in Section 2.01 of Schedule 2.

10. No loading/unloading: All Days 10am-3pm

Save as provided in Articles 13 and 14 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait for the purpose of loading to or unloading from the vehicle, all days between the hours of 10am to 3pm in a regulated road specified in Section 2.13 of Schedule 2

11. No loading/unloading: Monday to Saturday, 8am-6pm

Save as provided in Articles 13 and 14 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait for the purpose of loading to or unloading from the vehicle, Monday to Saturday (inclusive) between the hours of 8am to 6pm in a regulated road specified in Section 2.41of Schedule 2.

12. No loading/unloading: Monday to Saturday, 8.30am to 9.30am and 4pm to 6pm

Save as provided in Articles 13 and 14 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait for the purpose of loading to or unloading from the vehicle, Monday to Saturday (inclusive) between the hours of 8.30am to 9.30am and 4pm to 6pm in a regulated road specified in Section 2.62 of Schedule 2

13. Exemptions

Nothing in Articles 9, 10, 11 and 12 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle to wait in a regulated road referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable:-

- (a) the picking up and setting down of passengers;
- (b) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in another road, to be used in connection with any of the following purposes, namely:
 - the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (ii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of a road;
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on land adjacent to the said regulated roads of any sewer, or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of telecommunications apparatus;
- (c) the vehicle not being a passenger vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in another road, to be used in the service of a local authority or its contractors acting in pursuance of that authority's statutory powers or duties;
- (d) the vehicle, being a vehicle of a Universal Service Provider, to be used in the provision of a Universal Postal Service;

- (e) an official vehicle being used for a wedding or funeral, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in another road, to wait at or near premises situated on or adjacent to the regulated road for as long as waiting by that vehicle is reasonably necessary in connection with a wedding or funeral;
- (f) the vehicle to be used in an emergency for police, fire and rescue or ambulance purposes if the observance of the prohibition on loading and unloading would be likely to hinder the use of that vehicle for the purpose for which it is being used on that occasion;
- 14. Nothing in Articles 9, 10, 11 and 12 of this Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait or load or unload in any of the regulated roads referred to therein if it is displaying in the Relevant Position a valid Waiver Certificate or Dispensation Certificate issued by the Council and the vehicle is waiting or loading or unloading in accordance with the terms and conditions of the said certificate

WAIVER CERTIFICATES AND DISPENSATION CERTIFICATES

- 15. The Council may issue a Waiver Certificate or a Dispensation Certificate on receipt of an application and may impose charges, terms and conditions as appropriate.
- 16. A Waiver Certificate or Dispensation Certificate may be cancelled at any time at the sole discretion of the Council and shall thereupon immediately cease to be valid. Notification of such cancellation shall be in writing to the holder of the certificate and either delivered to him personally or sent to or left at any address that the Council believes to be that person's address and the certificate shall forthwith be surrendered to the Council.

DISABLED PERSON'S PARKING PLACES

17. All days all hours

The Regulated Roads specified in Section 3.01 of Schedule 3 are authorised to be used, subject to the provisions of this Order, as Parking Places for vehicles displaying a valid Disabled Person's Badge, in such positions as are specified in the said Schedule, provided always that there is on display in the vehicle in the Relevant Position a valid Disabled Person's Badge.

18. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to park in a Parking Place authorised by Article 17 of this Order to be used by a vehicle displaying a valid Disabled Person's Badge unless the vehicle immediately before or after the act of parking has been or is about to be driven or used by the person to whom the Disabled Person's Badge has been issued or, as the case may be, used for the carrying of that disabled person as a passenger.

GENERAL PARKING PLACES

19. Monday to Saturday 8am to 6pm, 2 hour maximum, no return within 1 hour

Save as provided in Articles 21 and 23, each of the Regulated Roads specified in Section 4.41 of Schedule 4 are authorised to be used, subject to the provisions of this Order, as a Parking Place for such classes of vehicles parked in the position specified in the said Schedule between the hours of 8am to 6pm Monday to Saturday (inclusive) for a maximum waiting time of 2 hours PROVIDED THAT no vehicle which has been taken away from a Bay within a Parking Place referred to in the said Schedule shall, until the expiration of one hour from the time it was taken away, be left again in that Parking Place.

