(AMENDMENT TO PARKING PERMITS)
ORDER 2022

SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1) 2(1) to (3) 4(2) 32 35 36 45 46 47 48 49 51 52 and 53 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

Citation and commencement

1. THIS Order may be cited as "The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in the Borough of Woking) (Amendment to Parking Permits) Order 2022" and shall come into operation on 1 November 2022_____

Interpretation

2. (1) In this Order the expression -

"enactment" means any enactment whether public general or local and includes any order bylaw rule regulation scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment_____

"Principal Order" means each of the relevant Orders specified in Article 3(1) and Article 3(2) and Article 3(3) and Article 3(4) as the case may be_____

(2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended applied consolidated re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment_____

(3) Unless the context otherwise requires any expression used in this Order which is also used in the amended Order shall have the same meaning as in that Order_____

Amendment of the Principal Orders

3. WITHOUT prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order

(1) The Surrey County Council Woking Controlled Parking Zone (Revocation and Consolidation of Waiting Restrictions and On-Street Parking Places) Order 2019 shall have effect as though

(i) The following Section was added to Part X in the Arrangement of Articles immediately following Section V

“SECTION VI – CHILDCARE PARKING PERMITS

Application for and issue of a childcare parking permit..	79A
Fee to be paid in respect of a childcare parking permit..	79B
Form of childcare parking permit..	79C
Display of childcare parking permit..	79D”

(ii) The following item was added to the Arrangement of Schedules as the fifth item –

“FIFTH SCHEDULE Cost of Residents Permits”

(iii) The following expressions and meanings were added to paragraph (1) of Article 2 in alphabetical sequence -

“childcare parking permit” means a childcare parking permit issued by the Council under the provisions of Article 79A

“childcare parking permit holder” means a person to whom a childcare parking permit has been issued

“two-hour resident’s visitor’s parking permit” means a resident’s visitor’s parking permit that is limited to a validity of two hours”

(iv) The words “or a virtual childcare parking permit” were added to the interpretation of the expression “virtual parking transaction” immediately following the words “operational parking permit”

(v) The words “or as the case may be a childcare parking permit” were added to the interpretation of “parking permit” immediately following the words “business parking permit”

(vi) In the meaning of the expression “residents’ parking place” in paragraph (1) of Article 2 there was added the phrase “or in the manner specified in Article 79D” immediately after the number “78”

(vii) The words “and shall include a two-hour resident’s visitor’s parking permit where applicable” was added to the interpretation of the expression “resident’s visitor’s parking permit” in paragraph (1) of Article 2 immediately following the number “64”

(viii) The words “or a childcare parking permit” was added to the meaning of the expression “valid parking permit” in paragraph (1) of Article 2 immediately following the words “business parking permit”

(ix) The phrase “or in the manner specified in Article 79D” was inserted in Article 14 and Article 32 and Article 33 and Article 34 and Article 37 and Article 39 and Article 40 and Article 43 and Article 44 and Article 45 and Article 62 and Article 66 and paragraph (7) of Article 68 and Article 73 immediately following the number “78”

(x) For paragraph (7) of Article 57 there was substituted the following similarly numbered paragraph-

“(7) The fee referred to in paragraph (2) of this Article payable to the Council shall be such sums as are specified in the Fifth Schedule to this Order in respect of such nominated vehicle indicated therein which subject to the provisions of this Order shall be valid for a period of twelve months running from any day of the month on which the parking permit first becomes valid and such fee shall apply from the date indicated in the relevant column therein”

(xi) The following paragraph was inserted in Article 57 immediately following paragraph (8) –

“(9) Any childcare parking permit shall be included in the calculation herein of a resident’s entitlement to a resident’s parking permit as though it was a resident’s parking permit”

(xii) The words “or limited to two hours as the case may be” was inserted in paragraphs (1) and (3) of Article 64 immediately following the words “without time limit”

(xiii) For paragraph (4) of Article 64 there was substituted the following similarly numbered paragraph -

(4) Subject to the provisions contained in paragraph (3) of this Article the number of residents’ visitors parking permits issued in respect of each separate place of abode shall not exceed one hundred and fifty in each calendar year and two hundred and fifty two-hour residents’ visitors’ parking permits in each calendar year

