 (Amendment No.1) Order 2006 and shall come into operation of 17 November 2006

2. (1) In this Order "the Principal Order" means The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Runnymede) (Prohibition of Stopping Outside Schools) (No.1) Order 2004
(2) In this Order the expression "enactment" means any enactment whether public general or local and includes any order bylaw rule regulation scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment
(3) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended applied consolidated re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment
(4) Unless the context otherwise requires any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Principal Order shall have the same meaning as in that Order

3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this order the Principal Order shall have effect as though -

- (a) for the item labelled "Stepgates Community School" in the First Schedule there was substituted the similarly labelled item in the Schedule to this Order
- (b) in the item labelled "Manorcroft Primary School" in the First Schedule for the number "24" there was substituted the number "43"

- (c) for the item labelled "Thorpe Lea Primary School" in the First Schedule there was substituted the similarly labelled item in the Schedule to this Order
- (d) for the item labelled "St Jude's CE School" in the First Schedule there was substituted the similarly labelled item in the Schedule to this Order
- (e) for the item labelled "Marshfields CE School" in the First Schedule there was substituted the similarly labelled item in the Schedule to this Order
- (f) the items labelled "Holy Family RC Primary School" "Ongar Place Infants School" "Fullbrook Secondary School" and "Trumps Green Infants School" in the Schedule to this Order were inserted in the First Schedule immediately following the item labelled "St Anne's Heath Junior School"