20. Monday to Saturday 8am to 6pm, 1 hour limit, no return within 1 hour (Zone A Permit holders exempt)

Save as provided in Articles 21, 22 and 23, each of the Regulated Roads specified in Section 4.91 of Schedule 4 are authorised to be used, subject to the provisions of this Order, as Parking Place for such classes of vehicles parked in the position specified in the said Schedule between the hours of 8am to 6pm Monday to Saturday (inclusive) for a maximum waiting time of 1 hour PROVIDED THAT no vehicle which has been taken away from a Bay within a Parking Place referred to in the said Schedule shall, until the expiration of one hour from the time it was taken way, be left again in that Parking Place.

21. Exemption for vehicles displaying a valid Disabled Person's Badge

A vehicle which displays in the Relevant Position continuously throughout the period of waiting a valid Disabled Person's Badge shall be exempt from compliance with any limitation of time during which a vehicle may be left in a Parking Place specified in Section 4.41 and 4.91 of Schedule 4 to this Order or any return period specified, provided that the vehicle immediately before or after the act of waiting has been or is about to be driven or used by the person to whom the badge has been issued or as the case may be, used for the carrying of that person as a passenger

22. Exemption for vehicles displaying a valid Zone A Permit

A vehicle which displays in the Relevant Position continuously throughout the period of waiting a valid Zone A Permit shall be exempt from compliance with any limitation of time during which a vehicle may be left in a Parking Place specified in Section 4.91 of Schedule 4 to this Order or any return period specified.

23. Exemption for vehicle displaying a Dispensation Certificate

Nothing in Articles 19 and 20 of this Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting any vehicle to wait in any of the Parking Places referred to therein if it is displaying, in the Relevant Position, a valid Dispensation Certificate issued by the Council and the vehicle is waiting in accordance with the terms and conditions of the said certificate

PARKING PLACES FOR LOADING AND UNLOADING

All days all hours

24. The Regulated Roads specified in Section 5.01 of Schedule 5 are authorised to be used, subject to the provisions of this Order, as Parking Places for the loading and unloading of such classes of vehicles parked in the positions specified in relation to those lengths of roads in the said Schedule.

Monday to Saturday, 8am to 6pm

- 25. The Regulated Roads specified in Section 5.41 of Schedule 5 are authorised to be used, subject to the provisions of this Order, as Parking Places for the loading and unloading of such classes of vehicles parked in the positions specified in relation to those lengths of roads in the said Schedule between the hours of 8am to 6pm Monday to Saturday (inclusive)
- 26. No person shall permit a vehicle to wait in any Parking Place described in Sections 5.01 and 5.41 of Schedule 5 unless it is engaged in loading and/or unloading or picking up and/or setting down passengers and in any case no vehicle shall be permitted to wait for any longer than is necessary to carry out the aforementioned activities.
- Nothing in Article 24 and 25 above shall render it unlawful for a vehicle which displays in the Relevant Position continuously throughout the period of waiting a Disabled Person's Badge and a Parking Disc marked to show the quarter hour period during which the period of exempted waiting began, to wait in the Parking Places referred to in Articles 24 and 25 above for a period not exceeding three hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same road on the same day) PROVIDED THAT the vehicle immediately before or after the act of waiting or parking has been or is about to be driven or used by the person to whom the Disabled Person's Badge has been issued or as the case may be, used for the carrying of that disabled person as a passenger

PARKING PLACES WITH TICKET MACHINES

Parking Places

- 28. Each area of the highway described in Column 2 of Section 7.435 of Schedule 6 to this Order is hereby designated as Parking Place between the hours of 8am to 6pm, every day.
- In this Order the Chargeable Hours means the period specified in Column 4 of Section 7.435 of Schedule 6 to this Order
- 30. The number and situation of Bays in each Parking Place shall be determined by the Council and the limits of each Parking Place and the limits of each Bay shall be indicated by the Council on the Carriageway by appropriate Traffic Signs