PROVIDED THAT this paragraph shall have effect subject to the proviso that in certain exceptional circumstances the number of residents’ visitor’s parking permits issued in respect of each separate place of abode may exceed one hundred and fifty in each calendar year and two hundred and fifty two-hour residents’ visitors’ parking permits with no upper limit on the number of such permits so issued provided that in each case the exceptional circumstances referred to above are met and/or fully complied with”

(xiv) For paragraph (6) of Article 64 there was substituted the following similarly numbered paragraph –

“(6) The fee referred to in paragraph (3) of this Article payable to the Council in respect of -

- (i) a resident’s visitor’s parking permit shall be £2 for each such parking permit and that the resident’s visitor’s parking permit shall be valid for a period of one day only
- (ii) a two-hour resident’s visitor’s parking permit shall be £1 for each such parking permit and that the two-hour resident’s visitor’s parking permit shall be valid for

a period of two hours only”

(xv) The following paragraph was added to Article 65 immediately following paragraph (f) –

“(g) and in the case of a two-hour resident’s visitor’s parking permit a space for the insertion of the time of the commencement of waiting by the said vehicle in the parking place”

(xvi) The words “and in the case of a two-hour resident’s visitor’s parking permit the time of the commencement of waiting by the said vehicle in the parking place” were added to Article 67 immediately following the words “to be used” in the last line

(xvii) For Article 70 including the shoulder heading there was substituted the following similarly numbered Article –

“No Charge in respect of a carer’s parking permit

70 NO charge shall be payable in respect of a carer’s parking permit which subject to the provisions of this Order shall be valid for a period of twelve months

(xviii) Article 71 was omitted in its entirety

(xix) The phrase “or in the manner specified in Article 79D” was inserted in Article 78 immediately following the number “73”

(xx) The following Section was added to Part X immediately following Section V

“SECTION VI – CHILDCARE PARKING PERMITS

Application for and issue of a childcare parking permit

79A (1) ANY person –

- (a) who is resident or ordinarily resident at any premises the postal address of which is in the roads and lengths of roads specified and described in column 2 of the table forming the First Schedule and
- (b) who receives regular visits from another person for the purpose of childcare pursuant to a contract of employment

may apply to the Council for the issue of a childcare parking permit for the leaving in any residents’ only parking place or shared use parking place or a dual use parking place situated within the lengths of roads specified in the column 3 of the table forming the First Schedule and identified on any of the plans during the permitted hours of either a passenger vehicle or goods vehicle or motor cycle and belonging to or being used by a person visiting that resident at those premises to carry out childcare duties and any such application shall be made either electronically or on a form issued by and obtainable from the Council and shall include the particulars and information required to be

supplied and the Council may in its absolute discretion issue a childcare parking permit to such resident

(2) THE Council may at any time require an applicant for a childcare parking permit or a childcare parking permit holder to produce to an officer of that Council such evidence in respect of an application for a childcare parking permit made to them as they may reasonably call for to verify any particulars or information given to them or in respect of any childcare parking permit issued by them to that person as they may reasonably call for to verify that the childcare parking permit is valid

(3) UPON receipt of an application duly made under the foregoing provisions of this Article and upon being satisfied that the applicant is in need of such visits by a childcare provider who is or are either the owner of either a passenger vehicle or goods vehicle or a motor cycle or a person authorised to use such a vehicle by the owner thereof the Council may in its absolute discretion issue to the applicant therefor one childcare parking permit for the leaving without time limit during the permitted hours in any residents' only parking place or shared use parking place or dual use parking place situated within the lengths of roads specified in column 3 of the table forming the First Schedule and identified on any of the plans of a vehicle belonging to or being used by a person visiting that resident in the course of their duties

PROVIDED THAT the childcare parking permit is only valid in respect of any resident's premises that are situated in the roads or parts of the roads specified and described in Column 2 of the table forming the First Schedule

(4) IN any respect not specifically mentioned in paragraphs (1), (2) and (3) of this Article and Articles 79B 79C and 79D the procedure validity and terms of use of a childcare parking permit shall be the same as the procedure validity and terms of use of a residents' parking permit and this paragraph shall be construed accordingly

Fee to be paid in respect of a childcare parking permit

79B The fee payable in respect of a childcare parking permit shall be as for a resident's parking permit as specified in the Fifth Schedule and the childcare permit shall be taken into account when making the calculation in accordance with the charges specified in the Fifth Schedule which subject to the provisions of this Order shall be valid for a period of twelve months

