(AMENDMENT TO PARKING PERMITS)
ORDER 2022

SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of their powers under Sections 32 35 36 45 46 49 51 and 53 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order: -

Citation and commencement

THIS Order may be cited as "The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in the Borough of Spelthorne) (Amendment to Parking Permits) Order 2022 and shall come into operation on 1 November 2022

Interpretation

2. (1) In this Order the expression -
- "enactment" means any enactment whether public general or local and includes any order byelaw rule regulation scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment
- "Principal Order" means each of the relevant Orders specified in Article 3(1) and Article 3(2) and Article 3(3) as the case may be
- (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended applied consolidated re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment
- (3) Unless the context otherwise requires any expression used in this Order which is also used in the amended Order shall have the same meaning as in that Order

Amendment of the Principal Orders

3 WITHOUT prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order -

(1) The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Spelthorne) (Residents' On-Street Parking Places) Order 2010 shall have effect as though -

(i) The following Section was added to Part III in the Arrangement of Articles

immediately following Section IVA

“SECTION V – CHILDCARE PARKING PERMITS

Application for and issue of a childcare parking permit..	27(F)
Fee to be paid in respect of a childcare parking permit..	27(G)
Form of childcare parking permit..	27(H)

(ii) The following item was added to the Arrangement of Articles as the third item –

“THIRD SCHEDULE Cost of Residents Permits”

(iii) The following expressions and meanings were added to paragraph (1) of Article 2 in alphabetical sequence -

““childcare parking permit” means a childcare parking permit issued by the Council under the provisions of Article 27(F)

“childcare parking permit holder” means a person to whom a childcare parking permit has been issued

“two-hour resident’s visitor’s parking permit” means a resident’s visitor’s parking permit that is limited to a validity of two hours”

(iv) The words “and shall include a two-hour resident’s visitor’s parking permit where applicable” were added to the interpretation of the expression “resident’s visitor’s parking permit” in paragraph (1) of Article 2 immediately following the number “23”

(v) The words “or as the case may be a childcare parking permit” was added to the meaning of the expression “parking permit” in paragraph (1) of Article 2 immediately following the words “carers parking permit”

(vi) The words “or as the case may be a childcare parking permit” was added to the meaning of the expression “parking permit holder” in paragraph (1) of Article 2 immediately following the words “carer parking permit”

(vii) The words “or a carer’s permit or a childcare parking permit” were added to the meaning of the expression “valid permit” in paragraph (1) of Article 2 immediately following the words “operational permit”

(viii) The phrase “or Article 27(e) or Article 27(I)” was inserted in Article 4 and Article 12B and Article 12C and Article 12D immediately following the number “27

(ix) The following words were inserted in paragraph (1) of Article 17 immediately following sub-paragraph (iii) –

“(iv) Any childcare parking permit shall be included in the calculation herein of a resident’s entitlement to a resident’s parking permit as though it was a resident’s parking permit”

(x) The words “or shared use parking place” were inserted in paragraph (4) of Article 17 immediately following the words “residents’ only parking place”

(xi) For paragraph (6) of Article 17 there was substituted the following similarly numbered paragraph-

“(6) The fee payable to the Council in respect of each resident’s parking permit shall be such sums as are specified in the Third Schedule to this Order in respect of such nominated vehicle indicated therein which subject to the provisions of this Order shall be valid for a period of twelve months running from any day of the month on which the parking permit first becomes valid and shall apply from the date indicated in the relevant column therein”

(xii) The words “or displays a valid permit in accordance with Article 25 or paragraph (7) of Article 27 or Article 27e or Article 27l was added to Article 21 immediately following the number “10”

(xiii) The words “or shared use parking place” were inserted in Article 23 and Article 25 and paragraphs (3) and (7) of Article 27 immediately following the words “residents’ only on-street parking place”

(xiv) The words “or limited to two hours as the case may be” were inserted in paragraphs (1) and (3) of Article 23 immediately following the words “without time limit”

(xv) For paragraph (4) of Article 23 there was substituted the following similarly numbered paragraph -

