## (EPSOM AND EWELL PROHIBTION OF VERGE PARKING)

### **ORDER 2014**

THE SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of their powers conferred upon it by Sections 1(1) 2(1) and (2) and 4(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act hereby make the following Order:-

- THIS Order may be cited as "The Surrey County Council (Epsom and Ewell Prohibition of Verge Parking) Order 2014 and shall come into operation on 7 March 2014
- 2 (1) In this Order unless the context otherwise requires -

"carriageway" has the same meaning as in Section 329 of the Highways Act 1980

"enactment" means any enactment whether public general or local and includes any order byelaw rule regulation scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment

"footway" has the same meaning as in Section 329 of the Highways Act 1980

"motor vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the 1984 Act subject however to the provisions of Section 140 of that Act

"verge" means any part of a road which is not a carriageway

"road" includes any part of a road and has the same meaning as in Section 142 of the 1984 Act

- (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended applied consolidated re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment
- 3 NO person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to be driven or to be left on any of the land described in The Schedule to this Order or any part and/or parts thereof

- 4 NOTHING in Article 3 of this Order shall apply in relation to -
  - a motor vehicle being used for ambulance fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency or
  - (b) anything done upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or
  - (c) any person driving any motor vehicle requiring access to any of the land described in The Schedule to this Order or any part and/or parts thereof for the purpose of exercising any statutory power or performing any statutory duty therein or thereon or
  - (d) any person who causes any motor vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed by the Police pursuant to Section 66 or Section 67 of the 1984 Act or
  - (e) any authorised person exercising any lawful right or privilege to enter by motor vehicle or leave any such vehicle on the land described in The Schedule to this Order or any part and/or parts thereof

The areas of verge and footway adjacent to the entire lengths of the carriageway of Court Farm Avenue, Elm Way, Elmstead Close, Ewell Court Avenue, Fairfield Close, Fairfield Way, Lakehurst Road, Oakland Way, Pams Way, River Way and Willow Way, Ewell and which are shown coloured green on Drawing Number 69 annexed to this Order