Form of childcare parking permit

79C A childcare parking permit shall either –

- (a) be in writing and shall include the following particulars –
 - (i) a serial number identifiable in the office of issue
 - (ii) the word “CHILDCARE”
 - (iii) the period during which the carer’s parking permit shall remain valid
 - (iv) an indication that the carer’s parking permit has been issued by the Council
 - (v) the appropriate letter or number identifying the roads or lengths of roads in which the permit is valid or
- (b) Be a virtual childcare parking permit

Display of childcare parking permit

79D AT all times during which a passenger vehicle or a goods vehicle or a motor cycle which is being used for the purposes specified in paragraph (1) of Article 79A is left in a residents’ only parking place or shared use parking place or a dual use parking place within the lengths of roads specified in column 3 of the table forming the First Schedule and identified on the plans during the permitted hours a valid childcare parking permit shall be displayed on the vehicle in respect of which it is to be used on the front or near-side of the vehicle so that all the particulars on the childcare parking permit are readily visible from the front or near-side of the vehicle

PROVIDED THAT a vehicle is validated by the hand held device as having a valid Virtual childcare parking permit no permit needs be displayed on that vehicle
 AND PROVIDED THAT no such parking permit need be so displayed if the vehicle is waiting in that parking place pursuant to the provisions of Article 51 or is displaying in the manner specified in Article 62 or Article 66 or paragraph (7) of Article 68 or Article 73 or Article 78 (if applicable) a valid parking permit issued in respect of that vehicle or is a disabled person’s vehicle which displays in the relevant position or in the prescribed manner a disabled person’s badge issued by any local authority”

(xxi) The Schedule to this Order was added to the Principal Order as the Fifth Schedule

(2) The Surrey County Council Brookwood Controlled Parking Zone in the Borough of Woking (Revocation and Consolidation of Waiting Restrictions and On-Street Parking Places) Order 2019 shall have effect as though –

(i) The following Section was added to Part VI in the Arrangement of Articles immediately following Section IV

“SECTION V – CHILDCARE PARKING PERMITS

Application for and issue of a childcare parking permit..	42A
Fee to be paid in respect of a childcare parking permit..	42B

Form of childcare parking permit..	42C
Display of childcare parking permit..	42D”

(ii) The following item was added to the Arrangement of Schedules as the fourth item –

“FOURTH SCHEDULE Cost of Residents Permits”

(iii) The following expressions and meanings were added to paragraph (1) of Article 2 in alphabetical sequence -

““childcare parking permit” means a childcare parking permit issued by the Council under the provisions of Article 42A

“childcare parking permit holder” means a person to whom a childcare parking permit has been issued

“two-hour resident’s visitor’s parking permit” means a resident’s visitor’s parking permit that is limited to a validity of two hours”

(iv) In the interpretation of the expression “residents’ parking place” in paragraph (1) of Article 2 there was added the phrase “or Article 42D” immediately after the number “42”

(v) The words “and shall include a two-hour resident’s visitor’s parking permit where applicable” was added to the interpretation of the expression “resident’s visitor’s parking permit” in paragraph (1) of Article 2 immediately following the number “33”

(vi) The words “or a childcare parking permit” was added to the interpretation of the expression “valid permit” in paragraph (1) of Article 2 immediately following the words “carer’s parking permit”

(vii) The words “or a virtual childcare parking permit” were added to the interpretation of the expression “virtual parking transaction” immediately following the words “operational parking permit”

(viii) The phrase “or in the manner specified in Article 42D” was inserted in Article 14 immediately following the number “42”

(ix) For paragraph (7) of Article 26 there was substituted the following similarly numbered paragraph-

“(7) The fee referred to in paragraph (2) of this Article payable to the Council shall be such sums as are specified in the Fourth Schedule to this Order in respect of such nominated vehicle indicated therein which subject to the provisions of this Order shall be valid for a period of twelve months running from any day of the month on which the parking permit first becomes valid and shall apply from the date indicated in the relevant column therein

(x) The following paragraph was inserted in Article 26 immediately following paragraph (8) –

“(9) Any childcare parking permit shall be included in the calculation herein of a resident’s entitlement to a resident’s parking permit as though it was a resident’s parking permit”

(xi) The phrase “or Article 42D” was inserted in Article 31 and Article 35 and paragraph (7) of Article 37 immediately following the number “42”