(4) Subject to the provisions contained in paragraph (3) of this Article the number of residents’ visitors parking permits issued in respect of each separate place of abode shall not exceed one hundred and fifty in each calendar year and two hundred and fifty two-hour residents’ visitors’ parking permits in each calendar year

PROVIDED THAT this paragraph shall have effect subject to the proviso that in certain exceptional circumstances the number of residents’ visitor’s parking permits issued in respect of each separate place of abode may exceed one hundred and fifty in each calendar year

and two hundred and fifty two-hour residents' visitors' parking permits with no upper limit on the number of such permits so issued provided that in each case the exceptional circumstances referred to above are met and/or fully complied with"

(xvi) For paragraph (6) of Article 23 there was substituted the following similarly numbered paragraph –

"(6) The fee referred to in paragraph (3) of this Article payable to the Council in respect of -

- (i) a resident's visitor's parking permit shall be £2 for each such parking permit and that the resident's visitor's parking permit shall be valid for a period of one day only
- (ii) a two-hour resident's visitor's parking permit shall be £1 for each such parking permit and that the two-hour resident's visitor's parking permit shall be valid for a period of two hours only"

(xvii) The following paragraph was added to Article 24 immediately following paragraph (f) –

"(g) and in the case of a two-hour resident's visitor's parking permit a space for the insertion of the time of the commencement of waiting by the said vehicle in the parking place"

(xiii) The words "or displays a valid permit in accordance with Article 21 or paragraph (7) of Article 27 or Article 27e or Article 27l was added to Article 25 immediately following the number "10"

(xix) The words "and in the case of a two-hour resident's visitor's parking permit the time of the commencement of waiting by the said vehicle in the parking place" were added to Article 26 immediately following the words "to be used" in the last line

(xx) For the words "permit holders' parking place" in Article 27(a) and 27(e) there were substituted the words "residents' only parking place or shared use parking place"

(xxi) For Article 27(b) including the shoulder heading there was substituted the following similarly numbered Article –

"No Charge in respect of a carer's parking permit

27(b) NO charge shall be payable in respect of a carer's parking permit which subject to the provisions of this Order shall be valid for a period of

twelve months”

(xxii) Article 27(c) was omitted in its entirety

(xxiii) The following Section was added to Part III immediately following Section IVA

“SECTION V – CHILDCARE PARKING PERMITS

Application for and issue of a childcare parking permit

- 27(F) (1) ANY person –
- (a) who is resident or ordinarily resident at any premises the postal address of which is in the roads and lengths of roads specified and described in column 2 of the table forming the First Schedule and
 - (b) who receives regular visits from another person for the purpose of child care pursuant to a contract of employment
- may apply to the Council for the issue of a childcare parking permit for the leaving in any residents’ only parking place or shared use parking place situated within the lengths of roads specified in the column 3 of the table forming the First Schedule and identified on any of the plans during the permitted hours of either a passenger vehicle or goods vehicle or motor cycle and belonging to or being used by a person visiting that resident at those premises to carry out childcare duties and any such application shall be made either electronically or on a form issued by and obtainable from the Council and shall include the particulars and information required to be supplied and the Council may in its absolute discretion issue a childcare parking permit to such resident
- (2) THE Council may at any time require an applicant for a childcare parking permit or a childcare parking permit holder to produce to an officer of that Council such evidence in respect of an application for a childcare parking permit made to them as they may reasonably call for to verify any particulars or information given to them or in respect of any childcare parking permit issued by them to that person as they may reasonably call for to verify that the childcare parking permit is valid
- (3) UPON receipt of an application duly made under the foregoing provisions of this Article and upon being satisfied that the applicant is in need of such visits by a childcare provider who is or are either the

owner of either a passenger vehicle or goods vehicle or a motor cycle or a person authorised to use such a vehicle by the owner thereof the Council may in its absolute discretion issue to the applicant therefor one childcare parking permit for the leaving without time limit during the permitted hours in any residents' only parking place or shared use parking place situated within the lengths of roads specified in column 3 of the table forming the First Schedule and identified on any of the plans of a vehicle belonging to or being used by a person visiting that resident in the course of their duties

PROVIDED THAT the childcare parking permit is only valid in respect of any resident's premises that are situated in the roads or parts of the roads specified and described in Column 2 of the table forming the First Schedule