Charges and Method of Payment

- 31. Subject to Article 32, 33, 34, 35, 36 and 39 of this Order, no person may leave or cause any vehicle to be left in a Parking Place specified in Column 2 of Section 7.435 of Schedule 6 to this Order during the Chargeable Hours except upon the payment of the charges specified in Column 4 of the said Schedule in relation to that Parking Place.
- 32. The Driver of a vehicle using a Parking Place specified in Column 2 of Section 7.435 of Schedule 6 to this Order shall:-
 - (a) immediately after entering the Parking Place insert the appropriate coin, coins or bank notes into a Ticket Machine, which shall be used as a means of collecting the charge imposed by Article 31 of this Order and which shall issue a numbered ticket indicating the Expiry Time of the ticket and the day of issue of the said ticket
 - (b) Not insert any coin or bank note other than those of the denominations indicated on the front of the Ticket Machine into the Ticket Machine
 - (c) use the ticket referred to in paragraph (a) above of this Article only at the Parking Place at which it is issued
 - (d) Leave the vehicle in the Parking Place on the day of issue only until the Expiry Time stated on the ticket
 - (e) Display the ticket in the Relevant Position on the vehicle at all times when the vehicle is parked in the Parking Place during the Chargeable Hours

Payment by Phone System

- 33. The Driver of a vehicle who wishes to pay the charges imposed by Article 31 of this Order by the Council's Pay by Phone system shall first of all register the information contained in Article 34 with the Council's Service Provider
- 34. The information referred to in Article 31 above is:-
 - (a) the telephone number of a mobile telephone
 - (b) a Credit Card or Debit Card identification number, expiry date and such other information as may be requested by the Service Provider relating to the Credit Card or Debit Card against which the payment will be made; and
 - (c) the registration number of the vehicle in respect of which the charges are to be paid
- 35. The telephone number of the Mobile Telephone registered in accordance with Article 34 shall for the purposes of this Order be known as the "Account Number"
- 36. Once the Driver of the vehicle has registered the information required by Article 34, he may pay the charges imposed by Article 31 of this Order in accordance with the provisions of this Order by the Council's Pay by Phone System by disclosing the following information to the Council's Service Provider:-
 - (a) their Account Number
 - (b) the Credit and or Debit Card identification number, expiry date and such other details as may be requested by the Service Provider relating to the Credit Card or Debit Card against which the payment is being made
 - (c) the Location Identification Number of the Parking Place in respect of which payment is being made; and
 - (d) the registration number of the vehicle being parked
- 37. Where payment of the charges imposed by Article 31 are made in accordance with the provisions of this Order, the period of parking shall commence on receipt by the Service Provider of the information specified in Article 34 of this Order
- 38. Where payment of the parking charges imposed by Article 31 of this Order have been made in accordance with the provisions of this Order, the period of