(xii) The words “or limited to two hours as the case may be” was inserted in paragraphs (1) and (3) of Article 33 immediately following the words “without time limit”

(xiii) For paragraph (4) of Article 33 there was substituted the following similarly numbered paragraph -

(4) Subject to the provisions contained in paragraph (3) of this Article the number of residents’ visitors parking permits issued in respect of each separate place of abode shall not exceed one hundred and fifty in each calendar year and two hundred and fifty two-hour residents’ visitors’ parking permits in each calendar year

PROVIDED THAT this paragraph shall have effect subject to the proviso that in certain exceptional circumstances the number of residents’ visitor’s parking permits issued in respect of each separate place of abode may exceed one hundred and fifty in each calendar year and two hundred and fifty two-hour residents’ visitors’ parking permits with no upper limit on the number of such permits so issued provided that in each case the exceptional circumstances referred to above are met and/or fully complied with”

(xiv) For paragraph (6) of Article 33 there was substituted the following similarly numbered paragraph –

“(6) The fee referred to in paragraph (3) of this Article payable to the Council in respect of -

- (i) a resident’s visitor’s parking permit shall be £2 for each such parking permit and that the resident’s visitor’s parking permit shall be valid for a period of one day only
- (ii) a two-hour resident’s visitor’s parking permit shall be £1 for each such parking permit and that the two-hour resident’s visitor’s parking permit shall be valid for a period of two hours only”

(xv) The following paragraph was added to Article 34 immediately following paragraph (f) –

“(g) and in the case of a two-hour resident’s visitor’s parking permit a space for the insertion of the time of the commencement of waiting by the said vehicle in the parking place”

(xvi) The words “and in the case of a two-hour resident’s visitor’s parking permit the time of the commencement of waiting by the said vehicle in the parking place” were added to Article 36 immediately following the words “to be used” in the last line

(xvii) For Article 39 including the shoulder heading there was substituted the following similarly numbered Article –

“No Charge in respect of a carer’s parking permit

39 NO charge shall be payable in respect of a carer’s parking permit which subject to the provisions of this Order shall be valid for a period of twelve months”

(xviii) Article 40 was omitted in its entirety

(xix) The following paragraph was added to Article 42 -

“PROVIDED THAT no such parking permit need be so displayed if the vehicle is waiting in that parking place pursuant to the provisions of Article 20 or is displaying in the manner specified in Article 31 or Article 35 or paragraph (7) of Article 37 or Article 42D a valid parking permit issued in respect of that vehicle or is a disabled person’s vehicle which displays in the relevant position or in the prescribed manner a disabled person’s badge issued by any local authority”

(xx) The following Section was added to Part VI immediately following Section IV

“SECTION V – CHILDCARE PARKING PERMITS

Application for and issue of a childcare parking permit

42A (1) ANY person –

- (a) who is resident or ordinarily resident at any premises the postal address of which is in the roads and lengths of roads specified and described in column 2 of the table forming the First Schedule and
- (b) who receives regular visits from another person for the purpose of childcare pursuant to a contract of employment

may apply to the Council for the issue of a childcare parking permit for the leaving in any residents’ only parking place situated within the lengths of roads specified in the column 3 of the table forming the First Schedule and identified on any of the plans during the permitted hours of either a passenger vehicle or goods vehicle or motor cycle and belonging to or being used by a person visiting that resident at those premises to carry out childcare duties and any such application shall be made either electronically or on a form issued by and obtainable from the Council and shall include the particulars and information

required to be supplied and the Council may in its absolute discretion issue a childcare parking permit to such resident

(2) THE Council may at any time require an applicant for a childcare parking permit or a childcare parking permit holder to produce to an officer of that Council such evidence in respect of an application for a childcare parking permit made to them as they may reasonably call for to verify any particulars or information given to them or in respect of any childcare parking permit issued by them to that person as they may reasonably call for to verify that the childcare parking permit is valid

(3) UPON receipt of an application duly made under the foregoing provisions of this Article and upon being satisfied that the applicant is in need of such visits by a childcare provider who is or are either the owner of either a passenger vehicle or goods vehicle or a motor cycle or a person authorised to use such a vehicle by the owner thereof the Council may in its absolute discretion issue to the applicant therefor one childcare parking permit for the leaving without time limit during the permitted hours in any residents' only parking place situated within the lengths of roads specified in column 3 of the table forming the First Schedule and identified on any of the plans of a vehicle belonging to or being used by a person visiting that resident in the course of their duties