(4) IN any respect not specifically mentioned in paragraphs (1), (2) and (3) of this Article and Articles 27(G) 27(H) and 27(I) the procedure validity and terms of use of a childcare parking permit shall be the same as the procedure validity and terms of use of a residents' parking permit and this paragraph shall be construed accordingly

Fee to be paid in respect of a childcare parking permit

27(G) The fee payable in respect of a childcare parking permit shall be as for a resident's parking permit as specified in the Third Schedule and the childcare permit shall be taken into account when making the calculation in accordance with the charges specified in the Third Schedule which subject to the provisions of this Order shall be valid for a period of twelve months

Form of childcare parking permit

27(H) A childcare parking permit shall be in writing and shall include the following particulars –

- (i) a serial number identifiable in the office of issue
- (ii) the word "CHILDCARE"
- (iii) the period during which the childcare parking permit shall remain valid
- (iv) an indication that the childcare parking permit has been issued by the Council
- (v) the appropriate letter identifying the roads or lengths of roads in which the permit is valid

Display of childcare parking permit

27(l) AT all times during which a passenger vehicle or a goods vehicle or motor cycle which is being used for the purposes specified in paragraph (1) of Article 27(F) is left in a residents' only parking place or shared use parking place within the lengths of roads specified in column 3 of the table forming the First Schedule and identified on the plans during the permitted hours a valid childcare parking permit shall be displayed on the vehicle in respect of which it is to be used on the front or near-side of the vehicle so that all the particulars on the childcare parking permit are readily visible from the front or near-side of the vehicle

PROVIDED THAT no such parking permit need be so displayed if the vehicle is waiting in that parking place pursuant to the provisions of Article 10 or is a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position or in the prescribed manner a disabled person's badge issued by any local authority"

(xxiv) The Schedule to this Order was added to the Order as the Third Schedule

(2) The Surrey County Council Prospect Place (D3287) Staines Upon Thames in the Borough of Spelthorne (Permit Holders' On-Street Parking Place) (Permit Zone) Order 2014 shall have effect as though -

(i) The following Section was added to Part III in the Arrangement of Articles immediately following Section IVA

"SECTION V – CHILDCARE PARKING PERMITS

Application for and issue of a childcare parking permit..	27(F)
Fee to be paid in respect of a childcare parking permit..	27(G)
Form of childcare parking permit..	27(H)
Display of childcare parking permit..	27(l)"

(ii) The following item was added to the Arrangement of Articles as the third item –

“and any childcare parking permit shall be included in the calculation herein of a resident’s entitlement to a resident’s parking permit as though it was a resident’s parking permit”

(ix) For paragraph (7) of Article 16 there was substituted the following similarly numbered paragraph -

“(7) The fee payable to the Council in respect of each resident’s parking permit shall be such sums as are specified in the Third Schedule to this Order in respect of such nominated vehicle indicated therein which subject to the provisions of this Order shall be valid for a period of twelve months running from any day of the month on which the parking permit first becomes valid and shall apply from the date indicated in the relevant column therein”

(x) The phrase “or Article 27(e) or Article 27(l)” was inserted in Article 21 and Article 25 immediately following the number “27”

(xi) The words “or limited to two hours as the case may be” was inserted in paragraphs (1) and (3) of Article 23 immediately following the words “without time limit”

(xii) For paragraph (4) of Article 23 there was substituted the following similarly

numbered paragraph -

(4) Subject to the provisions contained in paragraph (3) of this Article the number of residents' visitors parking permits issued in respect of each separate place of abode shall not exceed one hundred and fifty in each calendar year and two hundred and fifty two-hour residents' visitors' parking permits in each calendar year

PROVIDED THAT this paragraph shall have effect subject to the proviso that in certain exceptional circumstances the number of residents' visitor's parking permits issued in respect of each separate place of abode may exceed one hundred and fifty in each calendar year and two hundred and fifty two-hour residents' visitors' parking permits with no upper limit on the number of such permits so issued provided that in each case the exceptional circumstances referred to above are met and/or fully complied with"