- parking may be increased by payment of an additional sum towards the period of parking by the Councils Pay by Phone System.
- 39. The Driver of a vehicle who pays the charges imposed by Article 31 of this Order via the Pay by Phone system shall, in addition to paying such charges, pay such administrative charges in connection with the use of the Pay by Phone System to the Council's Service Provider in each Parking Place where the Pay by Phone System is in operation.
- 40. In any proceedings in respect of an alleged contravention of or noncompliance with this Order:-
 - (a) the indications as to the date, time and place on a ticket issued by a Ticket Machine shall be evidence that such ticket was issued and the parking time recorded according to such indications
 - (b) in respect of the Parking Places mentioned in Column 2 of Section 7.435 of Schedule to this Order, the absence of a ticket from a vehicle left in a Parking Place shall be evidence that no such ticket has been issued, and that the charge specified in Column 4 of Section 7.435 of Schedule 6 to this Order has not been paid in respect thereof; using the method of payment specified in Article 32.
 - (c) it shall be assumed unless the contrary is shown that any ticket machine is of a type and design approved by the Secretary of State
 - (d) a verification from the Service Provider regarding the registration number of the vehicle, the Location Identification Number, the period of parking and the charges paid via an approved Hand Held Device relating to payment via the Pay by Phone System shall be evidence that the charges specified in Column 4 of Section 7.435 of Schedule 6 have been paid, unless the contrary is proved.
 - (e) in respect of the Parking Places specified in Column 2 of Section 7.435 of Schedule 6 to this Order in the absence of a record registered on the Council's Pay by Phone System which can be verified by a Civil Enforcement Officer on a Hand Held Device to indicate that a parking charge has been paid in respect of that vehicle it shall be presumed unless the contrary is proved that the parking charges set out in Column 4 of Section 7.435 of Schedule 6 to this Order have not been paid via the Council's Pay by Phone System.

Ticket Machine Indications

41. There shall be at Ticket Machine installed adjacent to, or in the vicinity of, each Parking Place specified in Column 2 of Section 7.435 of Schedule 6 to this Order.

- 42. The charge for a vehicle left in a Parking Place specified in Column 2 of Schedule 7.435 to this Order shall be indicated on the Ticket Machine relating to that Parking Place
- 43. Where a ticket has been exhibited on a vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Article 32 paragraph (e), no person, not being the Driver of the vehicle shall remove the ticket from the vehicle unless authorised to do so by the Driver

Removal of Vehicles from Parking Places

- 44. When a vehicle is left in a Parking Place in contravention of any of the provisions contained in this Order, a person authorised in that behalf by the Council may remove the vehicle or arrange for it to be moved from that Parking Place
- Where it appears to the Council that a vehicle left in a Parking Place has been abandoned, a person authorised in that behalf by the Council may remove the vehicle or arrange for it to be removed from that Parking Place, provided that where the Council propose to move such a vehicle which in their opinion is in such a condition that it ought to be destroyed, then they shall, not less than 7 days before removing it, cause to be affixed to the vehicle a notice stating that they propose to remove it for destruction at the end of the period specified in Section 101 of the Act
- 46. Any person removing a vehicle by authority of Article 44 or 45 of this Order may do so by towing or driving the vehicle or in such other manner as he may think necessary and may take such measures in relation to the vehicle as he may think necessary to enable him to remove it as aforesaid
- 47. When a person authorised by the Council removes or makes arrangements for the removal of the vehicle from a Parking Place by authority of Articles 44 and 45 of this Order, he shall, except in the case of a vehicle which in the opinion of the Council is in such condition that it ought to be destroyed, make such arrangements as may be deemed reasonably necessary for the safe custody of the vehicle.

Use of Parking Places during Chargeable Hours without payment

- 48. Without prejudice to the foregoing provisions of this Order relating to vehicles which are left in a Parking Place specified in Column 2 of Section 7.435 of Schedule 6 to this Order in accordance with those provisions any other vehicle may wait during the Chargeable Hours:-
 - (a) anywhere in a Parking Place specified in Column 2 of Section 7.435 of Schedule 6 to this Order if:-

- the vehicle is waiting only for so long as is necessary to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
- the vehicle is waiting due to the Driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his control or to such waiting being necessary in order to avoid an accident;
- (iii) the vehicle is used for fire and rescue service purposes, is an ambulance or is vehicle (other than a passenger vehicle) in the service of a local authority or is a vehicle in the service of a police force in either case being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (iv) the vehicle is waiting for so long as may be necessary to enable it to be used in connection with the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
- the vehicle is a vehicle of a Universal Service Provider engaged in the provision of a Universal Postal Service;
- (vi) the vehicle not being a passenger vehicle is waiting only for so long as may be reasonably necessary to enable it to be used for the purpose of any building operation, demolition or excavation in or adjacent to the Parking Place or the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the Parking Place or the laying, erection, alteration, removal or repair in or adjacent to the Parking Place of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus;
- (vii) the vehicle is waiting for the purpose of posting or removing advertising material in the form of posters on or from premises adjacent to the Parking Place in which the vehicle is waiting;
- (viii) in any other case the vehicle is waiting for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading the vehicle a premises adjacent to the Parking Place in which the vehicle is waiting and the vehicle does not wait for such purposes for more than twenty minutes or for such longer period as a police officer or a Civil Enforcement Officer in uniform may authorise.
- (b) anywhere in a Parking Place specified in Column 2 of Section 7.435 of Schedule 6 to this Order other than in a Bay if goods are sold from the