PROVIDED THAT the childcare parking permit is only valid in respect of any resident's premises that are situated in the roads or parts of the roads specified and described in Column 2 of the table forming the First Schedule

(4) IN any respect not specifically mentioned in paragraphs (1), (2) and (3) of this Article and Articles 42B 42C and 42D the procedure validity and terms of use of a childcare parking permit shall be the same as the procedure validity and terms of use of a residents' parking permit and this paragraph shall be construed accordingly

Fee to be paid in respect of a childcare parking permit

42B The fee payable in respect of a childcare parking permit shall be as for a resident's parking permit as specified in the Fourth Schedule and the childcare permit shall be taken into account when making the calculation in accordance with the charges specified in the Fourth Schedule which subject to the provisions of this Order shall be valid for a period of twelve months

Form of childcare parking permit

43C A childcare parking permit shall either –

- (a) be in writing and shall include the following particulars –
- (i) a serial number identifiable in the office of issue
 - (ii) the word “CHILDCARE”
 - (iii) the period during which the carer’s parking permit shall remain valid
 - (iv) an indication that the carer’s parking permit has been issued by the Council
 - (v) the appropriate letter identifying the roads or lengths of roads in which the permit is valid or
- (b) Be a virtual childcare parking permit

Display of childcare parking permit

42D AT all times during which a passenger vehicle or a goods vehicle or a motor cycle which is being used for the purposes specified in paragraph (1) of Article 42A is left in a residents’ only parking place within the lengths of roads specified in column 3 of the table forming the First Schedule and identified on the plans during the permitted hours a valid childcare parking permit shall be displayed on the vehicle in respect of which it is to be used on the front or near-side of the vehicle so that all the particulars on the childcare parking permit are readily visible from the front or near-side of the vehicle

PROVIDED THAT a vehicle is validated by the hand held device as having a valid Virtual childcare parking permit no permit needs be displayed on that vehicle

PROVIDED THAT no such parking permit need be so displayed if the vehicle is waiting in that parking place pursuant to the provisions of Article 20 or is displaying in the manner specified in Article 31 or Article 35 or paragraph (7) of Article 37 or Article 41 a valid parking permit issued in respect of that vehicle or is a disabled person’s vehicle which displays in the relevant position or in the prescribed manner a disabled person’s badge issued by any local authority”

(xxi) The Schedule to this Order was added to the Principal Order as the Fourth Schedule

(3) The Surrey County Council West Byfleet Controlled Parking Zone in the Borough of Woking (Revocation and Consolidation of Waiting Restrictions and On-Street Parking Places) Order 2019 shall have effect as though –

(i) The following Section was added to Part IX in the Arrangement of Articles immediately following Section IV

“SECTION V – CHILDCARE PARKING PERMITS

Application for and issue of a childcare parking permit..	65A
Fee to be paid in respect of a childcare parking permit..	65B

Form of childcare parking permit..	65C
Display of childcare parking permit..	65D”

(ii) The following item was added to the Arrangement of Schedules as the fifth item –

“FIFTH SCHEDULE Cost of Residents Permits”

(iii) The following expressions and meanings were added to paragraph (1) of Article 2 in alphabetical sequence -

““childcare parking permit” means a childcare parking permit issued by the Council under the provisions of Article 65A

“childcare parking permit holder” means a person to whom a childcare parking permit has been issued

“two-hour resident’s visitor’s parking permit” means a resident’s visitor’s parking permit that is limited to a validity of two hours”

(iv) In the interpretation of the expression “residents’ parking place” in paragraph (1) of Article 2 there was added the phrase “or Article 65D” immediately after the number “65”

(viii) The phrase “or in the manner specified in Article 65D” was inserted in Article 14 and Article 30 immediately following the number “65”

(ix) The phrase “or Article 65D” was inserted in Article 31 and Article 32 and Article 33 and Article 35 and Article 36 and Article 54 and Article 58 and paragraph (7) of Article 60 immediately following the number “65”

(x) For paragraph (7) of Article 49 there was substituted the following similarly numbered paragraph-

“(7) The fee referred to in paragraph (2) of this Article payable to the Council shall be such sums as are specified in the Fifth Schedule to this Order in respect of such nominated vehicle

indicated therein which subject to the provisions of this Order shall be valid for a period of twelve months running from any day of the month on which the parking permit first becomes valid and shall apply from the date indicated in the relevant column therein

