Citation and Commencement

- 1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Epsom and Ewell (Pay and Display Parking Places) (Twenty Ninth Amendment) Order 2008
- (2) This Order shall come into operation on the 1st day of April 2008

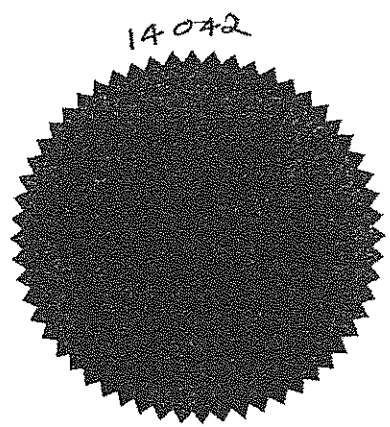

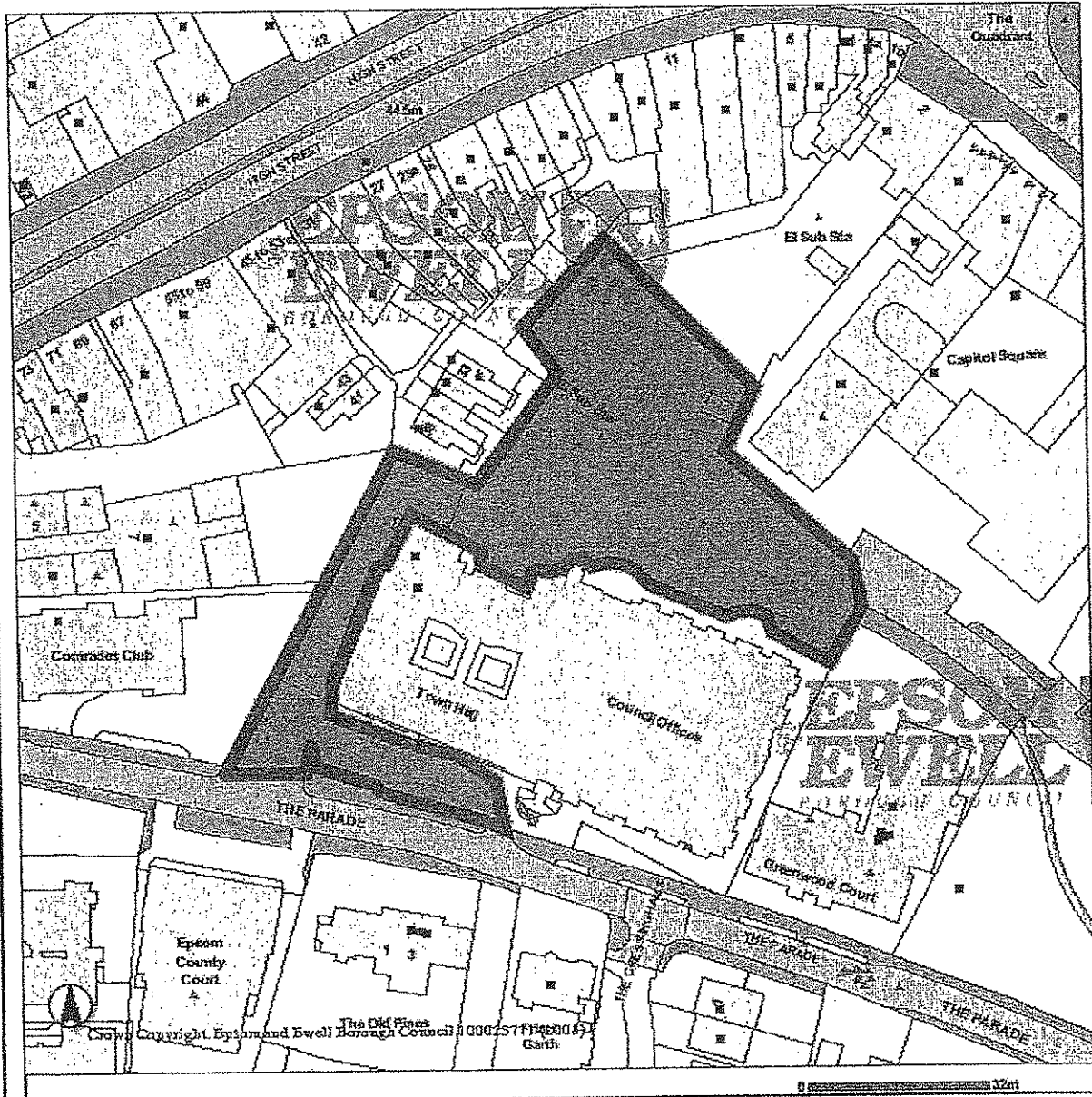

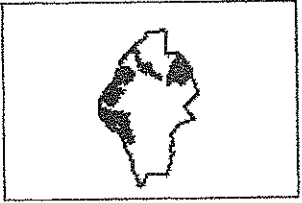