vehicle by a person who is licensed by the Council to sell goods from a stationary pitch situated in the Parking Place

- 49. No charge specified in the foregoing provisions of this Order shall be payable in respect of any vehicle waiting in a Parking Place specified in Column 2 of Section 7.435 of Schedule 6 in accordance with the provisions of Article 47
- 50. Any person who leaves or causes a vehicle to be left in a Parking Place specified in Column 2 of Section 7.435 of Schedule 6 to this Order by virtue of the provisions of paragraphs (vi), (vii) or (viii) of Article 48 shall take all steps necessary to ensure that the vehicle shall so stand as to be in accordance with the provisions of Article 55 of this Order.

Exemptions from Charges

- 51. If a vehicle therein is left in a Parking Place specified in Column 2 of Section 7.435 of Schedule 6 or Bay therein during the Chargeable Hours while there is on the Ticket Machine relating to that place or Bay or in or adjacent to the place or Bay a notice placed by any person authorised by the Council or by the Chief Constable indicating that the Ticket Machine is out of order, the vehicle will be exempt from the ticket machine charges, provided that after the Ticket Machine is repaired, the vehicle is removed within a reasonable time relating to the appropriate parking place, and in any event no later than the commencement of the Chargeable Hours for the next chargeable day
- 52. Any vehicle which displays in the Relevant Position a Disabled Person's Badge shall, if left in a Parking Place specified in Column 2 of Section 7.435 of Schedule 6 to this Order or parking Bay therein during the Chargeable Hours, be exempt from the payment of any charge

Installation of Ticket Machines

- 53. The Council may
 - (a) provide Ticket Machines or such other apparatus as may be required by this Order for the purposes of a Parking Place specified in Column 2 of Section 7.435 of Schedule 6 to this Order and
 - (b) carry out such other work as is authorised by this Order or is reasonably required for the purposes of satisfactory operation of a Parking Place specified in Column 2 of Section 7.435 of Schedule 6
 - install and maintain in proper working order at least one ticket machine is such a position as they think fit in/or in the vicinity of each of the Parking Places specified in Column 2 of Section 7.435 of Schedule 6 to this Order;

- (b) cause the limits of the Parking Place and of each Parking Space to be indicated on the carriageway by placing and maintaining thereon such signs and surface markings as it considers appropriate;
- (c) place and maintain in/or in the vicinity of each Parking Place such signs as it considers appropriate indicating that such a Parking Place may be used during the hours of operation for the leaving only of a vehicle specified in Column 3 of Section 7.435 of Schedule 6 to this Order
- (d) carry out such other work as is reasonably required for the purpose of the satisfactory operation of a Parking Place

PARKING PLACES FOR POLICE VEHICLE

54. All days all hours

The Regulated Roads specified in Section 20 of Schedule 7 to this Order are authorised to be used, subject to the provisions of this Order, as Parking Places for vehicles being used for police purposes in such positions as are specified in the said Schedule.