(xi) The following paragraph was inserted in Article 49 immediately following paragraph (8) –

“(9) Any childcare parking permit shall be included in the calculation herein of a resident’s entitlement to a resident’s parking permit as though it was a resident’s parking permit”

(xii) The words “or limited to two hours as the case may be” was inserted in paragraphs (1) and (3) of Article 56 immediately following the words “without time limit”

(xiii) For paragraph (4) of Article 56 there was substituted the following similarly numbered paragraph -

(4) Subject to the provisions contained in paragraph (3) of this Article the number of residents’ visitors parking permits issued in respect of each separate place of abode shall not exceed one hundred and fifty in each calendar year and two hundred and fifty two-hour residents’ visitors’ parking permits in each calendar year

PROVIDED THAT this paragraph shall have effect subject to the proviso that in certain exceptional circumstances the number of residents’ visitor’s parking permits issued in respect of each separate place of abode may exceed one hundred and fifty in each calendar year and two hundred and fifty two-hour residents’ visitors’ parking permits with no upper limit on the number of such permits so issued provided that in each case the exceptional circumstances referred to above are met and/or fully complied with”

(xiv) For paragraph (6) of Article 56 there was substituted the following similarly numbered paragraph –

“(6) The fee referred to in paragraph (3) of this Article payable to the Council in respect of -

- (i) a resident’s visitor’s parking permit shall be £2 for each such parking permit and that the resident’s visitor’s parking permit shall be valid for a period of one day only
- (ii) a two-hour resident’s visitor’s parking permit shall be £1 for each such parking permit and that the two-hour resident’s visitor’s parking permit shall be valid for a period of two hours only”

(xv) The following paragraph was added to Article 57 immediately following paragraph (f) –

“(g) and in the case of a two-hour resident’s visitor’s parking permit a space for the insertion of the time of the commencement of waiting by the said vehicle in the parking place”

(xvi) The words “and in the case of a two-hour resident’s visitor’s parking permit the time of the commencement of waiting by the said vehicle in the parking place” were added to Article 59 immediately following the words “to be used” in the last line

(xvii) For Article 62 including the shoulder heading there was substituted the following similarly numbered Article –

“No Charge in respect of a carer’s parking permit

62 NO charge shall be payable in respect of a carer’s parking permit which subject to the provisions of this Order shall be valid for a period of twelve months”

(xviii) Article 63 was omitted in its entirety

(xix) The following paragraph was added to Article 65 -

“PROVIDED THAT no such parking permit need be so displayed if the vehicle is waiting in that parking place pursuant to the provisions of Article 43 or is displaying in the manner specified in Article 54 or Article 58 or paragraph (7) of Article 60 or Article 65D a valid parking permit issued in respect of that vehicle or is a disabled person’s vehicle which displays in the relevant position or in the prescribed manner a disabled person’s badge issued by any local authority”

(xx) The following Section was added to Part IX immediately following Section IV

“SECTION V – CHILDCARE PARKING PERMITS

Application for and issue of a childcare parking permit

65A (1) ANY person –

- (a) who is resident or ordinarily resident at any premises the postal address of which is in the roads and lengths of roads specified and described in column 2 of the table forming the First Schedule and
- (b) who receives regular visits from another person for the purpose of childcare pursuant to a contract of employment

may apply to the Council for the issue of a childcare parking permit for the leaving in any residents’ only parking place or dual use parking place situated within the lengths of roads specified in the column 3 of the table forming the First Schedule and identified on any of the plans during the permitted hours of either a passenger vehicle or goods vehicle or motor cycle and belonging to or being used by a person visiting that resident at those premises to carry out

childcare duties and any such application shall be made either electronically or on a form issued by and obtainable from the Council and shall include the particulars and information required to be supplied and the Council may in its absolute discretion issue a childcare parking permit to such resident

(2) THE Council may at any time require an applicant for a childcare parking permit or a childcare parking permit holder to produce to an officer of that Council such evidence in respect of an application for a childcare parking permit made to them as they may reasonably call for to verify any particulars or information given to them or in respect of any childcare parking permit issued by them to that person as they may reasonably call for to verify that the childcare parking permit is valid

