Citation and commencement

1 THIS Order may be cited as "The Surrey County Council (Epsom and Ewell Prohibition of Verge Parking) Order 2014 (Amendment No. 1) Order 2018" and shall come into operation on 19 November 2018

Interpretation

- 2 (1) In this Order "the Principal Order" means The Surrey County Council (Epsom and Ewell Prohibition of Verge Parking) Order 2014
 - (2) In this Order the expression "enactment" means any enactment whether public general or local and includes any order bylaw rule regulation scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment
 - (3) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended applied consolidated re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment
 - (4) Unless the context otherwise requires any expression used in this Order which is also used in the amended Order shall have the same meaning as in that Order

Amendment of the Principal Order

- WITHOUT prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of
 any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order the Principal Order shall
 have effect as though
 - (a) in The Schedule to the Order there were added the Second Schedule set out in The Schedule to this Order
 - (b) in Article 3 of the Order there were substituted following similarly numbered article –
 "3 NO person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to be driven or to be left on any of the land described in The Schedule and Second Schedule to this Order or any part and/or parts thereof"
 - (c) in sub-paragraph (c) of Article 4 of the Order there were substituted the following –
 "(c) any person driving any motor vehicle requiring access to any of the land described in The Schedule and Second Schedule to this Order or any part and/or

parts thereof for the purpose of exercising any statutory power or performing any statutory duty therein or thereon or"

in sub-paragraph (e) of Article 4 of the Order there were substituted the following –
 "(e) any authorised person exercising any lawful right or privilege to enter by motor vehicle or leave any such vehicle on the land described in The Schedule and Second Schedule to this Order or any part and/or parts thereof"