GENERAL PROVISIONS RELATING TO PARKING PLACES

- 55. No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to wait in a Parking Place referred to in Articles 17, 19, 20, 24, 25, 28 and 54 above other than wholly within the limits of a Bay.
- No person shall use a Parking Place referred to in Articles 17, 19, 20, 24, 25, 28 and 54 above so as to prevent access to any premises adjoining the road or the use of the road by other persons or so as to be a nuisance.
- The driver of a vehicle using a Parking Place referred to in Articles 17, 19, 20, 24, 25, 28 and 54 above shall stop the engines as soon as the vehicle is in position in the Parking Place and shall not start the engine except when about to change position of the vehicle in or to depart from the Parking Place.
- No person shall use a Parking Place referred to in Articles 17, 19, 20, 24, 25, 28 and 54 above or any vehicle while it is in a Parking Place, in connection with the sale or offering or exposing for sale any goods to any person in or near the Parking Place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire his skills or services without the written permission of the Council.
- 59. Subject to the proviso hereto, where a vehicle is left in a Parking Place referred to in Articles 17, 19, 20, 24, 25, 28 and 54 above in contravention of any of the provisions contained in this Order a person authorised in that behalf by the Council may remove the vehicle or arrange for it to be removed from that Parking Place provided that when a vehicle is waiting in a Parking

Place in contravention of any provisions regarding the position in which a vehicle must be parked in a Parking Place, a person authorised in that behalf by the Council may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle in order that its position shall comply with that provision

- 60. Any person removing a vehicle or altering its position by virtue of Article 57 of this Order may do so by towing or driving the vehicle or in such other manner as they may think necessary and may take measures in relation to the vehicle as they may think necessary to enable them to remove it or alter its position, as the case may be.
- 61. Any person duly authorised by the Council may suspend temporarily the use of a Parking Place referred to in Articles 17, 19, 20, 24, 25, 28 and 54 above or any part thereof whenever they consider such suspension reasonably necessary:-
 - for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety
 - (b) for the purpose of any building operation, demolition or excavation in or adjacent to the Parking Place or the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the highway or the cleansing of gullies in or adjacent to the Parking Place, the laying, erection, alteration, removal or repair in or adjacent to the Parking Place of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus or the placing, maintenance or removal of any traffic sign;
 - (c) for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the Parking Place on any occasion of the removal of furniture to or from one office or dwelling-house adjacent to the Parking Place from or to a depository, another office or dwelling-house;
 - on any occasion on which it is likely by reason of some special attraction that any street will be thronged or obstructed; or
 - for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the Parking Place at times of weddings or funerals or other special occasions;
 - (f) to facilitate the holding of an event either in the Parking Place (including any part thereof) or in a street adjacent to the Parking Place or to enable members of the public to watch an event
- 62. A police officer in uniform may suspend the use of a Parking Place referred to in Articles 17, 19, 20, 24, 25, 28 and 54 above or any part thereof whenever he considers such suspension reasonably necessary for the purpose of

- facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety. Any such suspension shall not exceed 24 hours.
- Any person suspending the use of a Parking Place referred to in Articles 17, 19, 20, 24, 25, 28 and 54 above or any part thereof in accordance with the provisions of Articles 61 and 62 shall thereupon place or cause to be placed in or adjacent to that Parking Place or part thereof a sign indicating that parking by vehicles is prohibited and the extent (where relevant) of the Parking Place where there is such a prohibition
- 64. No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to wait in a Parking Place referred to in Articles 17, 19, 20, 24, 25, 28 and 54 above or any part thereof during such period as the Council (or any person authorised on its behalf) or a police officer has suspended the Parking Place or any part thereof and notice of such suspension on or near the Parking Place indicates that waiting or parking is prohibited.

REVOCATION

- 65. The Orders specified in the Revocations Schedule to this Order are hereby revoked to the extent specified therein, together with any provisions of any other Order or Orders that have amended or modified the Orders to be revoked.
- 66. If any existing Order or Orders whose provisions conflict with any of the provisions of this Order and the Schedules hereto has or have not been revoked by this Order or any other Order then such conflicting Order or Orders are hereby revoked to the extent that their provisions conflict with this Order.

SUPPLEMENTARY PROVISION

67. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act, or by or under any other enactment.