(3) UPON receipt of an application duly made under the foregoing provisions of this Article and upon being satisfied that the applicant is in need of such visits by a childcare provider who is or are either the owner of either a passenger vehicle or goods vehicle or a motor cycle or a person authorised to use such a vehicle by the owner thereof the Council may in its absolute discretion issue to the applicant therefor one childcare parking permit for the leaving without time limit during the permitted hours in any residents' only parking place or dual use parking place situated within the lengths of roads specified in column 3 of the table forming the First Schedule and identified on any of the plans of a vehicle belonging to or being used by a person visiting that resident in the course of their duties

PROVIDED THAT the childcare parking permit is only valid in respect of any resident's premises that are situated in the roads or parts of the roads specified and described in Column 2 of the table forming the First Schedule

(4) IN any respect not specifically mentioned in paragraphs (1), (2) and (3) of this Article and Articles 65B 65C and 65D the procedure validity and terms of use of a childcare parking permit shall be the same as the procedure validity and terms of use of a residents' parking permit and this paragraph shall be construed accordingly

Fee to be paid in respect of a childcare parking permit

65B The fee payable in respect of a childcare parking permit shall be as for a resident's parking permit as specified in the Fifth Schedule and the childcare permit shall be taken into account when making the calculation in accordance with the charges specified in the Fifth Schedule which subject to the provisions of this Order shall be valid for a period of twelve months

Form of childcare parking permit

65C A childcare parking permit shall either –

(a) be in writing and shall include the following particulars –

- (i) a serial number identifiable in the office of issue
- (ii) the word “CHILDCARE”
- (iii) the period during which the carer’s parking permit shall remain valid
- (iv) an indication that the carer’s parking permit has been issued by the Council
- (v) the appropriate letter identifying the roads or lengths of roads in which the permit is valid or

(b) be a virtual childcare parking permit

Display of childcare parking permit

65D AT all times during which a passenger vehicle or a goods vehicle or a motor cycle which is being used for the purposes specified in paragraph (1) of Article 65A is left in a residents’ only parking place or dual use parking place within the lengths of roads specified in column 3 of the table forming the First Schedule and identified on the plans during the permitted hours a valid childcare parking permit shall be displayed on the vehicle in respect of which it is to be used on the front or near-side of the vehicle so that all the particulars on the childcare parking permit are readily visible from the front or near-side of the vehicle

PROVIDED THAT a vehicle is validated by the hand held device as having a valid Virtual childcare parking permit no permit needs be displayed on that vehicle

AND PROVIDED THAT no such parking permit need be so displayed if the vehicle is waiting in that parking place pursuant to the provisions of Article 43 or is displaying in the manner specified in Article 53 or Article 58 or paragraph (7) of Article 60 or Article 64 a valid parking permit issued in respect of that vehicle or is a disabled person’s vehicle which displays in the relevant position or in the prescribed manner a disabled person’s badge issued by any local authority”

(xxi) The Schedule to this Order was added to the Principal Order as the Fifth Schedule

(4) The Surrey County Council Various Roads in the Borough of Woking (Residents’ On-Street Parking Places) Order 2019 shall have effect as though -

(i) The following Section was added to Part III in the Arrangement of Articles immediately following Section V

“SECTION VI – CHILDCARE PARKING PERMITS

Application for and issue of a childcare parking permit.. .. 32G

Fee to be paid in respect of a childcare parking permit..	32H
Form of childcare parking permit..	32I
Display of childcare parking permit..	32J”

(ii) The following item was added to the Arrangement of Schedules as the Fifth item –

“FIFTH SCHEDULE Cost of Residents Permits”

(iii) The following expressions and meanings were added to paragraph (1) of Article 2 in alphabetical sequence -

““childcare parking permit” means a childcare parking permit issued by the Council under the provisions of Article 32G

“childcare parking permit holder” means a person to whom a childcare parking permit has been issued

“two-hour resident’s visitor’s parking permit” means a resident’s visitor’s parking permit that is limited to a validity of two hours”

(iv) The words “and shall include a two-hour resident’s visitor’s parking permit where applicable” were added to the interpretation of the expression “resident’s visitor’s parking permit” in paragraph (1) of Article 2 immediately following the number “23”

(v) The words “or a childcare parking permit” were added to the interpretation of the expression “valid permit” in paragraph (1) of Article 2 immediately following the words “as applicable”

(vi) The words “or a business permit or a virtual childcare parking permit” were added to the interpretation of the expression “virtual parking transaction” immediately following the words “operational parking permit”