(xiii) For paragraph (6) of Article 23 there was substituted the following similarly numbered paragraph –

"(6) The fee referred to in paragraph (3) of this Article payable to the Council in respect of -

- (i) a resident's visitor's parking permit shall be £2 for each such parking permit and that the resident's visitor's parking permit shall be valid for a period of one day only
- (ii) a two-hour resident's visitor's parking permit shall be £1 for each such parking permit and that the two-hour resident's visitor's parking permit shall be valid for a period of two hours only"

(xvi) The phrase "or Article 27(e) or Article 27(l)" was inserted in paragraph (7) of Article 27 immediately following the number "25"

(xvii) For Article 27(b) including the shoulder heading there was substituted the following similarly numbered Article –

“No Charge in respect of a carer’s parking permit

27(b) NO charge shall be payable in respect of a carer’s parking permit which subject to the provisions of this Order shall be valid for a period of twelve months”

(xviii) Article 27(c) was omitted in its entirety

(xix) The following Section was added to Part III immediately following Section IVA

“SECTION V – CHILDCARE PARKING PERMITS

Application for and issue of a childcare parking permit

27(F) (1) ANY person –

(a) who is resident or ordinarily resident at any premises the postal address of which is in the roads and lengths of roads specified and described in the Second Part of the First Schedule and

(b) who receives regular visits from another person for the purpose of child care pursuant to a contract of employment may apply to the Council for the issue of a childcare parking permit for the leaving in the permit holders’ parking place situated within the length of road specified in the First Part of the First Schedule and identified on any of the plans during the permitted hours of either a passenger vehicle or goods vehicle or motor cycle and belonging to or being used by a person visiting that resident at those premises to carry out childcare duties and any such application shall be made either electronically or on a form issued by and obtainable from the Council and shall include the particulars and information required to be supplied and the Council may in its absolute discretion issue a childcare parking permit to such resident

(2) THE Council may at any time require an applicant for a childcare parking permit or a childcare parking permit holder to produce to an officer of that Council such evidence in respect of an application for a childcare parking permit made to them as they may reasonably call for to verify any particulars or information given to them or in respect of any childcare parking permit issued by them to that person as they may reasonably call for to verify that the childcare parking permit is

valid

- (3) UPON receipt of an application duly made under the foregoing provisions of this Article and upon being satisfied that the applicant is in need of such visits by a childcare provider who is or are either the owner of either a passenger vehicle or goods vehicle or a motor cycle or a person authorised to use such a vehicle by the owner thereof the Council may in its absolute discretion issue to the applicant therefor one childcare parking permit for the leaving without time limit during the permitted hours in the permit holders' parking place situated within the length of road specified in column 3 of the First Part of the First Schedule and identified on any of the plans of a vehicle belonging to or being used by a person visiting that resident in the course of their duties

PROVIDED THAT the childcare parking permit is only valid in respect of any resident's premises that are situated in the road or part of the road specified and described in the First Part of the First Schedule

- (4) IN any respect not specifically mentioned in paragraphs (1), (2) and (3) of this Article and Articles 27(G) 27(H) and 27(I) the procedure validity and terms of use of a childcare parking permit shall be the same as the procedure validity and terms of use of a residents' parking permit and this paragraph shall be construed accordingly

Fee to be paid in respect of a childcare parking permit

27(G) The fee payable in respect of a childcare parking permit shall be as for a resident's parking permit as specified in the Third Schedule and the childcare permit shall be taken into account when making the calculation in accordance with the charges specified in the Third Schedule which subject to the provisions of this Order shall be valid for a period of twelve months

Form of childcare parking permit

27(H) A childcare parking permit shall be in writing and shall include the following particulars –

- (i) a serial number identifiable in the office of issue
- (ii) the word "CHILDCARE"
- (iii) the period during which the childcare parking permit shall remain valid

- (iv) an indication that the childcare parking permit has been issued by the Council
- (v) the appropriate letter identifying the roads or lengths of roads in which the permit is valid

Display of childcare parking permit

27(l) AT all times during which a passenger vehicle or a goods vehicle which is being used for the purposes specified in paragraph (1) of Article 27(F) is left in the permit holders' parking place within the length of road specified in the First Part of the First Schedule and identified on the plans during the permitted hours a valid childcare parking permit shall be displayed on the vehicle in respect of which it is to be used on the front or near-side of the vehicle so that all the particulars on the childcare parking permit are readily visible from the front or near-side of the vehicle

PROVIDED THAT no such parking permit need be so displayed if the vehicle is waiting in that parking place pursuant to the provisions of Article 10 or is a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position or in the prescribed manner a disabled person's badge issued by any local authority"

(xx) The Schedule to this Order was added to the Order as the Third Schedule

(3) The Surrey County Council Lammas Close (D6347) Staines in the Borough of Spelthorne (Restricted Zone) (On-Street Parking Place) Order 2010 shall have effect as though –

SECTION V

CARERS’ PARKING PERMITS

Application for and issue of a Carer’s Parking Permit

30(A) (1) ANY person –

- (a) who is resident or ordinarily resident at any premises the postal address of which is in the road and length of road specified and described in Part II of the First Schedule and
- (b) is housebound and
- (c) in need of regular short term visits from carers

may apply to the Council for the issue of a Carer’s Parking Permit for the leaving in any residents’ only parking place situated within the length of road specified in Part II of the First Schedule and identified on plan during the permitted hours of either a passenger vehicle or goods vehicle and belonging to or being used by a person visiting that

resident at those premises to carry out carer's duties and any such application shall be made either electronically or on a form issued by and obtainable from the Council and shall include the particulars and information required to be supplied and the Council may in its absolute discretion issue a carer's Parking Permit to such resident

- (2) THE Council may at any time require an applicant for a Carer's Parking Permit or a Carer's Parking Permit holder to produce to an Officer of that Council such evidence in respect of an application for a Carer's Parking Permit made to them as they may reasonably call for to verify any particulars or information given to them or in respect of any Carer's Parking Permit issued by them to that person as they may reasonably call for to verify that the Carer's Parking Permit is valid
- (3) UPON receipt of an application duly made under the foregoing provisions of this Article and upon being satisfied that the applicant is housebound and in need of such short term visits by carers and that the carer is either the owner of either a passenger vehicle or goods vehicle or a person authorised to use such a vehicle by the owner thereof the Council may in its absolute discretion issue to the applicant therefor one Carer's Parking Permit for the leaving without time limit and free of charge during the permitted hours in any residents' only parking place situated within the length of road specified in Part I of the First Schedule and identified on the plan of a vehicle belonging to or being used by a person visiting that resident as a carer in the course of their duties

PROVIDED THAT the Carer's Parking Permit is only valid in respect of any resident's premises that are situated in the roads or parts of the roads specified and described in Part II of the First Schedule as applicable

- (4) IN any respect not specifically mentioned in paragraphs (1), (2) and (3) of this Article and Articles 30(B) and 30(C) and 30(D) the procedure validity and terms of use of a Carer's Parking Permit shall be the same as the procedure validity and terms of use of a Residents' Parking Permit and this paragraph shall be construed accordingly

No Charge in respect of a carer's parking permit

30(B) NO charge shall be payable in respect of a carer's parking permit which subject to the provisions of this Order shall be valid for a period of twelve

months”

Form of Carer’s Parking Permit

30(C) A Carer’s Parking Permit shall be in writing and shall include the following particulars –

- (i) a serial number identifiable in the office of issue
- (ii) the words “CARER”
- (iii) the period during which the Carer’s Parking Permit shall remain valid
- (i) an indication that the Carer’s Parking Permit has been issued by the Council
- (ii) the appropriate letter or number identifying the roads or lengths of roads in which the permit is valid

Display of Carer’s Parking Permit

30(D) AT all times during which a passenger vehicle or a goods vehicle which is being used for the purposes specified in paragraph (1) of Article 30(A) is left in a residents’ only parking place within the length of road specified in Part I of the First Schedule and identified on the plan during the permitted hours a valid Carer’s Parking Permit shall be displayed on the vehicle in respect of which it is to be used on the front or near-side of the vehicle so that all the particulars on the Carer’s Parking Permit are readily visible from the front or near-side of the vehicle