(vii) The phrase “or in the manner specified in Article 32J” was inserted in Article 4 immediately following the words “if applicable”

(viii) The following sub-paragraph shall be inserted in paragraph (1) of Article 16 immediately following paragraph (b) –

“(c) Any childcare parking permit shall be included in the calculation herein of a resident’s entitlement to a resident’s parking permit as though it was a resident’s parking permit”

(ix) For paragraph (7) of Article 16 there was substituted the following similarly numbered paragraph-

“(7) The fee referred to in paragraph (2) of this Article payable to the Council shall be such sums as are specified in the Fifth Schedule to this Order in respect of such nominated vehicle

indicated therein which subject to the provisions of this Order shall be valid for a period of twelve months running from any day of the month on which the parking permit first becomes valid and shall apply from the date indicated in the relevant column therein

(x) The phrase “or Article 32J” was inserted in Article 21 and Article 25 and paragraph (7) of Article 27 immediately following the number “32E”

(xi) The words “or limited to two hours as the case may be” was inserted in paragraphs (1) and (3) of Article 23 immediately following the words “without time limit”

(xii) For paragraph (4) of Article 23 there was substituted the following similarly numbered paragraph -

(4) Subject to the provisions contained in paragraph (3) of this Article the number of residents’ visitors parking permits issued in respect of each separate place of abode shall not exceed one hundred and fifty in each calendar year and two hundred and fifty two-hour residents’ visitors’ parking permits in each calendar year

PROVIDED THAT this paragraph shall have effect subject to the proviso that in certain exceptional circumstances the number of residents’ visitor’s parking permits issued in respect of each separate place of abode may exceed one hundred and fifty in each calendar year and two hundred and fifty two-hour residents’ visitors’ parking permits with no upper limit on the number of such permits so issued provided that in each case the exceptional circumstances referred to above are met and/or fully complied with”

(xiii) For paragraph (6) of Article 23 there was substituted the following similarly numbered paragraph –

“(6) The fee referred to in paragraph (3) of this Article payable to the Council in respect of -

- (i) a resident’s visitor’s parking permit shall be £2 for each such parking permit and that the resident’s visitor’s parking permit shall be valid for a period of one day only
- (ii) a two-hour resident’s visitor’s parking permit shall be £1 for each such parking permit and that the two-hour resident’s visitor’s parking permit shall be valid for a period of two hours only”

(xiv) The following paragraph was added to Article 24 immediately following paragraph (f) –

“(g) and in the case of a two-hour resident’s visitor’s parking permit a space for the insertion of the time of the commencement of waiting by the said vehicle in the parking place”

(xv) The words “and in the case of a two-hour resident’s visitor’s parking permit the time of the commencement of waiting by the said vehicle in the parking place” were added to Article 26 immediately following the words “to be used” in the last line

(xvi) For Article 29 including the shoulder heading there was substituted the following similarly numbered Article –

“No Charge in respect of a carer’s parking permit

29 NO charge shall be payable in respect of a carer’s parking permit which subject to the provisions of this Order shall be valid for a period of twelve months”

(xvii) Article 30 was omitted in its entirety

(4) IN any respect not specifically mentioned in paragraphs (1), (2) and (3) of this Article and Articles 32H 32I and 32J the procedure validity and terms of use of a childcare parking permit shall be the same as the procedure validity and terms of use of a residents' parking permit and this paragraph shall be construed accordingly

Fee to be paid in respect of a childcare parking permit

32H The fee payable in respect of a childcare parking permit shall be as for a resident's parking permit as specified in the Fifth Schedule and the childcare permit shall be taken into account when making the calculation in accordance with the charges specified in the Fifth Schedule which subject to the provisions of this Order shall be valid for a period of twelve months

Form of childcare parking permit

32I A childcare parking permit shall either -

PROVIDED THAT a vehicle is validated by the hand held device as having a valid Virtual childcare parking permit no permit needs be displayed on that vehicle

AND PROVIDED THAT no such parking permit need be so displayed if the vehicle is waiting in that parking place pursuant to the provisions of Article 10 or is displaying in the manner specified in Article 21 or Article 25 or paragraph (7) of Article 27 or Article 31 or Article 32E (if applicable) a valid parking permit issued in respect of that vehicle or is a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position or in the prescribed manner a disabled person's badge issued by any local authority"

(xix) The Schedule to this Order was added to the Principal Order as the Fourth Schedule