PROVIDED THAT no such parking permit need be so displayed if the vehicle is waiting in that parking place pursuant to the provisions of Article 15 or is displaying in the manner specified in Article 26 or Article 30 or paragraph (7) of Article 32 or Article 30(H) a valid parking permit issued in respect of that vehicle or is a disabled person’s vehicle which displays in the relevant position or in the prescribed manner a disabled person’s badge issued by any local authority

SECTION IV(B) – CHILDCARE PARKING PERMITS

Application for and issue of a childcare parking permit

- 30(E) (1) ANY person –
- (a) who is resident or ordinarily resident at any premises the postal address of which is in the roads and lengths of roads specified and described in the Second Part of the First Schedule and

(b) who receives regular visits from another person for the purpose of child care pursuant to a contract of employment may apply to the Council for the issue of a childcare parking permit for the leaving in the residents' parking place situated within the length of road specified in the First Part of the First Schedule and identified on any of the plans during the permitted hours of either a passenger vehicle or goods vehicle or motor cycle and belonging to or being used by a person visiting that resident at those premises to carry out childcare duties and any such application shall be made either electronically or on a form issued by and obtainable from the Council and shall include the particulars and information required to be supplied and the Council may in its absolute discretion issue a childcare parking permit to such resident

(2) THE Council may at any time require an applicant for a childcare parking permit or a childcare parking permit holder to produce to an officer of that Council such evidence in respect of an application for a childcare parking permit made to them as they may reasonably call for to verify any particulars or information given to them or in respect of any childcare parking permit issued by them to that person as they may reasonably call for to verify that the childcare parking permit is valid

(3) UPON receipt of an application duly made under the foregoing provisions of this Article and upon being satisfied that the applicant is in need of such visits by a childcare provider who is or are either the owner of either a passenger vehicle or goods vehicle or a motor cycle or a person authorised to use such a vehicle by the owner thereof the Council may in its absolute discretion issue to the applicant therefor one childcare parking permit for the leaving without time limit during the permitted hours in the residents' parking place situated within the length of road specified in the First Part of the First Schedule and identified on plan of a vehicle belonging to or being used by a person visiting that resident in the course of their duties

PROVIDED THAT the childcare parking permit is only valid in respect of any resident's premises that are situated in the road or part of the road specified and described in the First Part of the First Schedule

(4) IN any respect not specifically mentioned in paragraphs (1), (2) and (3) of this Article and Articles 30(F) 30(G) and 30(H) the procedure

validity and terms of use of a childcare parking permit shall be the same as the procedure validity and terms of use of a residents' parking permit and this paragraph shall be construed accordingly

Fee to be paid in respect of a childcare parking permit

30(F) The fee payable in respect of a childcare parking permit shall be as for a resident's parking permit as specified in the Second Schedule and the childcare permit shall be taken into account when making the calculation in accordance with the charges specified in the Second Schedule which subject to the provisions of this Order shall be valid for a period of twelve months

Form of childcare parking permit

30(G) A childcare parking permit shall be in writing and shall include the following particulars –

- (i) a serial number identifiable in the office of issue
- (ii) the word "CHILDCARE"
- (iii) the period during which the childcare parking permit shall remain valid
- (iv) an indication that the childcare parking permit has been issued by the Council
- (v) the appropriate letter identifying the roads or lengths of roads in which the permit is valid

Display of childcare parking permit

30(H) AT all times during which a passenger vehicle or a goods vehicle which is being used for the purposes specified in paragraph (1) of Article 30(E) is left in the residents' parking place within the length of road specified in the First Part of the First Schedule and identified on the plan during the permitted hours a valid childcare parking permit shall be displayed on the vehicle in respect of which it is to be used on the front or near-side of the vehicle so that all the particulars on the childcare parking permit are readily visible from the front or near-side of the vehicle

PROVIDED THAT no such parking permit need be so displayed if the vehicle is waiting in that parking place pursuant to the provisions of Article 10 or is displaying in the manner specified in Article 26 or Article 30 or paragraph (7) of Article 32 or Article 30(D) a valid parking permit issued in respect of that vehicle or is a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant

position or in the prescribed manner a disabled person's badge issued by any local authority"
